All watermasters shall make an annual report to the department of water resources prior to the expiration of the watermaster's appointment for the current year. This report shall show the total amount of water delivered by the watermaster during the preceding year, the amount delivered to each water user, the total expense of delivery and the apportionment of expenses among users and all debits and credits to be carried over to the following year. Such report shall also include records of stream flow the watermaster used or made in the process of distributing water supplies. The director may ask for other information deemed necessary in assuring proper distribution of water supplies within the district. The reports of watermasters to the department of water resources shall be filed and kept in the office of the department.

Instructions For Completing Annual Watermaster's Report

This form has been developed to assist the watermaster in complying with some of the annual reporting requirements of Section 42-606, Idaho Code. The form provides for summary of the amount of water delivered by the watermaster to each user, the total expense of delivery and the apportionment of expenses among water users, including debits and credits. Water distribution and hydrologic information including stream flow records, daily diversion data, water right information and water right priority cut summaries should be presented in a separate water distribution report.

Complete this annual report form of delivery and costs as follows:

- 1) Enter water right holder name, corresponding IDWR water right number or numbers, and corresponding diversion name and/or remarks on page 2;
- 2) Enter the total amount of water delivered to each user as total 24-hour second feet under column 1, page 3. Total **24-hour second feet** is a flow rate expressed in terms of one day or 24 hours. For example, a continuous diversion of 2 cfs over 20 days would equal 40 24-hour second feet.
- 3) Under column 3, page 3, enter the amount of money assessed or billed to each user at the beginning of the year. The assessment may be found in the previous year's adopted budget report.
- 4) In the work space provided on the right hand side of page 3, add up total watermaster salary costs and expenses and enter as 'TOTAL COST'. Then divide this total cost by the total number of 24-hour second feet delivered (sum of column 1) to obtain the cost per 24 hour second feet delivered, or the unit cost factor.
- 5) Under column 2, page 3, multiply the unit cost factor (obtained in step number 4 above) by each user's total 24-hour second feet delivery in column 1 to obtain the total cost against each user.
- 6) For each user, subtract the total cost amount in column 2 from the adopted budget in column 3 and enter the difference either as a credit or debit (negative differences entered as debits, positive differences entered as credits).
- Sign the report before a notary public and submit the original to the appropriate regional office of the Department of Water Resources. Retain one copy for the Water District.

Enclosed herewith is a copy of the Watermaster's Annual Report for the past season.

The same has been prepared by the watermaster and approved by this Department in conformity with Sections 42-610, 42-614 and 42-615, Idaho Code.

During the 1993 legislative session, the legislature enacted a new law which amends Section 42-619(9), Idaho Code and removes the independent financial audit requirement for most state water districts. The new law, referenced by Section 67-450B, Idaho Code (copy enclosed) identifies minimum audit requirements for all local government entities. Under the new statute, the governing body of any local government entity (i.e.; water district) whose annual budget does not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) has no minimum audit requirements under this section. This means that any district which handles its own money and whose budget is one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or less does not have to have an independent public account firm conduct a financial audit every few years as previously required by Section 42-619(9).

Please note that only the statutory requirement regarding the independent financial audit has been changed. Districts handling their own fund (i.e.; districts who collect and / or disburse their own funds) must still submit their own statement of the water district's financial affairs at the end of each fiscal year. As recommended in the Department's February 16, 1993 letter and the 1993 Watermaster Handbook, a copy of the financial statement may be submitted either with the annual water masters report or with the minutes of the annual meeting for the ensuing year. An example of an annual financial statement may be found in Appendix C of the 1993 Watermaster Handbook.



The purpose of this letter is to remind all water districts that workers compensation insurance is required for all water district employees. This requirement applies to all water districts in Idaho, regardless of annual budget. Insurance should be applicable at least to all paid water district staff, including the water master as week as well as watermaster assistants, advisory committee, secretary and treasurer. The costs associated with workers compensation insurance is paid directly by the water district and should be considered an expense of the district. For information about obtaining insurance costs etc., please contact the Idaho State Insurance Fund. The State Insurance Fund has offices in Boise, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho Falls, Pocatello and Twin Falls. Water Districts are also reminded that all paid water district staff may be subject to state and federal taxes. These tax requirements will vary depending on salaries and total income of each watermaster or employee. In many water districts, particularly smaller districts with part-time staff, payment of watermaster or each employee. Districts may wish to contact the State Tax Commission or the Internal Revenue Service for information about state and federal withholding taxes.



ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES -MARCH 19, 2016

The Annual Meeting was called to order March 19, 2016 at 1:12pm, in the "new" Salmon public library meeting room by Chairman/Secretary/Treasurer, Jesse Farmer-Lowell.

Those in attendance were Greg Lowell, Jesse Farmer-Lowell, Jeff Parker, Dale Edwards, James W. Miller, Robert L. Blackadar, Mike Wallingford, Gary Power, Ken Boese, Jim Austin, and John Goodman.

