I have reviewed the information that Rob Whitney gave you concerning Little Canyon Creek. There was an order for a measurement device and controlling works device for the 50/50 diversion and the Pond diversion. However, this order was inadequate to allow the watermaster the ability to properly deliver the water. The order only requires that 2 headgates be installed. The order does not say where the 2 headgates are to be installed. This makes it impossible to deliver the water on these diversions, because the elevation of the headgates in relation to the ditches makes it difficult to adjust the head on the gates in the pond. There is not an order for the remaining diversions on the creek. Only the 50/50 and Pond diversion have an order in place.

Therefore, I propose that the following order be issued to the Little Canyon Creek water district:

- 1.) All points of diversion shall have a lockable/controllable headgate for each diversion on the creek. For pumps directly diverting from the creek, the power box for the pump would need a shut off switch that could be locked.
- 2.) Each point of diversion should have a measurement device installed per IDWR standards. Power records could be used for the small pump users.
- 3.) All ditches leaving a pond, dam, or instream diversion point where water is being backed up for a point of diversion must also have a lockable controllable headgate installed, including the stream itself.

After reviewing the information, these are the recommendations that I came up with. Most of the problems on this stream are not with the existing headgates, but with instream dams and diversion used to back the water up. When the water is being backed up we need the ability to control both the creek and the headgate. If we do not have both headgates, then we can not control the water going both ways.







#### 50/50 DIVERSION:

To properly deliver water at the 50/50 diversion a lockable control device would need to be installed on the Batruel ditch and standard measurement devices would need to be installed on both ditches.

A lockable control gate has been installed on the Smith ditch. However, the Batruel ditch is at a lower elevation and water will go through this diversion before it would go through the Smith ditch. Therefore, there is no way to regulate this diversion without a lockable control gate on the Batruel ditch.

In order to determine how much water is going to each ditch, it would be necessary to install standard measurement devices on both ditches.

These devices would need to meet the Bureau of Reclamation definition of a Standard Device. A Standard Device is one that is properly constructed to set specifications and is properly installed. A non-standard device could be used as long as it was properly calibrated prior to diversion of water. The Smith ditch already has a weir in the ditch. However, this weir in improperly installed and is not a standard device. It would need to be moved downstream approximately 20 to 30 feet and the ditch cleaned to provide an adequate weir pool. The device itself would need to be rebuilt to Bureau of Reclamation standards.


#### RECOMMENDATIONS

#### **POND DIVERSION:**

Installing standard measurement devices in each ditch can regulate the pond diversion.

The Batruel ditch has an adjustable/lockable device on it. The Batruel diversion is lower in elevation than the ditch to the 50/50 diversion, which should allow the watermaster to regulate both diversions with the single headgate.

However, in order to determine how much water is going to each ditch, it would be necessary to install standard measurement devices on both ditches. These devices would need to meet the Bureau of Reclamation definition of a Standard Device. A Standard Device is one that is properly constructed to set specifications and is properly installed. A non-standard device could be used as long as it was properly calibrated prior to diversion of water.

Dear Mr. Batruel:

This letter is a formally respond to your complaint against the watermaster of Water District 61D, Jim Allen. You telephoned me on 4/2/2001 to inform me that someone had shut down the diversion to your reservoir on 3/29/2001. At that time you also stated that you had gone back and turned the water back into your reservoir and that a day or so later the water was turned back down Little Canyon Creek. You stated that the loss of storage for the last 3 days of March could cost you one cutting of hay or approximately \$10,000.00.

I spoke with Jim Allen on 4/3/2001 and he told me that he turned 50 % of the water into Little Canyon Creek to allow the Smiths to begin irrigating on 4/1/2001. The Smiths own the water right with the earliest priority date on the creek and their water rights were in place before the development of the Marrow Reservoir. However, in recent history the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) has allowed you to store water in your reservoir until April 1 of each year before releasing water into the creek for the downstream water users. Therefore, Mr. Allen should not have adjusted your diversion before April 1 without consulting with IDWR first. I contacted Mr. Allen on April 3, 2001 and informed him of this and told him that next year he should contact our office before releasing water from the Marrow Reservoir diversion. Please be aware that the Smith's water right is senior to your storage rights and the Smiths could have petitioned IDWR to release water early to allow them to begin diverting water on April 1. However, Mr. Allen should have sought instruction from our office prior to making that decision.

