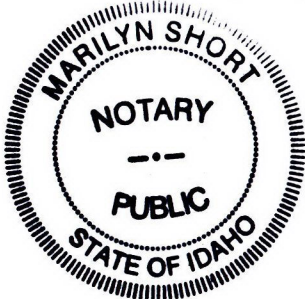

President, Blake Matthews called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. The meeting was held at the Oakley Canal Company Office at 100 West Elm Street, Oakley, Idaho.

I. Elections:

1. Meeting Secretary: Ryan Cranney made a motion to appoint Marilyn Short the meeting secretary, Eugene Matthews seconded the motion. All agreed, motion carried.

2. Election of Officers: Ryan Cranney made a motion that the officers remain the same for another year. Jim McBride seconded the motion. All agreed, motion carried. The officers will remain as follows:

Blake Matthews – president
Tim Payton – Sec/ treas.

3. Water master appointment: Ryan Cranney made a motion to continue the contract with Oakley Canal Co. for Water master responsibilities, with Chantry Whittle acting as the water master, for the same fee of \$5000. Jim McBride seconded the motion, all approved, motion carried.

II. Minutes:

The minutes of the 2016 Annual Birch Creek meeting were read by Blake Matthews. Jim McBride made a motion to approve the minutes, Ryan Cranney seconded the motion, all approved, motion carried.

III. Financial Report:

Marilyn Short was asked to present a financial report. The current bank balance is \$23,089.44. Two fees were presented for payment: \$5000.00 to Oakley Canal Company for the 2016 water master fees and \$300.00 to Marilyn Short for Secretarial Fees. Jim McBride made a motion to pay the bills, Tim Payton seconded the motion all agreed, motion carried.

The 2017 budget was discussed, and it was decided to keep the budget of \$8300.71 the same as 2016. Jim McBride made a motion to keep the water

assessments the same plus an additional \$1.50 on each bill to cover the billing fee charged by the county. Ryan Cranney seconded the motion, all agreed, motion carried.

There was discussion about other possible expenses this year. After much discussion about measuring the water that goes over the Birch Creek feeder it was decided to install two devices this year, one at each end of the Birch Creek feeder. Birch Creek would pay for them and OCC would build the structures for the devices. \$5000 would be allotted for this. Jim McBride made a motion to allot money to install 2 measuring devices at each end of the Birch Creek feeder. Tim Payton seconded the motion, all agreed, motion carried.

Delinquent bills were discussed and how best to take care of them. Nathan Ericson took down the names of the ones we can't find and will try to help us locate the new owners of the land.

IV. Water master Report: The water master report was given by Chantry Whittle. Birch Creek had very little water last year so few benefitted from it. Manning's used 9447" and Cranny's used 8404".

V. Old Business:

1. Discussion about the need for a structure to be constructed at the Birch Creek diversion was held. Blake Matthews mentioned that it is possible we could get help from the flood district to build it. The general consensus was that it's time for the advisory board to meet with James Mullen and get the plans started on this project. The need to take care of the problem has become urgent. The meeting was set for January 26th at 8:00 am to assess the situation, take measurements and make plans for the project.
2. The trade agreement was again proposed and explained by James Mullen. There was a great deal of discussion on the subject and many suggestions ranging from measuring the early water to a permanent trade agreement for 2016. Earl Dayley made a motion to sign the trade agreement for 2016. Brett Jones seconded the motion, all agreed, motion carried.
3. There was discussion about the need for purchasing more pipe for piping water to town. We need 1200 feet of 8" pipe. It was mentioned that we need a map showing where Dutch Robinson's lines are so we know where to tie in new lines. It was also mentioned that there is an urgency in this matter since Dutch's health is declining. Brett Jones said he will get a map and due to the fact that the canal company is tied up with pipe line projects and won't be able to help with Birch Creek's projects, this was tabled for now. There are still easements that haven't been signed.

VI. New Business:

1. The trade agreement was again discussed. Chantry Whittle's proposal was read by Blake Matthews and presented for discussion. The proposal guarantees water to town people every year even dry year. Several suggestions were made and Chantry was asked to make a couple of changes before presenting it to the

OCC board for approval. Ryan Cranney made a motion that the proposal be presented to the OCC board of directors for their approval, Jim McBride seconded the motion, all agreed, motion carried.

2. Blake Matthews suggested that a committee be formed to meet with James Mullen and work with him on the projects that need to be done this year. Jim McBride made a motion to form a committee consisting of Jim McBride, Tim Payton, Ryan Cranney, and Ryan Hawker, to meet with James Mullen on any future Birch Creek projects.
3. Chantry Whittle mentioned that Earl Dayley had asked the board if anything can be done about cleaning out the ditches from Judy's café to Poplar Street. The ditch runs through property that is badly neglected. There was much discussion on the matter and it will be looked into.

The next Annual board meeting was scheduled for Monday, January 8th, 2018 at 10:00 am at the Oakley Canal Company office. Ryan Cranney made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Tim Payton seconded the motion and meeting was adjourned at 12:10.

Blake Matthews called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m. The meeting was held at the Oakley Canal Company Office at 100 West Elm Street, Oakley, Idaho.

