Specific measurement information for the diversions within the district can be found in IDWR's WMIS database. Water district staff also took periodic ground water level measurements at wells scattered throughout the district. This data is stored in IDWR's file and is available to the public. In addition to measurement activities, water district staff reviewed aerial photos and diversion records to identify and any enforcement issues within the district and contacted water users as necessary to address the apparent violations. Financial reports, minutes, resolutions, and assessment records are summarized and attaché in separate documents. – James Cefalo

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING

Water District 120 2014 Annual Meeting February 10, 2014

Meeting called to order at 1:19 pm by Tim Deeg.

An inclusive motion was made by Stephanie Mickelsen, seconded by Dane Watkins and so moved nominating Tim Deeg Meeting Chair and Wendy Murphy Secretary.

Dane Watkins moved to approve the 2013 Annual Meeting Minutes as written, Stephanie Mickelsen seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Wendy Murphy presented the financial report as of October 31, 2013. The Balance Sheet reflected \$214,316 in checking and savings and \$710 balance in the accounts receivables. There was a liability to IDWR at the end of the year of \$4,631. Total Liabilities and Equity were \$215,071. A Profit and Loss comparison was also presented. The IDWR contract was 76% of anticipated budget \$76,754. The district had a net loss of \$4,672 which was \$18,678 less than the budgeted amount. Stephanie Mickelsen moved to approve the financial report as presented. Steve Howser seconded the motion and the motion carried.

James Cefalo reported briefly regarding the staffing of the eastern region. Scott Bergendorf and Cooper Fritz did the measurements in 2013. Over the winter there were some staff changes in the office. Cooper and Scott accepted a change in duties and will now perform in office work handling transfers and new applications. Those vacancies were filled by Heather Bohac and Layton Walton. Heather and Layton will handle all of the measurements in the upcoming irrigation season. Cooper prepared and presented a summary of 2013 field work. There were 89 diversions on the visit list for Water District 120 measured wells. Eighty-one of the 89 sites were measured. Though steps are taken to try to visit wells when they are running four wells were not measured because they were never running. These wells are at the top of the 2014 site visit list. Additionally, depth to water table measurements were taken on eight wells. Upon completion, in the fall, the data from the field work are entered; the state office is notified of any wells that need flow meter repairs/updates; incorporating the power data; and a general clean-up of the WMIS data base is performed as well as adding new points of diversion to be assessed. Cooper reported the goals for 2014 are to finish the data entry for 2013 field work, inventory three new wells and bring them into WMIS, visit and take measurements on one third of the wells which are on the 2014 visit list including the eight that did not get measured in 2013, and continue the depth to water table measurements twice a year (Spring and Fall). Cooper covered water table measurements and in general water is down seven tenths of a foot from average. Because of internet connections the locations of the wells were not available this year. Well depth measurements can be found on Hydro.online. Snow water content information was also

reviewed. The averages are based on a 30 year moving average. The NRCS adjusted the average from 1971 through 2000 to 1981 through 2010. Because the 1970's were wet and 2000's were dry the new averages are about 13% lower. There is a 50% chance of no curtailment and a 30% chance of curtailment anything junior to May 31, 1989. Within Water District 120 if water rights are curtailed to May 31, 1989 that will affect 302 rights and 233 owners.

James reported that some administrative items that have been done this year. These items include reviewing the records of volumes being pumped and looking for those that have exceeded the volume on their water rights. This overuse when further investigated has revealed some issues. It was discovered with the overuse wells about 1/3 of the wells need some corrections within the WMIS database. Another 1/3 of the wells could be classified as negligible overuse (within 5% of TAV as a result of measurement error this small of a percentage does not warrant enforcement). And the other third of the wells need some attention. They have tied wells together into a single system or they may be irrigating without water rights.

Wendy presented resolutions #1 - #15 with the only revisions being to the dates. Stephanie Mickelson moved to adopt resolution 1-15 and corresponding budget for 2014. Garth VanOrden seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Wendy presented the Special Resolution regarding the Idaho Water Resource Board operations. Steve Howser moved to accept the Special Resolution as presented and forward to the IWRB and the Director of IDWR. Stephanie Mickelsen seconded the motion and the motion carried. There was mention about potentially having someone come to the ground water district meetings to discuss the Idaho Water Resource Board Water Bank process. Other concerns expressed were in relation to the water bank being used for new ground water development.