In speaking with Mr. Allen, I am confident he thought he was doing the right thing and did not intend to harm anyone. Mr. Allen tried to contact me before he made the adjustment, but I was not available to instruct him at that time. I do not feel that further action against the watermaster is necessary at this time. However, you can send a written request for the removal of the watermaster if you choose. Upon receipt of this request, IDWR will thoroughly investigate this situation and take the appropriate steps. On rare occasions IDWR has removed the watermaster and appointed a new watermaster. Removal is only justified after a showing that the watermaster has failed to perform his duty.

During our initial conversation, you stated that you re-adjusted the headgate for your diversion. You have been instructed multiple times that you do not have the authority to adjust any headgate after the watermaster is regulating the water deliveries. You are not allowed to adjust any headgate without direct written permission from the watermaster or IDWR. I have enclosed the sections in the Idaho Code that refers to the adjustment of a headgate without the permission of the watermaster or IDWR. Please do not adjust any more headgates without permission or you could be subject to criminal prosecution.

On this date I received a telephone call from Mrs. Allen (wife of Jim Allen, Water Master) regarding a call for water delivery at the 50/50 diversion. Mrs. Allen explained that Jim has been called seven times to make the split of water and it appears that the diversion on the Batruel side is being tampered with.

Pursuant to our conversation this a.m., Dan Nelson and I will meet with the water master this afternoon to close the delivery of water on the Batruel side of the 50/50. This action will be taken because Batruel has not installed a proper headgate that allows the water master to effectuate the appropriate split to the parties. The water will be allowed to continue down sand springs gulch through the Smith's headgate at the 50/50. Mrs. Allen also stated that Batruel may be receiving the majority of the water reaching the 50/50, but it has been alleged that Batruel is not beneficially using this water.

This information is subject to verification at the time of our visit this afternoon.

The motion for interim administration seeks to have water distributed and administered in accordance with the Director's Report for 61-00293B, which does permit the Batruels to divert water at their Pond Diversion. It is my understanding that the Department can and will distribute water in accordance with its Director's Report for 61-00293B if so ordered by the Court under Idaho Code § 42-1417. If I am incorrect in my understanding, please let me know immediately.

The hearing on the motion for interim administration is set for next Friday, April 28, 2000, at 3:00 p.m. I apologize for the short notice. The call by Ms. Smith was not anticipated. However, now that my clients are being harmed by that call, they must move quickly to get their Pond Diversion headgate opened.

On that note, my clients will need to have Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) personnel testify at the April 28 hearing. Specifically, there will need to be someone who can testify as to the basis of the Director's Report for 61-00293B, as it relates to the issues raised by the motion for interim administration. There will also need to be someone who can testify concerning the measurement and distribution of water, if the water is allowed to be administered pursuant to the Director's Report. I believe Rob Whitney is the allocations agent most familiar with this latter issue.

Please let me know, as soon as possible, which agents will be made available for the April 28 hearing so that I may identify them in my list of witnesses and exhibits. Also, I would ask that IDWR prepare a poster-size map of the area encompassing the Batruels' place of use and the Morrow Reservoir. Please include on that map markers that identify the Pond Diversion, the 50/50 Diversion, and any other helpful markers that you feel would be of assistance to the Court in getting a clear picture of the facts in this case. I believe Wendy Eklund has prepared something similar to that in the last couple of months that you may be able to work from.

The above request for assistance is made pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 42-1401B and 42-1412(4). Again, I regret the short notice. Any assistance you can provide the Court and the parties in this case is greatly appreciated.

MOTION FOR ORDER OF INTERIM ADMINISTRATION; MOTION FOR DISCLOSURE OF WITNESSES AND EXHIBITS - 1

The grounds for this motion are as follows. As a result of a recent "water call" made by Carlene Smith, an objector in subcase no. 61-00293B, the watermaster, on April 18, 2000, shut down and locked the Batruels' headgate at a point commonly known as the "Pond Diversion." The watermaster, under direction of IDWR, took this action pursuant to a 1995 "Supplemental Judgment" entered in Elmore County case no. 82-08224, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit B. That judgment prohibits diversion of the Batruels' water at the Pond Diversion and requires that the water be diverted downstream at a point commonly known as the "50/50 Diversion." Because the 1995 Supplemental Judgement was entered after the commencement of the SRBA, there is a question as to whether the Elmore County Court lacked jurisdiction to enter the judgment and whether exclusive jurisdiction, at that time, vested in the SRBA Court.