The Secretary read the March 21, 2015 Annual Meeting minutes. A motion was made by Bob Blackadar to approve the minutes as read, seconded by Jeff Parker, and was passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The Treasurer read the 2015 Financial Report. A motion was made by Dale Edwards to approve the Financial Report, seconded by James Miller, and was passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

Bob Blackadar stated that Dale Edward's assessment of \$60 was added to the Proposed Budget in 2006. Discussion took place regarding the fact that the assessment was annually included on the Water District 75-A Annual Proposed Budget. Bob Blackadar stated that he would like the payment for the Jesse Creek Lateral added as an assessment on the District 75-A Annual Proposed Budget. It was noted that at present, that payment is made separately to Greg Lowell as Water Master of the Jesse Creek Lateral by Bob Blackadar in a lump sum.

Greg said that there would be difficulties in mixing the Jesse Creek Lateral assessment with the Water District 75A budget.

SCANNED MAY 26 2016 Bob suggested that Dale Edward's Jesse Creek/Gorley Ditch Lateral assessment should be paid separately from the Water District.

Dale explained that the point of diversion is the same as the Water District.

Bob said it was a different compensation to the Water Master.

Discussion occurred and ended with a motion made by Jim Austin that a different section be added to the budget for Dale Edward's assessment. The motion was seconded by Gary Power, and passed unanimously

NEW BUSINESS

James Miller inquired if pipe is going to be put in at the ditch above the water plant. Gary Power answered, yes. He is checking on putting in 350 feet of pipe at a cost of \$12,000.

WATER MASTER'S REPORT

Greg told the water Users that during 2015 weather occurred causing a situation in which only the City was allowed to take water because of the low levels. He would have had to shut off water to all other Users in District 75-A. However, the City chose to pump water even though

they could have taken water from Jesse Creek The water pumped from the Salmon River by the City was not reported in the Annual Report, and the other water Users were allowed to take the remaining Water District 75-A water available.

Greg explained that there is no Water Master on the Salmon River, although some day there will be regulations, and a new person will handle the whole upper basin. Bob Blackadar brought up the fact that Greg took a vacation in August, and upon his departure, the water level immediately dropped drastically.

Greg explained that four Users were left in charge, and there were no changes requested during his vacation. He claimed to have "taken care of the matter with cooler evenings and rain". There was some humorous discussion, and it was decided that, indeed, there had been no problems.

COMPENSATIONS FOR WATER MASTER AND SECRETARY/TREAS.

Greg Lowell made a request that the Water Master's fee be paid in quarterly increments.

Dale Edwards made a motion to that effect for both the Water Master and the Chairman/Secretary/Treas. The motion was seconded by Bob Blackadar, and passed unanimously.

James Miller stated that both the fee paid to the Water Master and the Secretary should be doubled because of the work that they do.

Discussion followed during which Bob Blackadar suggested the Water Master's fee be increased by \$100.00 and the Secretary's fee be increased by \$50.00 as they bring a "wealth of expertise" to those positions.

James Miller made a motion that the Water Master's fee be increased by at least \$200.00 and the Secretary's fee be increased by \$100, and that the salaries be reconsidered each year. The motion was seconded by Gary Power, and passed unanimously.

Thereby, the Water Master's fee for 2016 will be \$1100.00 and the Secretary's fee for 2016 will be \$350.00



ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN/SECRETARY/TREASURER

ELECTION OF WATER MASTER

Gary Power made a motion that Greg Lowell remain in the position of Water Master and that Jesse Farmer-Lowell remain in the position of Chairman/Secretary/Treasurer for the year 2016.

Bob Blackadar seconded the motion, and it was passed unanimously.

APPOINTMENT OF CREDENTIALS AND ADVISORY COMMITTEE

It was suggested that James Miller, as the representative of the City of Salmon, the major water User, be a member of the Committee, along with Dale Edward, Bob Blackadar, and Jeff Parker, the Arrowhead representative. John Goodman made a motion to that effect. It was seconded by Bob Blackadar, and passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF THE 2016 PROPOSED BUDGET

Greg Lowell explained the traditional split of water fees between the District and the Users.

There was discussion about whether that traditional manner of payment should be continued in 2016 Following discussion, Bob Blackadar made a motion that the traditional payment split between the District and the Users will continue in 2016, and in 2017 Users will pay the full amount of the fee. The motion was seconded by Jeff Parker, and passed unanimously

It was noted that Shane Newton is no longer a water User, and will be removed from the 2016 Proposed Budget. With no further discussion, a motion was made by Bob Blackadar that the 2016 Proposed Budget be approved, seconded by James Miller, and was unanimously approved.

RESOLUTIONS

The following resolutions for governing Water District 75-A for the upcoming season of 2016 are as follows:

- 1. The 2017 Annual Water District 75-A meeting will be held at 1pm on Saturday, March 4th in the Library Conference room.
- 2. All payments are to be made to the Lemhi County Treasurer by June 1, 2016. Late payment will be subject to an 8% penalty fee.
- 3. The Water Master will withhold water until a User's assessment is paid.
- 4. The Water Master shall work from April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2017.
- 5. Gorley Creek water rights will be assessed a flat fee of \$60.00, not to be divided in half.
- 6. A charge of \$12.50 will be assessed each User named in the Adopted Budget of this District whose share of the total budget is less than \$25.00

OPEN DISCUSSION

Greg reported that efforts are being made by the Users to install additional measuring devices and fix any not working. He stated that it is a work in progress.

John Goodman reported that he installed an 18 inch culvert, solving the flood problem caused by Proksch's head gate. There are now three culverts at that location.

A motion to adjourn was then made by Bob Blackadar, seconded by Jeff Parker, and passed unanimously.