Stephanie Mickelsen made a motion to retain the current Advisory Board listed in the resolutions. Dane Watkins seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Gaylen VanOrden moved to adjourn. Stephanie Mickelsen seconded the motion and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 2:19 pm.

APPROVED RESOLUTIONS

Water District 120 2014 Resolutions

- 1. The annual Water District 120 meeting shall hereafter be held on the second Monday of February, of each year unless the Director of IDWR or the Water District 120 advisory committee should find it necessary to change the meeting date or unless changed by resolution of the district at any annual meeting.
- 2. The watermaster shall perform the duties as required by Chapter 6, Title 42, Idaho Code and in accordance with:
 - 1) The duties described in the Final Order Creating Water District 120, signed by the Director of the IDWR, February 19, 2002, including:
 - a) Curtail illegal diversions;
 - b) Measure and report the diversions under water rights;
 - c) Enforce the provisions of the stipulated agreements approved by the Director, and;
 - d) Curtail out-of-priority diversions determined by the director to be causing injury to senior priority water rights if not covered by a stipulated agreement or a mitigation plan approved by the Director.
 - 2) Direction and guidance provided by the Director of IDWR pursuant to Idaho Water Law.
 - 3) The annual water district resolutions as adopted herein.
- 3. James Cefalo be elected the watermaster for Water District 120. The Director of IDWR shall appoint James Cefalo, an employee of IDWR, to provide watermaster services for the ensuing year.
- 4. As provided in <u>Idaho Code</u> § 42-608(4), the watermaster shall serve throughout the entire year after election at this meeting and upon appointment by the Director.
- 5. The attached budget represents the expenses to be incurred by Water District 120 in the current year (November 1 October 31). The attached budget is hereby adopted as a component of these resolutions.
- 6. Water District 120 includes one or more ground water districts, irrigation districts or other geographical areas where the source of water or nature of water use is common among water right owners and users. The following ground water districts and irrigation districts may already be measuring and reporting diversions on their own to promote efficiency in the administration of water rights and water management.
 - 1) Aberdeen-American Falls Ground Water District
 - 2) Bingham Ground Water District
 - 3) Bonneville-Jefferson Ground Water District
 - 4) Falls Irrigation

- 7. Water Users within Water District 120 shall be assessed as follows. For purposes of these resolutions, the diversion rate for a point of diversion shall be calculated based on the cumulative diversion rate authorized under all water rights pertaining to the point of diversion.
 - a) Diversions meeting the definition of "domestic purposes" as set forth in Idaho Code §42-111 will not be assessed.
 - b) Diversions, with water rights authorizing equal to or less than 0.24 cfs or 5.0 acres of irrigation shall receive a minimum assessment of \$25. These minimum assessment diversions will not be measured by Water District 120 or the ground water districts or irrigation districts described above.
 - c) Diversions, with water rights exceeding 0.24 or 5.0 acres of irrigation, that are easured by one of the ground water districts or irrigation districts described above, will be assessed an administrative fee of \$0.02 per acre-foot diverted based on a 5-year rolling average.
 - d) Diversions, with water rights exceeding 0.24 cfs or 5.0 acres of irrigation, that are not measured by one of the ground water districts or irrigation districts described above, will be regularly measured and monitored by Water District 120 staff. The assessment for such diversions will include:
 - 1) \$60.00 per diversion;
 - 2) \$0.30 per acre-foot diverted based on a 5-year rolling average; and
 - 3) An administrative fee of \$0.02 per acre-foot diverted, based on a 5-year rolling average.
- 8. BE IT RESOLVED that the Water District 120 budget will be approved for a fiscal year that begins November 1 and ends October 31.
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Water District 120 advisory committee shall hereby be authorized to adopt an interim water district budget for the period between November 1 and the next annual meeting.
- 9. Be it also resolved, that the Watermaster is authorized pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-618, to withhold or suspend deliveries of water to any water user who has not paid their assessment charge by January 1 of the year following the billing date.
- 10. The water users of Water District 120 hereby empower the elected advisory committee to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the Water District and the Director of IDWR that will provide for the following:
 - a) Compensation of the watermaster and all related water district expenses for the 2014 fiscal year shall be provided by the water district.
 - b) The budget for Water District 120 for the ensuing year will be set at this annual meeting in resolution 10. Appointment of a district treasurer for fiscal year 2014 will occur during a regular or special meeting of the advisory

committee of Water District 120 before assessments from the water district are sent.

