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GUIDELINES FOR RECORDKEEPING



- Use the official daily record book. Do not use substitutes. If you prefer to record notes in another text, transcribe to the daily record book immediately.
- Use a separate daily record book for each stream you administer. Do not mix the users of several streams into one daily record.
- 3. If the water being delivered is measured and the headgate set on a particular day, record the flow in cubic feet per second in the proper grid space. If water diverted at a particular diversion is not measured on a given day, but you believe that water continues to be delivered without a change in the flow or headgate setting, place an "A" in the grid space for that day. The "A" represents that the previous flow and headgate setting is "assumed." An "A" must always be preceded by an actual numerical flow rate.
- 4. If the water being delivered is not actually measured, enter an "E" in the fraction portion of the grid space for the particular day that the flow rate is estimated. An "E" should always follow an estimated numerical flow that is observed and set in the field.
- 5. If water is not being delivered, enter a "0" (zero) in the proper grid space. If the water right is cut off because of unavailability of water, a zero may be entered in the grid space corresponding to the day the right could no longer be satisfied, and all subsequent days when water is not deliverable may be designated with a horizontal line through the grids that represent the days of nondelivery.
- A blank grid space means that the watermaster has no knowledge of the amount of water being delivered on that day. A grid should never be blank while the watermaster is delivering water.
- 7. If possible, please list the water right no. in the daily record rather than a number assigned by the district or by the decree. Future users of the records will likely look for a water right reference.
- 8. Record unusual or noteworthy happenings. For instance, if a senior downstream right holder's water right is no longer available because the creek dries up upstream, and junior upstream rightholders are allowed to divert remaining water upstream, this event should be recorded on the day it happens.

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 1:02 pm, January 11, 2010, by Carlene Smith, President

Water users in attendance: Rob Whitley-IDWR, Rusty Trails, Teresa McCallum, Jesus Hernandez D., Carlene Smith, Alan Crane, Mike Nickerson, Gary Ellis Jr., Roberto Robles Elizabeth Elias, Charles Finley, Ann T. Wilson, Sulio Zabala.

Reading of Minutes: Minutes provided by Teresa McCallum were moved to approval by Rusty Trails and seconded by Alan Crane. Minutes were accepted as read.

Election of Officers:

President: Teresa McCallum nominated Mike Nickerson Rusty Trails 2nd. Nominations were closed and passed by unanimous consent.

Secretary/Treasurer: Rusty nominated Teresa McCallum, Alan Crane 2nd. Nominations were closed and passed by unanimous consent.

Watermaster: Teresa Nominated Gary Ellis Jr. with Jennifer Baker as alternate so that two people would be trained by Water Resources. This was 2nd by Ann Wilson and approved. Advisory Committee: To Remain the same as last year, being all water users.

Treasurer's Report: Assessment for 2010 was \$260.87 w/ minimums amount billed \$367.57, collected was \$377.57. All Water Users are current. Collected an additional \$7.91 in interest on the bank account. Spent \$143.36 on insurance, Watermaster salary of \$150.00 from 2009, and postage of \$21.95 Balance in the account is \$2,208.29 as of 12/31/09. Treasures report was moved to be accepted as read by Ann Wilson and seconded by Rusty Trails. There were no objections.

Old Business: None

Previous year water report: Teresa read the Watermaster report for 2010. There were none. Report was approved as read.

At the District meeting on August 31, 2010, the District voted to have the Department staff perform the District watermaster duties for the 2011 irrigation season. If the Department Director declined the responsibility, Gary Ellis would be the elected watermaster for the new season.

Recently, I met with Administration Staff and the Director regarding the District's request for a Department staff watermaster next season. Given the current staff and budget reductions and additional future budget holdbacks, the Director has declined the request to appoint a Department staff member as District Watermaster. Mr. Ellis will be the duly elected/appointed Watermaster for the 2011 irrigation season.

To assist the new Watermaster, the Department will assign a staff member to provide a 1 day onsite preseason training, and the regional office will provide technical support as needed. However, I want to emphasize the Department's resources are very limited. If there is an unfortunate midseason resignation of the Watermaster, the District will need to expedite the search/election of a replacement.

Enclosed is a measurement and controllable works order that was issued for Cold Springs Creek in January of 2002. Please be advised, the order will continue to be applicable for the 2011 new season. Department staff and the Watermaster will be checking to make sure wateruser diversions meet the necessary measurement and controllable works standards.

BY LAWS OF THE

WATER DISTRICTS

61 D LITTLE CANYON CREEK

ARTICLE I

Name, Location, Business

SECTION 1: Name: The name of this organization shall be Little Canyon Creek Water

District. "it shall be referred to hereinafter as "the organization".

SECTION 2: Location: 11204 N. Bar 21 Dr. Glenns Ferry, Idaho 83623 or with the

current organization secretary.

SECTION 3: **Business:** This organization shall engage in the business of controlling and running the operations of Little Canyon Creek Water Districts 61D as prescribed by these By Laws.

ARTICLE II

Purpose

SECTION 1: **Purpose:** The purpose for which this group is organized is civic in nature to control the operation of irrigation along Little Canyon Creek. The organization shall be and is empowered to cooperate and work in compliance with the State of Idaho governmental agencies to achieve its purpose. This organization shall act as the primary controlling agency for Little Canyon Water District and shall promote just and equitable rules and controls in business, through the collection and dissemination of information, and through services that may be rendered in connection with subjects of general importance, through research and if needed direct action.