As a result of the headgate being shut down and locked at the Pond Diversion, the Batruels are unable to divert their Sand Springs Gulch water (right no. 61-00293B) onto their entire recommended 295-acre place of use. If the Batruels are forced to take their water downstream at the 50/50 Diversion, they will only be able to irrigate the lower portion of their farmland with Sand Springs Gulch water. A large portion of their farmland, which is higher in elevation than the 50/50 Diversion, can only be irrigated with water from Sand Springs Gulch by diverting it at the Pond Diversion. The Director's Report for 61-00293B recognizes the Batruels' need for, and historical use of, diverting water at the Pond Diversion.

IDWR has indicated that, under its ministerial duties, it can and will distribute water pursuant to its Director's Report for 61-00293B, if this Court issues an Order of Interim Administration pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1417(1)(a). Because the Batruels' are being immediately harmed by the closure of their headgate, they respectfully move the Court for an

Order granting interim administration until the dispute between the parties can be resolved on the merits, pursuant to the Trial Scheduling Order issued by this Court on April 18, 2000.

#### MOTION FOR DISCLOSURE OF WITNESSES AND EXHIBITS

The Batruels also respectfully move this Court for an Order requiring that each party and IDWR lodge with the Court and serve on the other parties and IDWR on or before 5:00 p.m. on April 26, 2000, a list of witnesses and exhibits that the party and/or IDWR intend to call or introduce at the hearing on the above motion.

The Motion for Order of Interim Administration is supported by the record in this case and such testimony and other evidence as will be introduced at the hearing scheduled on this motion.

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Defendants shall immediately and forthwith construct a good and sufficient ditch in the manner outlined in the reports of Carlyle W. Briggs, Special Master, by constructing approximately 400 feet of ditch, to include installation of a culvert under a road, from the Morrow Reservoir to the Batruel pond located near Batruel's home. The water from the Morrow Reservoir shall be diverted from such reservoir through such new ditch and pond, and shall not be diverted

into Sand Springs Gulch, except as provided in paragraph 3 hereof.

- 2. Defendants shall immediately and forthwith remove all obstructions to the flow of Sand Springs Gulch from such Gulch, in order that there can be a full flow of water in such Gulch. Further, Defendants shall not divert water from Sand Springs Gulch at the so-called "pond diversion," but shall allow water to flow to the "50-50" diversion downstream therefrom. Further, the parties shall jointly install two locking headgates in order that the Watermaster may properly allocate the parties' respective water rights. However, if Plaintiff agrees in writing filed in this Court, the equal division of the water that rises and flows in Sand Springs Gulch may occur at the Pond Diversion.
- 3. Defendants shall, however, be allowed to use Sand Springs Gulch, if directed to do so by the Department of Water Resources to alleviate leaking and structural integrity problems with such dam on the Morrow Reservoir. Defendant shall not divert water through their pond in such fashion as it floods Plaintiff's fields.
- 4. The Department of Water Resources and the Watermaster with jurisdiction over this region shall be furnished with a copy hereof, and shall endeavor to allocate the water rights of the parties in conformance with this Judgment and the prior orders of this Court.

RE: Batruel Pond Diversion shutoff-Sand Springs Gulch

With instructions from J.Holman and N. Young, Rob Whitney and I met the #61D Watermaster and Ms. S. Richards Elmore County Deputy at Glenns Ferry. The group proceeded to the diversion site, and found the lock had been removed from the previous locked open headgate. The Batruel gate was closed, chained/locked, and tagged by the watermaster; some fill was placed in front of the gate to seal leakage. There was approx. 2cfs + flow past the diversion.

The group then traveled to the 50-50 Batruel/Viner-Smith split in the lower gulch. The split area is overgrown with cattails/reeds. The Viner-Smith diversion is an 8" headgate with a cipolleti weir (2 ft length) downstream. There is basically little, if any weir pool behind the weir, and the weir blade is too long to accurately measure the small gulch flows. The Batruel gate is approx. 30-50 ft downstream, (east side) consisting of tin slide over a 1 ft dia concrete pipe; there is no measuring device. It appeared Batruel was getting considerable more flow than Viner.