I. Elections:

1. Meeting Secretary: Tim Payton made a motion to appoint Marilyn Short meeting secretary, Jim McBride seconded the motion. All agreed, Motion carried
2. Election of Officers: Jim McBride made a motion that the officers remain the same for another year. Tim Payton seconded the motion. All agreed and the officers will remain as follows:
Blake Matthews – President
Tim Payton – Sec/treas
3. Water master appointment: Tim Payton made a motion to continue the contract with Oakley Canal Co. for Water master responsibilities, with Chantry Whittle appointed to act as Water master. Earl Dayley seconded the motion, all approved, motion carried.

II. Minutes:

The minutes of the 2015 Annual Birch Creek meeting were read by Blake Matthews. Jim McBride made a motion to approve the minutes, Tim Payton seconded the motion, all approved, motion carried.

III. Financial Report:

Marilyn Short was asked to present a financial report. The current bank balance is \$23,089.44. Two fees were presented for payment: \$5000.00 to Oakley Canal Company for the 2016 water master fees and \$300.00 to Marilyn Short for Secretarial Fees. Jim McBride made a motion to pay the bills, Tim Payton seconded the motion all agreed, motion carried.

The 2016 budget was discussed. There was discussion about possible expenses this year such as building a structure at the diversion and possibly purchasing pipe for future projects. It was decided to keep the budget of \$8300.71 the same as 2015. Jim McBride made a motion to keep the water assessments the same with the exception of adding \$1.50 to each bill to cover the billing fee charged by the county. Brett Jones seconded the motion, all agreed, Motion carried.

Delinquent bills were discussed and how best to take care of them.

Delinquent bills: Jamie Castaneda, Nels Peterson, Joseph Whitely owe for 2015 & Mike Wands is delinquent from 2011.

IV. Watermaster Report:

The water master report was explained by James Mullen. Birch Creek had very little water last year so few benefitted from it. Brett Jones made a motion to accept the Watermaster report. Earl Dayley seconded the motion, all agreed, motion carried.

V. Old Business:

PASP
1. Jim McBride asked about billing Dutch Robinson for his portion of the survey bill. The total bill was for \$1563.50. After discussion it was decided that Dutch's portion should be \$350. Marilyn will send him a bill for that amount.

2. The trade agreement with Oakley Canal Company was discussed. Marilyn Short gave Blake Matthews a copy of it to read and discuss. Jim McBride made a motion to continue with the trade agreement for the 2015 season. Tim Payton seconded the motion, all agreed, motion carried. Blake signed the agreement for the 2015 season.

NOT DONE
3. James Mullen suggested the need to construct something solid at the lower diversion of Birch Creek. There was discussion about the collection of dirt and debris which poses a problem every year. Also there is a problem with the willows needing to be cleaned out. James suggested that he and the committee go up there together this spring and take a look at the situation and find a solution to the problem.

4. Ron Abromovich was visiting from the NRCS Snowtel office. He presented some interesting insights on the current weather pattern which are affecting our weather. He explained the things they use to predict our weather and amount of moisture we will receive for the season. He showed the graphs of weather patterns and explained what we may expect for moisture this spring. It looks like February will warm up and the storms will go around us. At the current time we are 130% of normal in our moisture level but that will drop to possibly 55% by April. The outlook is still favorable as we are slightly ahead of last year in snowfall.

5. James Mullen mentioned that there is someone interested in trading Birch Creek shares of water for Oakley Canal Shares. He also mentioned that he was just notified that pipe prices have dropped 30%.

VI. New Business:

Blake Mathews mentioned that it is possible we could get help from the flood district to build it. Birch Creek Trade Agreement

As the upper water users of Birch Creek, we realize that it can be a struggle to get water into town and beyond. Therefore we agree to trade some of our canal water shares to accommodate the other users of Birch Creek, on the following conditions.

1. Water will not be traded until April 15th, at the earliest, or when the Oakley Canal Company turns their water into the canal system.
2. The earlier water is not as valuable to us as our canal shares, yet anyone who wants water before this date can still have as much as they are entitled to, delivered through the Birch Creek system. Just remember to order it through the Watermaster a day or more in advance.
3. After April 15th or water turn on for Oakley Canal Co. we will only trade if we are using the whole ditch. If there is water over and above what we are using on that given day or week, the water master will make it available to you. Again remember to call in advance to order water.
4. We feel that on a yearly average the amount of water that the town people, Tim Payton, and Critchfields own in value is equal to the amount of 90 shares of canal water. Therefore we hesitate to trade more than 90 shares of Oakley Canal water shares. If we are within the season and we have traded the maximum amount of 90 shares and you have used all of your allotted amount, but you were still entitled to more of what water is still in the creek we will make arrangements for the delivery of that water, if there is more than 80 inches in the creek.

Birch Creek Stream flow Storage with the Oakley Canal Co.

This proposal is to arrange for the OCC (Oakley Canal Company) to store and deliver water for the Birch Creek water stream flow rights that reside in the City of Oakley.

1. Birch Creek users will pay the OCC the same allotment rate that the OCC Share holders pay. (2017 rate is \$19.00 per share)
2. The Birch Creek users allotment will be based in the "Trade agreement list" that has been followed since around 2006. (See attached list)
3. This is based on 80 shares to be divided among the Birch Creek users.
4. OCC will use the OCC delivery bylaws that have been established and followed for delivery of the water.
5. No water will be carried over to the following year and Birch Creek water will be subtracted first if users have shares in the OCC.
6. Scenario= Lonnie Stringham has the equivalency if .22 Birch Creek shares of water in the OCC system. If the full allotment was 18", we times that by 2.1= 37.8" X .22= 8.316" to be used in that year. His share for OCC storing his Birch Creek water would be \$4.18
