Rules for Record ping

- 1. Use the daily record book or personal spreadsheet.
- 2. Use a separate daily record book for each stream you administer. Do not mix the users of several streams into one daily record.
- 3. If the water being delivered is measured and the headgate set on a particular day, record the flow in cubic feet per second in the proper grid space. If water diverted at a particular diversion continues to be delivered without a change in the flow or head gate setting, place an 'A' in the grid space for that day. The 'A' represents that the previous flow and head gate setting is "assumed." An 'A' must always be preceded by an actual numerical flow rate.
- 4. If the water being delivered is not actually measured, enter an 'E' in the grid space under the column *Meas*. *Method* for the particular day that the flow rate is estimated. An 'E' should always follow an estimated numerical flow that is observed and set in the field.
- 5. If water is not being delivered, enter a '0' (zero) in the proper grid space. If the water right is cut off because of unavailability of water, a zero may be entered in the grid space corresponding to the day the right could no longer be satisfied, and all subsequent days when water is not deliverable may be designated with a horizontal line through the grids that represent the days of non-delivery.
- A blank grid space means that you have no knowledge of the amount of water being delivered on that day. A grid should never be blank while you, as watermaster, are delivering water.
- 7. If possible, list the water right number in the daily record rather than a number assigned by the district or by the decree. Future users of the records will likely look for a water right reference. If there are multiple rights at a diversion, please list the most senior right first. You may supplement this book with a list of water rights by priority for each diversion.
- 8. Record unusual or noteworthy happenings. For instance, if a senior downstream right holder's water right is no longer available because the creek dries up upstream, and junior upstream right holders are allowed to divert remaining water upstream, this event should be recorded on the day it happens.
- If necessary or requested, you should submit a separate water rights list or reference sheet that associates water rights with current owners and diversion names.

Rules for Record Keeping

- 1. Use the daily record book or personal spreadsheet.
- 2. Use a separate daily record book for each stream you administer. Do not mix the users of several streams into one daily record.
- 3. If the water being delivered is measured and the headgate set on a particular day, record the flow in cubic feet per second in the proper grid space. If water diverted at a particular diversion continues to be delivered without a change in the flow or head gate setting, place an 'A' in the grid space for that day. The 'A' represents that the previous flow and head gate setting is "assumed." An 'A' must always be preceded by an actual numerical flow rate.
- 4. If the water being delivered is not actually measured, enter an 'E' in the grid space under the column *Meas*. *Method* for the particular day that the flow rate is estimated. An 'E' should always follow an estimated numerical flow that is observed and set in the field.
- 5. If water is not being delivered, enter a '0' (zero) in the proper grid space. If the water right is cut off because of unavailability of water, a zero may be entered in the grid space corresponding to the day the right could no longer be satisfied, and all subsequent days when water is not deliverable may be designated with a horizontal line through the grids that represent the days of non-delivery.
- A blank grid space means that you have no knowledge of the amount of water being delivered on that day. A grid should never be blank while you, as watermaster, are delivering water.
- 7. If possible, list the water right number in the daily record rather than a number assigned by the district or by the decree. Future users of the records will likely look for a water right reference. If there are multiple rights at a diversion, please list the most senior right first. You may supplement this book with a list of water rights by priority for each diversion.
- 8. Record unusual or noteworthy happenings. For instance, if a senior downstream right holder's water right is no longer available because the creek dries up upstream, and junior upstream right holders are allowed to divert remaining water upstream, this event should be recorded on the day it happens.
- 9. If necessary or requested, you should submit a separate water rights list or reference sheet that associates water rights with current owners and diversion names.





2017 ASSESSMENT FEE

We increased our water fee to \$8.00 per share 2 years ago when we could see that several repair projects were needed. Since we have \$11,000+ in retained funds this year, Basil Fairchild suggested that we reduce the fee to \$5.00 per share, the Jared Bedke said he had figured it out and that \$4.00 per share would give us sufficient money to work with. At \$4.00 per share, we would be adding about \$5,000 to our retained monies. The water users agreed that \$4.00 would be our assessment fee this year. Jerry Marchant mentioned that an emergency assessment fee could be called for if we got into financial distress.

<u>MOTION</u> to accept the reduction of the assessment fee from \$8.00 to \$4.00: Jared Bedke <u>MOTION</u> seconded by: Ryan Hawker

Jerry Marchant told us about his recent trip to Phoenix and how farmers are using drones to spray weeds. It was interesting to think about all of the potential ways that technology may be able to help farmers and ranchers in the future. For example, spraying in areas that equipment has not been traditionally able to get into.

Our annual meeting is scheduled for Thursday, January 11, 2018. Water users want to continue with updates that pertain to use of the water in the Basin.

ELECTION of 2016 WATER BOARD MEMBERS

WATER REPORT

Danielle Bedke Helms's <u>WATER REPORT of the 2015 SEASON</u> was read aloud and discussed. This report was available for water users to have an individual copy and preread it before the meeting started. (Danielle was unable to attend the meeting because her daughter was having a medical procedure in Salt Lake City. Board Members were contacted about her absence before the meeting and Danielle made the copies for water users to read.)

Nathan Erickson talked about high water and how to measure it. Danielle had a question about measuring and recording high water. She had made an estimate. We are off rotation on high water times, so the Water Master is to report this time as <u>full</u> <u>delivery</u>.

Discussion to hire Danielle Bedke Helms as the WATER MASTER for the 2015 season. All present were in agreement about this. Her wage would be \$5,000 paid in 6 payments of \$750.00 per month (April thru September) equaling \$4,500 and the remaining \$500 paid when her Annual Water Report was presented to the Board.

<u>ALL</u> water users, present at the meeting, accepted this motion. Eugene said that he would discuss this information with Danielle.



ASSESSMENT