The cattail growth and locations of the gates makes it impossible for the Watermaster to make any kind of accurate split. Growth needs to be controlled in the area, along with a diversion structure that can automatically split flow (pipes at equal elevation, etc.).

RE: Batruel Diversion in Sand Springs Gulch.

On Mike Stubblefield and I inspected the Morrow Dam. Reservoir outlet flow were being diverted to the regulating pond on the Batruel property. No flow was being released into the Sand Springs Gulch.

As the result of a call earlier in the week from Mrs. Jim Allen (watermaster spouse) of Little Canyon Water District, we stopped at the "pond diversion" located in Sand Spring Gulch below the dam. The ditch gate at the diversion was chained and padlocked open; all the gulch flow (approx. 2 cfs.) was diverted into the ditch that conveys water to the Batruel dairy pond. Overflows from the dairy pond were flowing east crossing the road down the draw to the gulch flume, and to a newly constructed ditch to the Batruel pasture. We did not follow the ditch through the pasture. See attached map.

#### 4/15/00

I received a call from Mrs. Jim Allen to discuss problems her husband was having with the Batruels and Mrs. Viner-Smith. The problem centered around the pond diversion and 50/50 on Sand Springs Gulch. Mrs. Viner-Smith had become abusive with the Watermaster, and Mrs. Allen indicated he was gone to turn in his resignation. After a long discussion, I stated, the Dept. would contact Jim on Monday, and possibly meet with him on the site if needed.

Revised Delivery Instructions for Sand Springs Gulch

Dear Mr. Hall:

Attached you will find a copy of the District Court's Supplemental Judgment filed on July 5, 1995.

The District Court required the parties to take certain actions to effectuate water delivery on Sand Springs Gulch.

- 1. Defendant Batruel has been ordered to immediately construct a new ditch and remove any obstructions from Sand Springs Gulch.
- 2. Defendant Batruel and Plaintiff Viner have each been ordered to install a locking headgate at the 50/50 diversion in order that the Watermaster may properly allocate the parties' respective water rights.
- 3. Defendant Batruel was further ordered not to divert water from the "pond diversion," and only use the gulch if directed to do so by the Department in order to alleviate structural integrity problems with Morrow Dam.

Additionally, the Supplemental Judgment ordered the Department to allocate the water rights of the parties in conformance with the Judgment and all prior orders of the Court. Pursuant to I.C. § 42-701 the design and installation of the headgates at the 50/50 diversion must be approved by the Department to insure the water in the gulch can be divided equally.

At this point, both parties still need to make the structural changes described in paragraph number one and two above, in order to allow for the delivery of water as contemplated by the Court's order. A period of ten days from the date of this letter will be allowed for both parties to make any required structural changes. Thereafter, the watermaster is directed to deliver water in accordance with the Supplemental Judgment

of the Court unless it has been stayed through appropriate legal action.

Delivery of water under the Supplemental Judgment will require that the headgate at the "pond diversion" be locked and posted by the Watermaster, and that no water be diverted through the existing ditch from Sand Springs Gulch into the Batruel pond. Likewise, at the 50/50 diversion, the watermaster under the Supplemental Judgment is directed to divide the available water one-half to Batruel and one-half to Viner up to her decreed amount of 28-3/4 inches, provided Department approved headgates are installed. The unauthorized removal of a lock placed by the watermaster or otherwise illegally diverting water at either the pond diversion or the 50/50 diversion will be subject to criminal prosecution under Chapter 43, Title 18, Idaho Code.

The watermaster's actions will result in no water being diverted through the existing ditch into Batruel's pond. Plaintiff may need to take precautions to prevent flooding should it become necessary for the watermaster to lock the diversion of water at the pond diversion, and is being so advised by copy of this letter.

After considerable review by the Department it appears that the Supplemental Judgment may have substantially modified the earlier decrees of the Court and effectively adjudicated the parties' water rights. The Court's Supplemental Judgment raises issues concerning jurisdiction of the Court to adjudicate water rights under Chapter 14, Title 42, Idaho Code. The Department expects that the jurisdictional issue will be addressed later in the Snake River Basin Adjudication, Twin Falls County Case No. 39576, in the event the issue is not appealed in this case.

Upon a showing of good cause, either party may petition the Department for additional time to take any actions identified above.