- c) The watermaster shall maintain an office for the ensuing year within the IDWR Eastern Regional Office, located in Idaho Falls, Idaho.
- d) IDWR will provide office space, vehicles and the use of all necessary office and field equipment in exchange for compensation as set in the 2014 budget. This arrangement shall not give Water District 120 any ownership interest in any IDWR office space and equipment. However, equipment purchased by Water District 120 will remain owned by Water District 120
- e) Districts identified in item 6 are expected to fund, at their own expense during the 2014 fiscal year, personnel and equipment necessary for measurement and reporting of diversions within these districts.
- 11. These districts designated above may have employees who measure and report diversions to the water master of Water District 120 and IDWR. The water master of Water District 120 may therefore appoint employees or agents of these districts as assistant watermasters for purposes of measuring and reporting water use to the watermaster of Water District 120. The water district watermaster and the Director of IDWR will provide direction and guidance to assistant watermasters for measuring and reporting of diversions in these districts, including but not limited to the following:
 - a) Each district responsible for data collection shall provide an annual report of diversion data to the water district watermaster in accordance with <u>Idaho Code</u> § 42-606, § 42-708, § 42-709, and the direction provided by the Director of IDWR.
 - b) Assistant watermasters shall cooperate and coordinate with the water district watermaster and IDWR in sharing water use information.
 - c) The regulation of diversions, including curtailment of diversions and other water right enforcement actions, shall be the primary responsibility of the water district watermaster and IDWR.
 - d) The designated districts will first be given the opportunity to resolve unauthorized diversions, or other enforcement matters before action is taken by the watermaster or IDWR.
 - e) To the extent that assistant watermasters may otherwise be involved in the regulation or enforcement of diversions, such involvement will be under the instruction of the watermaster and the Director of IDWR.
- 12. WHEREAS, the water district meets in regular annual session, as provided by state law, and;

WHEREAS, an advisory committee shall be elected at each regular annual session to represent the interests of the water users and to provide input to the watermaster and the Director of IDWR, and;

WHEREAS Idaho Code 42-605 provides for voting by water users and election of an advisory committee,

BE IT RESOLVED that the credentials for voting in any district meeting and for serving on the district advisory committee will be as follows:

- a) The advisory committee shall consist of 11 members, of which no more than 3 of these shall represent non-irrigation water users. And be it further resolved that when available there shall be at least three committee members from both the Aberdeen-American Falls Ground Water District and the Bingham Ground Water District and at least two committee members from the Bonneville-Jefferson Ground Water District.
- b) Must be a water user of the district as evidenced by a valid water right or an assessment for water delivery the previous year.
- c) Must have paid all assessments owed to the water district.
- 13. Copies of the minutes of the annual meeting, the budget as approved, all resolutions approved, and the report prepared in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-615, shall be filed with the director of the Department of Water Resources in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-617.
- 14. The watermaster of Water District 120 shall be responsible for submitting to IDWR annual reports showing water use and such other information that may be deemed necessary by the Director of IDWR in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-606, § 42-708, and § 42-709.
- 15. The watermaster and assistant watermasters are authorized under Idaho Code § 42-1701(5) to make reasonable entry on lands within the district to carry out the duties of the watermaster as instructed by IDWR. These duties include but are not limited to:
 - a) Monitoring diversion and measuring rate and volume of water diverted from ground water and other public water sources.
 - b) Measuring the depth to water in wells.
 - c) Monitoring the place, period, and nature of use of water to identify unauthorized diversion and use and to determine compliance with mitigation provisions required by agreement or order of IDWR.

Special Resolution

WHEREAS, the Idaho Water Resource Board and the Idaho Department of Water Resources operate a Water Supply Bank, which allows water users to rent unused water rights, which have been leased into the Water Supply Bank, to satisfy short-term water needs; and

WHEREAS, there is not currently a date set in which rental applications are considered "timely" in a given irrigation season, which has led to a competition to have the first rental application filed; and

WHEREAS, in 2012 and 2013 most of the ground water rights available in the Water Supply Bank within the boundaries of Water District 120 were rented by two large-acreage water users, leaving little or no water available for rental by other water users within Water District 120;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the water users of Water District 120 encourage the Idaho Water Resource Board to evaluate the rules governing the Water Supply Bank and to revise or adopt rules to create a more equitable distribution of available water rights to water users filing Water Supply Bank rental applications. Further, the Water Supply Bank rules should be revised to set a date when rental applications may be filed and considered "timely" for the subsequent irrigation season.

