A question has been raised about the use of three water rights attached to your Hagerman property. The water rights are:

36-4025 Owner Donald & Bonnie Pica Trust  
36-7298 Owner Donald & Bonnie Pica Trust  
36-10169 Owner Donald & Bonnie Pica Trust

For water right 36-4025 I found no violation of the Partial Degree.

For water right 36-7298 I found one violation by a site visit on 12-10-17 for the place of use. The place of use for water right 36-7298 is Township 07S, Range 13E, Section 14, Tract NW NW. It appears you have constructed ponds outside this place of use.

For water right 36-10169 I found one violation by a site visit on 12-10-17 for period of use. The period of use for water right 36-10169 is from 02/15 to 11/30. Water was being diverted on 12-10-17 into the corn field in NW NW section 14 Range 13E Township 07S.

Please address these violations by January 5, 2018. I would consider a site visit to review the property and water rights.

## **Water District 36A – Annual Meeting**

**January 17, 2017**

American Legion Hall, Hagerman, ID

- (1 & 2)** Gary Lemmon, 2016 Advisory Board Chairman, opened the meeting at 1:31 pm and introduced the current Advisory Board members in attendance, Water Master Frank Erwin, Secretary/Treasurer Linda Lemmon, and IDWR Staff from the Twin Falls office (Kent Aasa, Jana Reeder and Michelle Richman).

Handouts available at the sign in sheet included: Agenda for today's meeting, Minutes from the January 19, 2016 Annual Meeting, the 2016 Treasurer's Report and Proposed 2017 Water District Budget, and the proposed 2017 Resolutions. Twenty five district members were in attendance representing 29 of the 69 diversions in the District.

**(3) Election of Meeting Chairman**

Gary Lemmon led the election of the Meeting Chairman to run today's annual meeting. *A motion was made by Bill Jones and seconded by Butch Morris that Gary Lemmon be elected as Chairman to run today's meeting.* No other nominations were made. *Motion carried by voice vote with none opposed.*

**Election of Water District 36A Advisory Board for FY 2017**

Gary Lemmon reported that all of the current advisory board members except Dennis Newman, who was no longer based out of Hagerman for IDFG, were willing to serve another year if the members so desired. Gary Lemmon asked for nominations from the floor. Brandon Tycz, who replaced Dennis Newman at IDFG, said he would be willing to serve on the advisory board. *Bill Jones moved that Bud Huntley, Gary Lemmon, Billy McCarthy, John Mavencamp, Howard Morris, Brandon Tycz and Dan Yore be elected to the Advisory Board for fiscal year 2017. Butch Morris seconded the motion.* No other nominations were offered and the nominations were closed. *Motion passed by voice vote, with none opposed.*

**(4) Approval of FY 2016 Annual Meeting Minutes**

*A motion was made by Rod Howard and seconded by David Cropper to approve the minutes from the January 19, 2016 Annual Meeting as written and presented. Motion carried by voice vote, with none opposed.*

**(5) Presentation of the 2016 Treasurer's Report and Adoption of Proposed 2017 Budget**

Frank Erwin reviewed the handout titled *Water District 36A Budget Summary (as of 12/31/16)* which included both the 2016 Treasurer's Report (adopted and actual budgets) and the 2017 Proposed Budget. Linda explained that the large amount spent in the office supply category was due to ordering a box of stamped, return-addressed envelopes that would be used over several years. Frank did not turn in any additional mileage reimbursement for 2016.

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Using the same handout, Frank reviewed the proposed 2017 Budget for the District which included an assessment rate of \$ 0.50/24-hr second ft, the same as last year.

***A motion to accept the proposed as presented was made by David Cropper and seconded by Tom Van Tassel. Motion carried by voice vote, with none opposed.***

**(6) Adoption of 2017 Resolutions**

Gary Lemmon reviewed the handout titled *Water District 36A - Proposed Resolutions for 2017* which described the rules under which the District operates annually. The eleven proposed resolutions were essentially the same as last year – only the years were updated.

