The same has been prepared by the watermaster and approved by this Department in conformity with Sections 42-610, 42-614 and 42-615, Idaho Code.

During the 1993 legislative session, the legislature enacted a new law which amends Section 42-619(9), Idaho Code and removes the independent financial audit requirement for most state water districts. The new law, referenced by Section 67-450B, Idaho Code (copy enclosed) identifies minimum audit requirements for all local government entities. Under the new statute, the governing body of any local government entity (i.e.; water district) whose annual budget does not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) has no minimum audit requirements under this section. This means that any district which handles its own money and whose budget is one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or less does not have to have an independent public account firm conduct a financial audit every few years as previously required by Section 42-619(9).

Please note that only the statutory requirement regarding the independent financial audit has been changed. Districts handling their own fund (i.e.; districts who collect and / or disburse their own funds) must still submit their own statement of the water district's financial affairs at the end of each fiscal year. As recommended in the Department's February 16, 1993 letter and the 1993 Watermaster Handbook, a copy of the financial statement may be submitted either with the annual water masters report or with the minutes of the annual meeting for the ensuing year. An example of an annual financial statement may be found in Appendix C of the 1993 Watermaster Handbook.

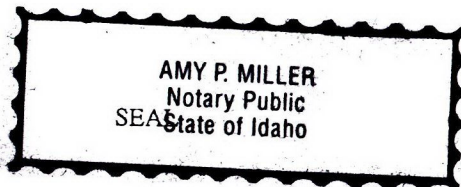

Devin asked about the financials of the district. James stated that the district spent \$3,569.20 and collected \$5,760.18. Garth made the motion. Lon T 2nd the motion the motion carried.

Next, Devin opened the elections for water master. Joel Teuscher was nominated. Nominations closed. Garth B made the motion to close nominations. Gary T seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Secretary/Treasurer: Garth B made the motion to retain existing secretary/treasurer. Tim T 2nd the motion. The motion carried.

Advisory board: The two members of the district that are up for election are Carson P and Derek B. The nomination was made for Derek B. and Richard L. The motion was made to close the nominations by Garth B. and Gary T. seconded the motion. The motion carried. Derek and Richard were voted on the advisory board.

Turned time over to Joel T for the past water year and start of the new year. Jon C, Carson P, and Keith P. have issues with one water right. Check each of your water rights. Make sure they are right. The base fee was lowered to \$10.00. The base fee is what every water holder pays just for owning the rights. Base fee generates \$2470.00 about and the water use brings in \$1838.00. Water costs \$.37 to deliver. We have the water fee set at \$.15. Joel said this year reminds him of the 2001 summer. Because the frost and little snow. Hope it will rain.

Janet asked about brake down of the water right #28 of the Taylor Canal rights. Joel stated that he did not know that at the moment but he has a list at home. Janet said their water right in the Taylor canal is separate. Issue was raised about the water rights 119, 120 which Laura W. and kirk W. were splitting be lowered to \$5.00. Janet said they are still only two rights. They are in the process of splitting the two rights which will make four rights. Joel stated that the base fee is \$10.00. Carson stated \$10.00 for CFS is fair.

Joel stated that the IDWR would like for the district to have 2 year reserve of funds to operate. James stated the bank account stands as of December 1st at \$9562.07. Robert B. asked about Thomas Fork Canal base fee is \$364.20 and a total assessment of \$1,046.20. The motion was made to keep the base fee at \$10.00 by Gary T. and Garth seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Joel reminded everyone present to pay before the water be turned on. And the metering device be working. It is the individual water right holders to have the devises repaired. Joel stated that the devises that don't work he measures at the high mark and for the amount of days of use.

Garth B made the motion to accept the budget and Lon T seconded. The motion carried.

Robert B asked about moving the measuring devise back where it was originally. The court ordered to put the measuring device down from the diversion.
