Enclosed herewith is a copy of the Watermaster's Annual Report for the past season.

The same has been prepared by the watermaster and approved by this Department in conformity with Sections 42-610, 42-614 and 42-615, Idaho Code.

During the 1993 legislative session, the legislature enacted a new law which amends Section 42-619(9), Idaho Code and removes the independent financial audit requirement for most state water districts. The new law, referenced by Section 67-450B, Idaho Code (copy enclosed) identifies minimum audit requirements for all local government entities. Under the new statute, the governing body of any local government entity (i.e.; water district) whose annual budget does not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) has no minimum audit requirements under this section. This means that any district which handles its own money and whose budget is one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or less does not have to have an independent public account firm conduct a financial audit every few years as previously required by Section 42-619(9).

Please note that only the statutory requirement regarding the independent financial audit has been changed. Districts handling their own fund (i.e.; districts who collect and / or disburse their own funds) must still submit their own statement of the water district's financial affairs at the end of each fiscal year. As recommended in the Department's February 16, 1993 letter and the 1993 Watermaster Handbook, a copy of the financial statement may be submitted either with the annual water masters report or with the minutes of the annual meeting for the ensuing year. An example of an annual financial statement may be found in Appendix C of the 1993 Watermaster Handbook.

The purpose of this letter is to remind all water districts that workers compensation insurance is required for all water district employees. This requirement applies to all water districts in Idaho, regardless of annual budget. Insurance should be applicable at least to all paid water district staff, including the water master as week as well as watermaster assistants, advisory committee, secretary and treasurer. The costs associated with workers compensation insurance is paid directly by the water district and should be considered an expense of the district. For information about obtaining insurance costs etc., please contact the Idaho State Insurance Fund. The State Insurance Fund has offices in Boise, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho Falls, Pocatello and Twin Falls. Water Districts are also reminded that all paid water district staff may be subject to state and federal taxes. These tax requirements will vary depending on salaries and total income of each watermaster or employee. In many water districts, particularly smaller districts with part-time staff, payment of watermaster or each employee. Craig Crandall asked the Secretary to read the minutes from March 7th, 2016. Craig Crandall asked if there was any corrections to the minutes or corrections there was none. Jim Andrus made the motion to accept minutes as read. David Banks 2nd, motion passed. Craig Crandall asked for the financial statement to be read. Craig Crandall asked if there was any discussion, none. Tom Barnes made the motion to accept the financial as read, Steve Gravis 2nd, motion passed. Craig Crandall recommended Jim Andrus, Randy Morris, and Wayne Avery serve on the Credential committee and that we use 2016 billing for water if needed to vote. Attending Craig Crandall (President), Jim Andrus (Vice President), Wayne Avery (Secretary), Bryan Allen, Randy Morris, Tom Barnes, Mark Bennett, and James Cefalo (IDWR).

Craig Crandall called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. and welcomed everyone and asked for the 2016 minutes to be read. Craig asked for a motion to approve the minutes, Tom Barnes made the motion to approve the minutes as read, Bryon Allen 2nd, motion passed. Craig asked for the financial statement to be read, Randy Morris made the motion to accept the financial statement as read, Jim Andrus 2nd, motion passed.

Bryon Allen stated that we need to set aside money to do cleaning of the river, Jim advised that the work on the river was done and it was a success last fall. McCammon paid some on the cleaning, Glen Christiansen paid some, and Jim Andrus paid some. Randy Morris moved to accept Steve Hebdon proposed budget of \$46,000.00 plus a line item of \$4,000.00 to help cover expense's until money starts coming in from water users assessments instead of having an overdraft at the bank. This brings the total for the 2017 budget to \$50,000.00, Jim Andrus 2nd the motion, motion passed.

James Cefalo stated that the water district needs to start taking responsibility for the water master. Discussed Steve Hebdon's D.U.I. at length and addressed Bryon Allen's concerns. Address by James Cefalo, Mark Bennett stated that he called Steve Hebdon and talked to Steve for over two hours about his D.U.I. and Steve Hebdon stated he has not had a drink since September 16th, 2016.

Randy Morris has concerns about Steve Hebdon and if he is still capable of doing his job. Randy Morris stated that Steve Hebdon needs to be more accurate on his mileage and needs to get it turned in every year to the secretary. Discussed measurements of water coming into the reservoir and that all Steve Hebdon does is estimates, he does not measure it. Steve Hebdon needs to measure it three times a week. Bryon Allen said that we need to start looking for someone to replace Steve Hebdon when he retires. Tom Barnes stated that Steve Hebdon needs to have zero tolerance on drinking needs to turn in mileage and some guide lines on how often to check gates. Steve Hebdon arrived at 12:00 p.m. for the meeting.

The board discussed his drinking and his D.U.I. with him (Steve Hebdon). Steve Hebdon stated that he was done drinking, and that he is losing weight, so he will be able to do his job better. Jim Andrus made a motion that we hire Steve Hebdon as water master for the 2017 water season with a wage of \$16,000.00 and \$10,000.00 for expenses with better records from Steve Hebdon on mileage with zero tolerance on alcohol use and drugs of any kind, with the



exception of prescribed prescription from a licensed medical doctor, and the Board can insist from Steve Hebdon of a blood test at the River District's expense. The Board is the only one whom can request Steve Hebdon to take a blood test. All the board has to know about the request. Randy Morris 2nd the motion, motion passed.

Craig Crandall asked Steve Hebdon if he could agree to the above motion, Steve said all he request is one hour notice, it was agreed.

Advised, and discussed with Steve Hebdon about the outstanding assessments. Richard Davis wants to sell his water to a broker (maybe). Len Burris sold to Mike Doyle, Jim Andrus is to collect from Bristol Park. Craig Crandall told Steve Hebdon that the zero tolerance is 24-7 for the 2017 irrigation season. Steve Hebdon said no problem, Bryon Allen asked Steve Hebdon if some measuring device could be checked less and some more, Steve Hebdon advised yes, that would help him also. Wayne Avery asked about the liability Insurance, Tom Barnes stated he checked on Liability Insurance and it would cost about \$1,200.00 per year. James Cefalo stated he did not think we needed Liability Insurance, as we would be covered by the State Attorney General. Tom Barnes made the motion to adjourn, Randy Morris 2nd motion passed. Adjourned 1:20p.m.