Water District 120 Advisory Meeting January 29, 2014 IDWR, 900 N Skyline Dr, Suite A Idaho Falls, ID 83402

Tim Deeg called the meeting to order at 2:07 pm. Those in attendance are: Neil Morgan, Steve Howser, Terrell Sorensen, Gaylen VanOrden, Marla Trible, Heather Bohac, Brian Lebrecht, Layton Walton, Wendy Murphy, Dane Watkins, Stephanie Mickelsen, Scott Bergendorf, Cooper Fritz, James Cefalo, Craig Evans, and Tim Deeg.

Dane Watkins moved to approve the previous advisory meeting minutes as written. Stephanie Mickelsen seconded the motion and the motion passed.

James Cefalo introduced the IDWR staff. James indicated the eastern regional office is now fully staffed, although some satellite offices in Salmon and Soda Springs are permanently closed. Cooper Fritz and Scott Bergendorf performed the measurements for WD120 in 2013. Cooper and Scott have been reassigned and are now going to be doing permits and transfer review. Heather Bohac and Layton Walton will be performing the measurements in 2014. Layton provided a quick review of the work performed in 2013. A more detailed report will be presented at the annual meeting. Power records were recently received and are being reviewed as well. It was a hot/dry summer which pushed water users to their volume limits. The current snow conditions are about 70% of normal.

James noted that Aberdeen American Falls GWD prepared a list of 20-25 excess uses within the district. WD120 staff reviewed the information and found that about 1/3 of the list were minor overages (within 5% of the listed volume limit), about 1/3 of the overages were due to errors in the database (which were corrected), and about 1/3 were actual water right violations. IDWR is currently working with water users to address the violations. James also indicated Lance Funk had secured water rights to cover the irrigation for the 2013 season, manly by utilizing the Water Supply Bank. After much discussion regarding the Water Supply Bank, the board asked James to draft a resolution that expressed concerns over the ability of one water user taking all the water in the supply bank to satisfy new development rather than allowing other users access as well and potentially shutting off wells that have been in existence for several years.

Wendy Murphy presented a Balance Sheet ending October 31, 2013 compared to January 27, 2014. The Profit and Loss Budget Performance ending October 31, 2013 was also presented. Questions were raised regarding the Mitigation costs of Water District 120. It was indicated the mitigation costs are handled through the ground water districts. The large retained earnings were built over years where positions were vacant for periods of time. The board has been attempting to reduce the retained earnings slowly by operating at a loss. There was also a discussion regarding the interest earned and options available for investing and holding the one year reserve account. Discussion then moved to the 2014 Budget. Even though WD120 was under budget in 2013 the department is better staffed to cover all the requirements for the Water District. With the anticipation of some curtailment and to cover items that were not able to be accomplished in prior years the budget is proposed to be higher than the 2013 budget. Stephanie Mickelsen

proposed keeping assessment rates the same as last year. Dane Watkins seconded the motion, and the motion passed. Steve Howser offered an amendment to the motion to adopt the 2014 budget as presented but adjusting the income side to reflect keeping assessments the same as 2013 and making up the deficit with the retained earnings. Stephanie accepted the amendment, as well as Dane Watkins who seconded the motion. The amended motion passed.

The proposed 2014 resolutions were also presented. Terrell Sorensen moved to present the resolutions to the water users at their annual meeting with the addition of the water bank resolution to be drafted. Stephanie Mickelsen seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Tim Deeg adjourned the meeting at 3:26 pm.

Water District 120 Advisory Meeting September 9, 2014 – 10:00 am IDWR, 900 N Skyline Dr, Suite A Idaho Falls, ID 83404

Meeting was called to order at 10:00 am by Tim Deeg. Those in attendance were: Tim Deeg, Steve Howser, Dane Watkins, Stephanie Mickelson, Allison Torres, Heather Bohac, Mandy Gunderson, Wendy Murphy, and James Cefalo.

Dane Watkins made a motion to accept the Minutes from the January 29, 2014, advisory meeting. Stephanie Mickelson seconded the motion carried.