***Tom Van Tassel moved and Bill Jones seconded that the 2017 proposed resolutions be adopted as written. There was no further discussion. Motion carried by voice vote, with none opposed.***

**(7) Water Master's Report & Goals for 2017**

Frank reported that he had no complaints about measuring and reporting efforts by District members. He reminded everyone with meters to make sure that they included all of the basic information requested on the report form specific to their particular meter (serial numbers, multiplier, etc) as he was compiling a book summarizing that information for a new water master to use in the future. He had already compiled a book with pertinent information on the open channel diversions in the District. There are still a couple of PCCs in the District that need to be changed over to meters by 2018.

Frank reported, in general, that Billingsley Creek streams were a bit improved this past year. He reported that low elevation springs downstream of Tupper Grade were more steady state than in previous years due in part, he believes, to positive hydrostatic pressure from water in the W-canal on the rim. At the same time, springs upstream of Tupper Grade were not at steady state.

He also reported that the groundwater districts intend to purchase the Rangen Hatchery at the head of Billingsley Creek (upstream of Tupper Grade) this year and are expected to change how they operate the Magic Springs pump that was installed to supply up to 10 cfs spring water as mitigation to that facility. As facility owners, the GW districts will no longer have to supply mitigation water to themselves. Last year about 8 cfs of spring water was delivered to the facility under the mitigation agreement, which was subsequently available for diversion by other users along Billingsley Creek after discharging the facility. Without the Magic Springs water, Curren Ditch diverters immediately downstream of the Rangen facility will be the first users affected whenever the canal company can't deliver substitute wastewater to them through the Sandy Pipeline.

**(8) Additional News & Updates**

Frank reported that recharge efforts above the rim have been slowly moving forward, but that headway is being made. The goal of 250,000 acre feet of recharge is still a long way off, but more infrastructure is in place to accommodate recharge when available. Freezing weather this winter is hampering recharge efforts through the Milepost 31 site, but Twin Falls Canal Co. did some recharge in Murtaugh Lake.

Meeting adjourned at 1:55 pm.

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**WATER DISTRICT 36A – ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS FOR 2017**

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SOUTHERN REGION

- 1 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that hereafter the annual meeting of Water District 36A shall be held on the third Tuesday in January each year.
- 2 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the amounts payable by each ditch, association, canal company, or other water user, as shown by the approved budget, shall become due and payable upon receipt and delinquent on April 15<sup>th</sup>, and said amount, if not paid, shall bear a penalty of 10% and interest from that date until paid, at a rate of 1% per month.
- 3 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that no ditch, association, canal company, or other water user shall have the right to demand and receive water, and the Water Master shall not deliver to such person(s) or entity(ies), until the amount due and payable from such user(s), as fixed by the budget, has been paid.
- 4 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Water Master shall be in service for a full year, commencing on February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year and continuing until the following January 31<sup>st</sup>, or until his successor as been duly qualified and elected.
- 5 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that Frank Erwin be elected Water Master of Water District 36A for the ensuing year, beginning February 1, 2017, and ending January 31, 2018.
- 6 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that Linda Lemmon be elected Secretary/Treasurer for Water District 36A for the ensuing year, beginning February 1, 2017, and ending January 31, 2018.
- 7 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the elected Treasurer of Water District 36A should only disburse monies from the Water District accounts upon a voucher approved by the Water Master. All Water District checks can be signed either by the Treasurer or Chairman, but must be co-signed by an Advisory Board Member. Advisory Board Members Howard Morris and Billy McCarthy shall serve for the purpose of co-signing all Water District 36A checks.
- 8 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that Water District 36A assessments shown in the adopted budget shall constitute a final determination of the amount due for that year (per Idaho Code 42-612).
- 9 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that Water District 36A assessments shall be based on the most recent reliable data available to the Water Master and shall be assessed in 24-hour second feet (per Idaho Code 42-612).
- 10 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that for the year 2017, a minimum charge of \$50.00 shall be assessed to each individual or entity that owns a water right, whose share of the total budget is less than the above specified amount.
- 11 **BE IT RESOLVED**, that for all mitigation and replacement water rights administered within the boundary of Water District 36A, the Water Master shall require lockable and controllable structures at all points of delivery and measuring devices approved by both the Water District 36A Water Master and IDWR. Costs for structures and devices shall be paid by the owner of the water right being used for mitigation or replacement purposes.

