Enclosed herewith is a copy of the Watermaster's Annual Report for the past season.

The same has been prepared by the watermaster and approved by this Department in conformity with Sections 42-610, 42-614 and 42-615, Idaho Code.

During the 1993 legislative session, the legislature enacted a new law which amends Section 42-619(9), Idaho Code and removes the independent financial audit requirement for most state water districts. The new law, referenced by Section 67-450B, Idaho Code (copy enclosed) identifies minimum audit requirements for all local government entities. Under the new statute, the governing body of any local government entity (i.e.; water district) whose annual budget does not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) has no minimum audit requirements under this section. This means that any district which handles its own money and whose budget is one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or less does not have to have an independent public account firm conduct a financial audit every few years as previously required by Section 42-619(9).

Please note that only the statutory requirement regarding the independent financial audit has been changed. Districts handling their own fund (i.e.; districts who collect and / or disburse their own funds) must still submit their own statement of the water district's financial affairs at the end of each fiscal year. As recommended in the Department's February 16, 1993 letter and the 1993 Watermaster Handbook, a copy of the financial statement may be submitted either with the annual water masters report or with the minutes of the annual meeting for the ensuing year. An example of an annual financial statement may be found in Appendix C of the 1993 Watermaster Handbook.

The purpose of this letter is to remind all water districts that workers compensation insurance is required for all water district employees. This requirement applies to all water districts in Idaho, regardless of annual budget. Insurance should be applicable at least to all paid water district staff, including the water master as week as well as watermaster assistants, advisory committee, secretary and treasurer. The costs associated with workers compensation insurance is paid directly by the water district and should be considered an expense of the district. For information about obtaining insurance costs etc., please contact the Idaho State Insurance Fund. The State Insurance Fund has offices in Boise, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho Falls, Pocatello and Twin Falls. Water Districts are also reminded that all paid water district staff may be subject to state and federal taxes. These tax requirements will vary depending on salaries and total income of each watermaster or employee. In many water districts, particularly smaller districts with part-time staff, payment of watermaster or each employee. Districts may wish to contact the State Tax Commission or the Internal Revenue Service for information about state and federal withholding taxes.

During the 1993 legislative session, the legislature enacted a new law which amends Section 42-619(9), Idaho Code and removes the independent financial audit requirement for most state water districts. The new law, referenced by Section 67-450B, Idaho Code (copy enclosed) identifies minimum audit requirements for all local government entities. Under the new statute, the governing body of any local government entity (i.e.; water district) whose annual budget does not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) has no minimum audit requirements under this section. This means that any district which handles its own money and whose budget is one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or less does not have to have an independent public account firm conduct a financial audit every few years as previously required by Section 42-619(9).

Please note that only the statutory requirement regarding the independent financial audit has been changed. ANNUAL WATER USERS MEETING BIRCH CREEK WATER DISTRICT #32-D

The Birch Creek Water District 32-D Water Users meeting was held March 14, 2017, 10:00 a.m. at the Clark County Annex Building, Dubois Idaho.

Chairman, Mac Wagoner, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Those attending were: Greg Shenton (Watermaster), Brett Murdock (Deputy Watermaster), Mac Wagoner (Chairman), Laurie Small (Secretary), James Palmer (representing Ted Sorenson), and Lane Newman.

Minutes were read individually. James Palmer made a motion to accept the previous year's minutes. Lane Newman seconded the motion. Motion passed.

NOMINATIONS FOR CHAIRMAN & SECRETARY:

Chairman, Mac Wagoner, asked for nominations for Chairman and Secretary. Lane Newman made a motion that Mac Wagoner continue as Chairman and Laurie Small continue as Secretary. James Palmer seconded the motion. Motion passed.

APPOINTMENT OF CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE:

WATERMASTERS REPORT:

Watermaster, Greg Shenton, presented the Watermaster's Report for the year 2016. The 2016 diverted flows totaled 16,136 A.F. down 1,095 A.F. from previous years diverted and recorded flows. Snow course measurements were 157% of average at Meadow Lake, 145% of average at Beagle Springs, 120% of average at Haun and 102% of average at Spring Mountain Canyon with the last snow measurements taken on February 28, 2017. Snotel data was acquired on February 28, 2017. Greg reported on averages on snow courses in surrounding areas and the cloud seeding program. Measurements on stream bed losses taken by contract with U.S.G.S. were included in the report.

Brett Murdock asked Wagoner Ranch place a plank across their ditch above their weir so measurements can be done.

Lane Newman asked about all time high and low water years, Greg said that could be included in future reports.

Watermaster, Greg Shenton, went over the 2016 budget and proposed 2017 budget.

RESOLUTIONS

James Palmer made a motion that the Water District adopts the following resolutions:

COLLECTION OF WATER ASSESSMENT

No ditch, canal, or other water user shall have the right to demand and receive water until full payment due is paid. Payment shall become due April 15, and shall become delinquent May 15, and if not paid by

May 15, the payment shall bear interest from April 15, at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum.

The Watermaster shall not deliver any water until full payment due is paid.

WATERMASTER TERM OF SERVICE

The Watermaster shall be elected for a term of one full year. The purpose is so the Watermaster can serve in the legal capacity to do official business for the district in the event of emergencies, legislative actions, hearings, disputes or other water related or job related activities. The Watermaster cannot be required to make deliveries before April 1, or after November 1, (the normal irrigation season) unless an emergency exists. The Watermaster shall not be paid before April 15, or after November 1, from the Water District budgeted regular funds.

HEADGATES & WEIRS

All control devices and measuring devices shall be in good working order before water can be demanded or delivered. The Watermaster shall not deliver any water unless such devices are in good working order.



USGS MEASUREMENTS

They agreed to continue with the 3 USGS measurement and it was included in the resolution motion.

WATER DELIVERY

Allow Brandie Terry, Scott Bridges, and Mrs. Sorenson to receive water for their lawns, with no daily records require, at no cost to them until any future changes are made.

Lane Newman seconded the motion. All 5 resolutions passed.