James Cefalo introduced staff. Allison Torres, who will be doing measurements, Heather Bohac has returned and has done measurements before, and Mandy Gunderson will be helping Wendy with the finances. James noted that because Heather was already familiar with the system and was there through the winter, she was able to correct much of the data not only with American Falls/Aberdeen but also Bingham, Bonneville and Jefferson ground water districts.

At the annual meeting a special resolution was made directed to the water supply bank. By March 21st the Water Supply Bank had adopted a beginning application date of November 1st. All applications filed prior to November 1st will be treated the same. Private lease/rental agreements will not be changed.

James posed the question whether the Water District or the Ground Water District (GWD) should assess for minimums. Would the Minimum fee pay for mitigation if there was a call? WD120 does not provide mitigation nor do they have the ability to file liens. WD120 can provide a list of all of the current rights the GWD should be assessing. The GWD will provide WD120 with an annual list of all the Water Rights assessed. WD120 will review the assessment data to check for duplicates. Currently, there are a couple of minimum users in the Ground Water District. Those minimums are currently assessed \$50 each.

Wendy Murphy said that ground water districts are required to publish a statement of financial conditions and a list of the water rights that are regulated. Wendy noted that ground water districts are required to provide a list of the water rights assessed, it is not optional. By providing the water right numbers on assessments, the water district will more easily be able to cross reference the assessments to verify that there are not duplicates. It would also be helpful to have a list of which water users have opted in or out of the ground water districts.

James Cefalo raised the issue of certain systems needing flow meters. Since the WD120 was created, systems have become increasingly complex and it is not appropriate or accurate to use the power consumption coefficient method for complex systems. The department has issued individual measuring device orders stating that a system is too complex and requires a flow meter. These orders have generally been disregarded by the water users. There are currently an estimated 200 complex systems

requiring flow meters in the district. James proposed creating an incentive to install flow meters. If a water user installs a department approved flow meter, the diversion would not need to be measured or calibrated. This could result in waiving the measurement fees. There would only be a need to get a meter reading at the end of the year. In conjunction with this proposal is the possibility of a tiered assessment so those who are not in compliance would pay a higher assessment as a result of the increased expense to the Water District for measuring complex systems.

The battery in the electromagnetic (Mag) Meters last about 5 years and is the biggest maintenance concern with the meters. Batteries cost about \$150 to replace. The largest expense is not the cost of the Mag Meters but in bringing the system to par to function with the meters.

Stephanie Mickelson felt to merit the expense involved in switching to Mag Meters, prior to State enforcing the requirements, there would have to be a return to the business owner. At current assessment rate the recovery period is approximately 10 years. The question was then posed whether or not to have tiered assessments to cover the additional expenses incurred from measuring complex wells. Board members were generally not in favor of a tiered assessment structure. James proposed, in an effort to encourage those that might be considering installing a department approved meter, a draft resolution that would waive the measurement fees for those users who install an approved meter. A draft resolution will be prepared for the next advisory board meeting.

Wendy Murphy presented the financial report. The Balance Sheet as of August 31, 2014, reflects a Checking Account Balance of \$205,711 and an Accounts Receivable balance of \$701. Total current assets are \$206,412. Accounts payable for August are \$12,422, which is the bill from IDWR. Open Balance Equity is \$15,583; Current Retained Earnings is \$210,439; and Total Net Loss is \$ (16,449). Total equity in the District is \$193,990. The Profit and Loss Sheet as of August 2014 was presented. Assessments are \$52,322 representing 90.4% of the projected income budget. Some Penalty income and Finance Charges have been written off reflecting in credit of \$459 and \$54 respectively. Interest earned is \$129.60. Total Income as of August 2014 \$51,937. Expenses as of August 2014 are \$68,387. Which include a small Travel expense of \$18.00, equipment expense of \$13 and the IDWR contract of \$68,356. Some of the write offs are because of a bankruptcy. There was some discussion about the possibility of amending the law to give the district the ability to collect via liens or another mechanism.

No other business was brought before the committee; Stephanie Mickelsen made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and the meeting adjourned at 11:12 am.

Water District 120 Annual Meeting February 11, 2013, 1:00 p.m. Bingham County Courthouse Blackfoot, ID

Tim Deeg called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m. A List of Attendees is attached.

