



The annual meeting of the water users of Water District 47-C was held on March 4, 2019, at the office of Coleman, Ritchie & Jacobson, 156 2nd Avenue West, Twin Falls, Idaho, at 11:00 a.m.

The minutes of the 2018 Annual Meeting were read. After reading the previous year's meeting minutes, Brad Visser, moved to approve the minutes as read. The motion was seconded by Richard A. Rodgers. By unanimous vote the motion passed.

Upon motion by Richard A. Rodgers and seconded by Rod Gonzales, it was unanimously approved that David A. Coleman would act as Chairman of the meeting.

The Chairman announced that the next matter of business was the election of an advisory board to serve for the 2019 irrigation season. Upon motion duly made by Rod Gonzales and seconded by Richard A. Rodgers, the following persons were nominated and elected as the advisory committee for the Water District for the irrigation season of 2019:

Discussion then turned to a general discussion about the current water year and the hope for sufficient water. Ben Ruffing reported about the general condition of the cross-cut ditch.

After the foregoing discussion, no further items came before the meeting. Richard A. Rodgers moved to adjourn the meeting which was seconded by Rod Gonzales. The meeting was adjourned.