## **WATER DISTRICT 36A – PROPOSED RESOLUTIONS FOR 2017**

- 1 BE IT RESOLVED**, that hereafter the annual meeting of Water District 36A shall be held on the third Tuesday in January each year.
- 2 BE IT RESOLVED**, that the amounts payable by each ditch, association, canal company, or other water user, as shown by the approved budget, shall become due and payable upon receipt and delinquent on April 15<sup>th</sup>, and said amount, if not paid, shall bear a penalty of 10% and interest from that date until paid, at a rate of 1% per month.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED**, that no ditch, association, canal company, or other water user shall have the right to demand and receive water, and the Water Master shall not deliver to such person(s) or entity(ies), until the amount due and payable from such user(s), as fixed by the budget, has been paid.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Water Master shall be in service for a full year, commencing on February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year and continuing until the following January 31<sup>st</sup>, or until his successor as been duly qualified and elected.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED**, that Frank Erwin be elected Water Master of Water District 36A for the ensuing year, beginning February 1, 2017, and ending January 31, 2018.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED**, that Linda Lemmon be elected Secretary/Treasurer for Water District 36A for the ensuing year, beginning February 1, 2017, and ending January 31, 2018.
- 7 BE IT RESOLVED**, that the elected Treasurer of Water District 36A should only disburse monies from the Water District accounts upon a voucher approved by the Water Master. All Water District checks can be signed either by the Treasurer or Chairman, but must be co-signed by an Advisory Board Member. Advisory Board Members Howard Morris and Billy McCarthy shall serve for the purpose of co-signing all Water District 36A checks.
- 8 BE IT RESOLVED**, that Water District 36A assessments shown in the adopted budget shall constitute a final determination of the amount due for that year (per Idaho Code 42-612).
- 9 BE IT RESOLVED**, that Water District 36A assessments shall be based on the most recent reliable data available to the Water Master and shall be assessed in 24-hour second feet (per Idaho Code 42-612).

## **Water District 36A – Annual Meeting**

**January 19, 2016**

American Legion Hall, Hagerman, ID

- (1 & 2) Gary Lemmon, 2015 Advisory Board Chairman, opened the meeting at 1:02 pm and introduced the current Advisory Board members in attendance, Water Master Frank Erwin, Secretary/Treasurer Linda Lemmon, and Water District 130 Water Master Cindy Yenter and Nathan Erickson, IDWR Staff Hydrologist from the Twin Falls office.

Handouts available at the sign in sheet included: Agenda for today's meeting, Minutes from the January 20, 2015 Annual Meeting, Minutes from the December 4, 2015 Advisory Board meeting, the 2015 Treasurer's Report and Proposed 2016 Water District Budget, and the proposed 2016 Resolutions. Twenty three people were in attendance representing 18 of the 65 diversions in the District.

### **(3) Election of Meeting Chairman**

Frank Erwin led the election of the Meeting Chairman to run today's annual meeting. ***A motion was made by Bud Huntley and seconded by David Cropper that Gary Lemmon be elected as Chairman to run today's meeting.*** No other nominations were made. ***Motion carried by voice vote with none opposed.***

### **Election of Water District 36A Advisory Board for FY 2016**

Gary Lemmon asked for nominations from the floor. ***David Cropper moved that Gary Lemmon, Bud Huntley, Billy McCarthy, John Mavencamp, Howard Morris, Dennis Newman and Dan Yore be reelected to the Advisory Board for fiscal year 2016. Bud Huntley seconded the motion.*** No other nominations were offered and the nominations were closed. ***Motion passed by voice vote, with none opposed.***

### **(4) Approval of FY 2015 Annual Meeting Minutes**

***A motion was made by David Cropper and seconded by Bud Huntley to approve the minutes from the January 20, 2015 Annual Meeting as written and presented. Motion carried by voice vote, with none opposed.***

Gary mentioned that the minutes from the December 7, 2015 Advisory Board meeting were also passed out but would not be approved at this meeting. The Advisory Board meets each December to discuss the budget and resolutions to be proposed at the annual meeting.

