SECTION 42-606 IDAHO CODE

REPORTS OF WATERMASTERS. All watermasters shall make an annual report to the department of water resources prior to the expiration of the watermaster's appointment for the current year. This report shall show the total amount of water delivered by the watermaster during the preceding year, the amount delivered to each water user, the total expense of delivery and the apportionment of expenses among users and all debits and credits to be carried over to the following year. Such report shall also include records of stream flow the watermaster used or made in the process of distributing water supplies. The director may ask for other information deemed necessary in assuring proper distribution of water supplies within the district. The reports of watermasters to the department of water resources shall be filed and kept in the office of the department.

Instructions for Completing Annual Watermaster's Report

This form has been developed to assist the watermaster in complying with some of the annual reporting requirements of Section 42-606, Idaho Code. The form provides for summary of the amount of water delivered by the watermaster to each user, the total expense of delivery and the apportionment of expenses among water users, including debits and credits. Water distribution and hydrologic information including stream flow records, daily diversion data, water right information and water right priority cut summaries should be presented in a separate water distribution report.

Complete this annual report form of delivery and costs as follows:

- Enter water right holder name, corresponding IDWR water right number or numbers, and corresponding diversion name and/or remarks on page 2;
- 2) Enter the total amount of water delivered to each user as total 24-hour second feet under column 1, page 3. Total 24-hour second feet is a flow rate expressed in terms of one day or 24 hours. For example, a continuous diversion of 2 cfs over 20 days would equal 40 24-hour second feet.
- 3) Under column 3, page 3, enter the amount of money assessed or billed to each user at the beginning of the year. The assessment may be found in the previous year's adopted budget report.
- 4) In the work space provided on the right hand side of page 3, add up total watermaster salary costs and expenses and enter as 'TOTAL COST'. Then divide this total cost by the total number of 24-hour second feet delivered (sum of column 1) to obtain the cost per 24 hour second feet delivered, or the unit cost factor.
- 5) Under column 2, page 3, multiply the unit cost factor (obtained in step number 4 above) by each user's total 24-hour second feet delivery in column 1 to obtain the total cost against each user.
- 6) For each user, subtract the total cost amount in column 2 from the adopted budget in column 3 and enter the difference either as a credit or debit (negative differences entered as debits, positive differences entered as credits).
- Sign the report before a notary public and submit the original to the appropriate regional office of the Department of Water Resources. Retain one copy for the Water District.

Chairman Walker then asked for a motion to elect a Chairman and a Secretary/Treasurer for the upcoming year. A motion to retain Brent Walker as Chairman and Alan Permann as the Secretary/Treasurer was made by James Robinson and seconded by Scott Hendrickson. Motion passed.

Chairman Walker asked Watermaster Brian Woodworth to report on the previous water year. "The 2017 water year was excellent on the East Fork of Rock Creek. Water users had full water rights throughout the watering season and no cuts were made. The south fork of Rock Creek was a different story. Much like last year, stream flow was short. The Landing ditch never saw much over 5" of water throughout the watering season and dipped to a low of 3.75" mid July. Although other ditches with South Fork diversions were subject to cuts, we did see some improvement by the first part of September."

Chairman Walker then asked for the financial report. Secretary Permann reported that \$7947.25 was spent the previous budget year out of a budget of \$8,300.00. The checking account has a balance of \$1693.81 as of 3/5/2018.

Chairman Walker asked if there were any applications for the position of Watermaster for the 2018 water year. Brian Woodworth said that he would apply for the position. Motion was made by Dan Ralphs and seconded by Mariah Farr to accept the application of Brian Woodworth as Watermaster for 2018. Motion passed.

Chairman Walker then asked secretary Permann to present a suggested budget for 2018. The following numbers were presented and discussed for a vote.

Secretary Permann reported that because of a new policy at Key Bank they were now charging a \$5.00 per month service charge for accounts that fell below \$2500.00 in a month. After some discussion a motion was made to allow Secretary Permann the right to move the District's money to another bank. Motion was made by Dan Ralphs and seconded by Brian Woodworth. Motion passed.

Chairman Walker asked if any problems had been brought to the attention of the Advisory committee. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to retain the same advisory committee as the previous year. A motion was made that Ronald L. Nelson, Rick Nelson and Scott Hendrickson serve as the Advisory Committee for 2018 by James Robinson and seconded by Ladd Permann. Motion passed.

Curtis Munk made a motion to adjourn the meeting until next year (2019), to be held on the first Monday of March at 1pm, seconded by James Robinson. Motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 1:35pm.

Also attached to this email is the legislative update from February with three bills that might be something to mention at the meeting if it applies.

HB370 - Will extend the time that is allowed for water district meeting to occur. Currently it is any day except Saturday and Sunday between the second Monday in January and the third Monday of March. The bill is proposing to change it to still not be on Saturday or Sunday and between the second Monday in January and the fourth Tuesday of May. It will also clarify the language about absentee and proxy voting not being allowed.

HB371 – This bill is specific to critical ground water areas... probably won't apply to any of the districts anyone is going to today.

HB372 – This is the bill changing the transfer application fees for updating water rights where no physical change will occur.
