




During the 1993 legislative session, the legislature enacted a new law which amends Section 42-619(9), Idaho Code and removes the independent financial audit requirement for most state water districts. The new law, referenced by Section 67-450B, Idaho Code (copy enclosed) identifies minimum audit requirements for all local government entities. Under the new statute, the governing body of any local government entity (i.e.; water district) whose annual budget does not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) has no minimum audit requirements under this section. This means that any district which handles its own money and whose budget is one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or less does not have to have an independent public account firm conduct a financial audit every few years as previously required by Section 42-619(9).

Please note that only the statutory requirement regarding the independent financial audit has been changed. Districts handling their own fund (i.e.; districts who collect and / or disburse their own funds) must still submit their own statement of the water district's financial affairs at the end of each fiscal year. As recommended in the Department's February 16, 1993 letter and the 1993 Watermaster Handbook, a copy of the financial statement may be submitted either with the annual water masters report or with the minutes of the annual meeting for the ensuing year. An example of an annual financial statement may be found in Appendix C of the 1993 Watermaster Handbook.

The purpose of this letter is to remind all water districts that workers compensation insurance is required for all water district employees. This requirement applies to all water districts in Idaho, regardless of annual budget. Insurance should be applicable at least to all paid water district staff, including the water master as well as watermaster assistants, advisory committee, secretary and treasurer. The costs associated with workers compensation insurance is paid directly by the water district and should be considered an expense of the district. For information about obtaining insurance costs etc., please contact the Idaho State Insurance Fund. The State Insurance Fund has offices in Boise, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho Falls, Pocatello and Twin Falls. Water Districts are also reminded that all paid water district staff may be subject to state and federal taxes. These tax requirements will vary depending on salaries and total income of each watermaster or employee. In many water districts, particularly smaller districts with part-time staff, payment of watermaster or each employee. Districts may wish to contact the State Tax Commission or the Internal Revenue Service for information about state and federal withholding taxes.







Deputy Watermaster, Brett Murdock, discussed the 2016 Water District 32-C Watermaster's report as follows.

2016 WATER YEAR:

The 2016 water delivery was 17,930 A.F. of water compared to 16,325 A.F. in the previous year, a difference of 1,605 A.F. of water. April water delivery for 2016 was 798 A.F.

2016-17 SNOW COURSE MEASUREMENT:

Snow measurements at Irving Creek were 28 with 5.2 water content averaging 113% of normal. Weber Creek snow depth was 32 with 6.2 water content averaging 129% of normal. The average of the two creek drainages at 121% of normal. Measurements were taken March 2, 2017.

FINANCIAL REPORT AND BUDGET:

Deputy Watermaster, Brett Murdock, reviewed the 2016 budget explaining the expenditures. Brett then presented the 2017 proposed budget which would remain the same as last year. Brett reviewed the USGS measurements and the Medicine Lodge bed loss measurements with the water users.

WATERMASTER'S REPORT & BUDGET APPROVAL:

Chairman Tod Shenton asked for a motion to accept the proposed budget. Brock Egan made the motion to accept the proposed budget. Sid Brown seconded the motion. Motion passed.

ELECTION OF WATERMASTER:

Chairman Tod Shenton asked for nominations for Watermaster. Brion Egan made the motion Greg Shenton continue as Watermaster. Sid Brown seconded the motion. Garth Ashcraft moved that nominations cease. Nomination passed.

RESOLUTIONS:

Chairman Tod Shenton then asked the water users to adopt the following resolutions.

Headgates and Weirs

"All control devices and measuring devices shall be in good working order before water can be demanded and delivered. The Watermaster shall not deliver any water unless such devices are in good working order."

"All headgate systems that have return flow capability or a bypass channel for the water to return to Medicine Lodge must have a weir installed and functioning before water will be delivered."

Collection of Water Assessments

"No ditch, canal, or other water user shall have the right to demand and receive water until full payment due is paid. Payment shall become due April 1, and shall be come delinquent May 1, and if not paid by May 1, the payment shall bear interest from May 1, at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum.

The Watermaster shall not deliver any water until full payment due is paid."

Watermaster Term of Service

"The Watermaster shall be elected for a term of one full year. The purpose is so the Watermaster can serve in the legal capacity to do official business for the district in the event of emergencies, legislative actions, hearings, disputes or other water related or job related activities.

The Watermaster cannot be required to make water deliveries before April 1, or after November 1, (the normal irrigation season) unless an emergency exists. The Watermaster shall not be paid before April 1, or after November 1 from water district budgeted regular funds."

Pumping from Creek

"Prohibit any pumping directly form Medicine Lodge Creek as per the motion adopted 1980, which read as follows: "That no pumping be allowed from Medicine Lodge Creek or its tributaries, without first diverting and measuring water into a private pond or sump, to eliminate any interference with regulation of stream waters."

Calling the Deputy Watermaster to Duty

"The Deputy Watermaster shall be called to duty by the Watermaster for the remainder of the season at the request of three water users whose signatures shall authorize said action."

Deputy Term of Service

"The Deputy Watermaster shall be called to duty on May 1 to measure, record and regulate waters of Medicine Lodge Creek."

Pooling Agreement

"Be it resolved that the water users of Medicine Lodge Creek unanimously agree and direct the Watermaster to continue the practice of water right exchanges, which has been practiced since the formation of the stipulation and agreement dated March 2, 1954. Such practices shall include pooling of waters, rented waters, and exchanges beneficial to the users as a whole. The Watermaster is further directed not to deliver the above mentioned waters to a downstream user, until that water delivery amount(c.f.s.) is assessed a bed loss value to provide that no injury to an existing water right would occur. These losses should be assessed according to the average of U.S.G.S. bed losses measurements.

We further resolve that delivery of the above waters cannot be demanded prior to May 1, unless excess water exits the stream."

IDWR REPORT:

Cooper Fritz represented the IDWR and answered questions on the Surface Water Coalition and the participating members of the Idaho Ground Appropriators Agreement. Scott Clawson with Water District 110 has opened an office in Mud Lake to assist water users with questions they may have pertaining to the agreement.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Watermaster, Greg Shenton, reported on the cloud seeding in the area. Garth Ashcraft questioned a bridge structure on the creek south of his property. Discussion on Carl Taylor's stockwater request. Discussion on stockwater rights on creek.

MEETING TIME:

Brock Egan moved that next year's meeting is held on Tuesday March 13, 2018 at 1:00 p.m., at the Clark County Annex Building in Dubois, Idaho. Garth Ashcraft seconded the motion. Motion passed.






