Enclosed herewith is a copy of the Watermaster's Annual Report for the past season.

The same has been prepared by the watermaster and approved by this Department in conformity with Sections 42-610, 42-614 and 42-615, Idaho Code.

During the 1993 legislative session, the legislature enacted a new law which amends Section 42-619(9), Idaho Code and removes the independent financial audit requirement for most state water districts. The new law, referenced by Section 67-450B, Idaho Code (copy enclosed) identifies minimum audit requirements for all local government entities. Under the new statute, the governing body of any local government entity (i.e.; water district) whose annual budget does not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) has no minimum audit requirements under this section. This means that any district which handles its own money and whose budget is one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or less does not have to have an independent public account firm conduct a financial audit every few years as previously required by Section 42-619(9).

Please note that only the statutory requirement regarding the independent financial audit has been changed. Districts handling their own fund (i.e.; districts who collect and / or disburse their own funds) must still submit their own statement of the water district's financial affairs at the end of each fiscal year. As recommended in the Department's February 16, 1993 letter and the 1993 Watermaster Handbook, a copy of the financial statement may be submitted either with the annual water masters report or with the minutes of the annual meeting for the ensuing year. An example of an annual financial statement may be found in Appendix C of the 1993 Watermaster Handbook.

The purpose of this letter is to remind all water districts that workers compensation insurance is required for all water district employees. This requirement applies to all water districts in Idaho, regardless of annual budget. Insurance should be applicable at least to all paid water district staff, including the water master as week as well as watermaster assistants, advisory committee, secretary and treasurer. The costs associated with workers compensation insurance is paid directly by the water district and should be considered an expense of the district. For information about obtaining insurance costs etc., please contact the Idaho State Insurance Fund. The State Insurance Fund has offices in Boise, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho Falls, Pocatello and Twin Falls. Water Districts are also reminded that all paid water district staff may be subject to state and federal taxes. These tax requirements will vary depending on salaries and total income of each watermaster or employee. In many water districts, particularly smaller districts with part-time staff, payment of watermaster or each employee. Districts may wish to contact the State Tax Commission or the Internal Revenue Service for information about state and federal withholding taxes.

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 P.M. in Room 103 at the Brooklyn Annex by Chairman Jack Jakovac.

Members Present

Attending the meeting were: Jack Jakovac, Bob Loucks, Gary Thomas, Mike & Carolyn Thomas, Robert Jensen & Andrea Daine. Barbara Peets. Alfonso Martinez, Tom Stephenson, Vicki Colston, Lynn and Heather Thomas, Rick Sager, Morgan Peets, and Rob Whitney and Cindy Yenter from IDWR. All water rights except David Yoder, Linda Davidson, and Kathy Jordan were represented.

Election of Officers

<u>Chairman</u> – Jack Jakovac was nominated and unanimously elected. <u>Secretary-Treasurer</u> – Bob Loucks was nominated and unanimously elected.

Budget

Financial Statements including Income, Disbursements, and Budgets for 2014, 2015, and 2016 were presented. Motion: (Loucks-Tom Stephenson) That the financial statements be accepted. Motion: carried. After considerable discussion of the financial situation of the District, the following motion was offered. Motion: (T. Stephenson-Sager) That the budget for 2017 be \$3500. Motion carried.

Watermaster

Gary Thomas was nominated by Rick Sager and unanimously elected.

Resolutions

Cindy Yenter suggested the operation of the District would be facilitated if some continuing resolutions were adopted. Bob amended some suggested resolutions from a District in S. Idaho. The following resolutions were suggested:

- 1. The Treasurer of Water District 74J is hereby authorized to collect the assessments of the Water District in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-618.
- 2. Given that the water district cost for administering water for many water users is greater than their normal assessments would be based upon their total annual use of water, it is resolved that pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-612 (4) the Treasurer of Water District 74J is authorized to assess a \$25 minimum charge for watermaster services for water users in the District.
- 3. In accordance with Idaho Code § 42-612 (5), the assessment amount for each individual user as shown in the annual adopted budget shall constitute a final determination of the amount due for that year. In the computation of assessments, the watermaster shall use a 4-year rolling average of diversions for each water user.
- 4. All payments for assessments not received by January 1 of the year following the billing date shall accrue penalties in the amount of 10% of the charge plus interest in the amount of 1% per month, as of the June 1 due date and as provided pursuant to Idaho Code Section 42-617. It is resolved that the Watermaster is authorized pursuant to Idaho Code Section 42-618, to withhold or suspend deliveries of water to any water user who has not paid their assessment charges.



- 5. The annual Water District 74J meeting shall hereafter be held on the first Thursday of March, of each year unless the Director of IDWR should find it necessary to change the meeting date or unless changed by resolution of the district at any annual meeting.
- The Watermaster is authorized as an employee of IDWR under Idaho Code § 42-1701(5) to make reasonable entry on lands within the district, in accordance with IDWR policy, to carry out the duties of the watermaster as instructed by IDWR.
- 7. The Watermaster will manage distribution of water within the District from POD Wi-3 (74-216J & 74-221). This POD has 2.81 cfs (140.5 miners inches) of water right. The Chairman of WD-74J will put the Watermaster on duty when only 2.0 cfs (100 miners inches) is delivered. At that point, the District will not be in regulation. When the creek flow approaches 1 cfs (50 miners inches) at POD Wi-3, the Watermaster will put the creek on regulation. In the interim between when the Watermaster is called out and when WD-74J goes to regulation, irrigators should confine themselves to diverting no more than 1.5X their water right. If there is any "surplus" water after the creek is on regulation, it will be shared equally among the water rights.

After considerable discussion of the applicability of the resolutions, the following motion was offered. Motion: (M.Thomas-M.Peets) That Resolutions 1 – 6 be adopted. Motion carried.

An additional Resolution was proposed. Motion: (L.Thomas-M.Peets) When the District is in regulation the Watermaster come at least twice weekly, with 24 hours notice for those with multiple diversions. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 2:30 p.m.