SECTION 2: **Limitations:** The organization in its activities shall be limited to insuring irrigators along Little Canyon Creek are in compliance with their water rights and controls are in place to enforce compliance as directed by Water District and the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III

Membership

SECTION 1: **Eligibility:** Any person, firm, partnership, corporation/association, estate, or trust may apply for membership if they have water rights for taking water from Little Canyon Creek and agrees to conform to and abide by the By Laws of Water District 61D Little Canyon Creek and any amendments there to.

SECTION 2: Classification of Members: All active members in good standing shall be entitled to vote, to hold office, to serve on standing and special committees, to attend all

regular and special membership meetings, to have the privileges of the floor at such meetings and to participate in all referenda conducted by the organization. A member in good standing is one that is in compliance with all requirements of this organization and is current in any and all assessments made by this organization.

SECTION 3: **Membership dues:** The minimum annual membership dues for active members of this organization shall be reviewed annually by the board of officers and any proposed assessment shall be voted on by organization membership.

SECTION 4: **Voting:** Each individual member in good standing shall be entitled to one vote. Votes shall be by individual persons only, one vote person, and not by proxy unless done so in writting. Every firm shall designate a voting representative for each vote authorized.

SECTION: **Termination of membership:** Upon termination of any membership by death, resignation, sale or transfer of water rights in Little Canyon Creek or expulsion, the interests of such member in and to the property of this organization and his/her rights and privileges shall be forfeited. In the event of termination of membership, assessments shall not be refundable.

ARTICLE IV

Membership Meetings

SECTION 1: **Annual Meetings:** The annual membership meeting of this organization shall be held the second Monday of January of each year at such time and place as may be designated by the President. At such annual meeting, the newly elected officers shall be installed.

SECTION 2: **Special Meetings:** The President may call such special meeting of the membership as he/she may deem necessary, and shall call a membership meeting upon the request of ten percent of the members in good standing.

SECTION 3: **Quorum:** Ten percent of the active members in good standing of the organization shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business at a membership meeting.

ARTICLE V

Officers

SETION 1: **President's Office:** The President shall preside at all meetings of this organization and perform all duties incident to that office. He/She shall, as he/she may deem proper, commend to the membership such matters and make suggestions as may tend to promote the prosperity and increase the usefulness of the organization. SECTION 2: **Secretary/Treasurer's Office:** It shall be the duties of the secretary to conduct the official correspondence, communication, and maintain an accurate record of the proceedings of this organization. The treasurer shall receive and disburse the funds of this organization. He/She shall keep all monies of this organization deposited in the name of this organization. All disbursements shall be made by check duly signed by the Treasurer and counter signed by the President if over \$500.00

SECTION 3: Vacancies: Vacancies occurring in the offices herein provided for shall be filled by interim appointment by a Resolution of the membership. The interim appointment shall be until the vacancies' term has expired.

SECTION 4: **Hold Harmless:** The Officers of this organization shall not be held personally liable for any of the actions of the membership of this organization unless criminal intent is shown.

SECTION 5: Term of officers: The term of elected officers shall be one calendar year.

ARTICLE VI

Representatives

SECTION 1: Any person or persons appointed to act as the official representative or representatives of this organization at conventions, hearings, or public meetings of any kind, shall so act only after receiving specific instructions from the President. Upon completion of such an assignment the representative(s) shall make a full report to the President.

SECTION 2: Watermaster as Representative of the Organization has the ability to set time limits for response to call outs not to exceed 48 hours.

SECTION 3: The Watermaster is to immediately notify the District Secretary when 10 call outs are performed. Then again when the budgeted callouts are reached, in any one year.

ARTICLE VII

Budgeting

SECTION 1: **Fiscal Year:** The fiscal year of this organization shall be January 1 through December 31.

SECTION 2: **Budget:** The President shall constitute the Budget Committee and adopt a budget in December each year for the following year. At the annual meeting the President shall present the budget to the membership for approval and or adjustments. The President shall adjust and/or revise the annual budget to conform with any limitations or expenses created by changing conditions throughout the year. The Dues/Assessments shall be based on the estimated budget for the upcoming year. The Dues/Assessments shall be reduced by any remaining funds over \$1000.00 from previous years budget.

SECTION 3: **Dues/Assessments:** Each member shall be bill by the percentage of the water right held on Little Canyon Creek, with a minimum billing of 10.00 dollars. The amounts payable by each member as shown by the approved budget shall become due and payable on March 15th and that said amount, if not paid shall bear a penalty of 10% and shall bear interest from that date until paid, at a rate of 8 percent per annum. No member shall have the right to demand and receive water, and the Watermaster shall not deliver to such person until the amount due and payable for such member as fixed by the budget has been paid.

ARTICLE VIII

- B. By a two-thirds affirmative vote of the members entitled to vote there at, at the Annual meeting of the members, or any other meeting of the members called for that purpose by the President.

ARTICLE IX

Dissolution

On dissolution of this organization any funds remaining shall be distributed to the current members by the percentage of water rights held on Little Canyon Creek.