### **(5) Presentation of the 2015 Treasurer's Report and Adoption of Proposed 2016 Budget**

Frank Erwin reviewed the handout titled *Water District 36A Budget Summary (as of 12/31/15)* which included both the 2015 Treasurer's Report (adopted and actual budgets) and the 2016 Proposed Budget. Linda explained that one assessment had not been received, but that it was her fault it was late and she was working with USFWS to set up a federal account so that it can be collected now and in the future.

Using the same handout, Frank reviewed the proposed 2016 Budget for the District which included an assessment rate of \$ 0.50/24-hr second ft, the same as last year. Linda explained that the office expense category included the cost to purchase envelopes (the last box was purchased in 2011). Responding to a question, Frank said he didn't believe there would be any mitigation cases that would require him to travel to



Boise for hearings in 2016. Nevertheless, \$100 was included in the travel category in the proposed budget just in case. Otherwise, the budget remained relatively unchanged from last year.

***A motion to accept the proposed as presented was made by Bud Huntley and seconded by Kathie McKenzie. Motion carried by voice vote, with none opposed.***

**(6) Adoption of 2016 Resolutions**

Linda Lemmon reviewed the handout titled *Water District 36A - Proposed Resolutions for 2016* which described the rules under which the District operates annually. The eleven proposed resolutions were essentially the same as last year – only the years were updated.

***David Cropper moved and Bud Huntley seconded that the 2016 proposed resolutions be adopted as written. There was no further discussion. Motion carried by voice vote, with none opposed.***

**(7) Water Master's Report & Goals for 2016**

Frank reminded everyone to make sure they were measuring flows accurately and reporting all requested information on the annual report forms. He said most people now understand how to fill out the totalizing meter forms. He would still like to see the PCCs changed to meters as soon as practical as they are more accurate, but Cindy commented that she didn't see any glaring errors recently.

Frank also explained that IDWR is changing its policy on checking and calibrating meters. IDWR now says that if the meter has been chosen from the IDWR-approved list and installed according to the manufacturer's recommendations and specs that IDWR won't require the District to calibrate it. Until now, Cindy or other IDWR personnel have calibrated meters at no cost to the District, and Frank thanked them for that service. Frank does make independent measurements throughout the irrigation season and will know if flows reported on the annual report are incorrect.

Responding to a question, Frank answered that spring flows along Billingsley Creek this year appear to be comparable to last year, but it is still too soon to know if that indicates stabilization. An Idaho Power employee told him they believed that flows below Milner were down compared to last year.

**(8) Additional News & Updates**

The current recharge program was reviewed. Cindy reported figures released by IDWR that 26,819 acre feet had been recharged to date this season, which is far below the goal of 250,000 acre feet annual average. Meters are to be installed at the Sandy Pond site so that WD36A and WD 130 can measure recharge flows intended for specific mitigation actions.

Cindy Yenter reported: (a) since IGWA began delivering water to Rangen through the Rangen-Magic Springs pipeline last year that there has been cooperation between WD 36A and WD 130 on measuring and reporting efforts. Last year, all water delivered to Rangen was re-diverted below Rangen to the Curren and Buckeye diversions, so no extra water ran down Billingsley Creek; (b) the term sheet between the Surface Water Coalition and groundwater users was finalized but implementing the various actions has proven difficult. GW users plan to install 4000 flow meters on wells on the ESPA; (c) IDWR created new water districts in the Big/Little Wood area, Raft River (groundwater only), and Mt. Home (groundwater only).