Chairman and Secretary were nominated. Dane Watkins nominated Tim Deeg as Meeting Chairman and Kenda Jones as Meeting Secretary. Nominations ceased and all those in attendance approved the motion.

Minutes were reviewed from 2012 annual meeting. Dane Watkins moved to approve the minutes as written. Neil Morgan seconded the motion and the minutes were approved as written.

Wendy Murphy presented the Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Budget Comparison as of October 31, 2012. Assessments are not be increased for this year. Dane Watkins motioned to accept the financials, Nic Behrend seconded and the financial report was accepted as reported.

Jim Bitzenburg presented the Watermaster report. There were 140 wells on the visit list for 2012. These wells were all visited. There was also an enforcement issue in 2012 which required several hours to resolve. The ground water levels in the area over the last five years tend to be static. Reservoirs are at 56% capacity at the first of February. Snow water equivalent charts show we are currently at normal levels. It was noted the averages for the NRCS have been adjusted to a new thirty year average.

James Cefalo provided additional information about enforcement activity. He indicated that some pivots were locked until a water source was acquired through the state water bank. He indicated it is best to address those issues early in the spring and if water users notice a violation early in the season to please notify him. Dane Watkins motioned to accept the watermaster report, LaVerelle Stecklein seconded and watermaster report was accepted.

Resolutions for 2013 were reviewed. The advisory board had asked James to make some changes to last year's resolutions. Primarily, the assessment resolutions were combined to clear up the language and keep one resolution for assessments rather than several as existed in previous years. Neil Morgan motioned to accept the Resolutions as changed, Dane Watkins seconded and Resolutions for 2013 were approved as corrected.

An election of Advisory Committee was held. Tim Deeg proposed leaving the advisory committee the same except for removing Dan Hammond as an alternate. Neil Morgan moved to retain the same committee with the exception of Dan Hammond, Dan Watkins seconded and the motion passed.

Tim Deeg gave a summary of the year. The ground water districts finished purchasing Clear Springs, Rim View, and Blue Lakes. There will be no delivery call from these fisheries with this purchase. The Department is now using a new model to review calls and transfers.

Lyle Swank indicated there is a proposed legislation to change 42-605 which deals with the election of the watermaster.

Dane Watkins motioned for the meeting to adjourn, Jeanie Hendricks seconded and the meeting was adjourned.

Water District 120 2013-2014 Resolutions

- 1. The annual Water District 120 meeting shall hereafter be held on the second Monday of February, of each year unless the Director of IDWR or the Water District 120 advisory committee should find it necessary to change the meeting date or unless changed by resolution of the district at any annual meeting.
- 2. The watermaster shall perform the duties as required by Chapter 6, Title 42, Idaho Code and in accordance with:
 - 1) The duties described in the Final Order Creating Water District 120, signed by the Director of the IDWR, February 19, 2002, including:
 - a) Curtail illegal diversions;
 - b) Measure and report the diversions under water rights;
 - c) Enforce the provisions of the stipulated agreements approved by the Director, and;
 - d) Curtail out-of-priority diversions determined by the director to be causing injury to senior priority water rights if not covered by a stipulated agreement or a mitigation plan approved by the Director.
 - 2) Direction and guidance provided by the Director of IDWR pursuant to Idaho Water Law.
 - 3) The annual water district resolutions as adopted herein.
- 3. James Cefalo be elected the watermaster for Water District 120. The Director of IDWR shall appoint James Cefalo, an employee of IDWR, to provide watermaster services for the ensuing year.
- 4. As provided in <u>Idaho Code</u> § 42-608(4), the watermaster shall serve throughout the entire year after election at this meeting and upon appointment by the Director.
- 5. The attached budget represents the expenses to be incurred by Water District 120 in the current year (November 1 October 31). The attached budget is hereby adopted as a component of these resolutions.
- 6. Water District 120 includes one or more ground water districts, irrigation districts or other geographical areas where the source of water or nature of water use is common among water right owners and users. The following ground water districts and irrigation districts may already be measuring and reporting diversions on their own to promote efficiency in the administration of water rights and water management.
 - 1) Aberdeen-American Falls Ground Water District
 - 2) Bingham Ground Water District
 - 3) Bonneville-Jefferson Ground Water District
 - 4) Falls Irrigation

- 7. Water Users within Water District 120 shall be assessed as follows. For purposes of these resolutions, the diversion rate for a point of diversion shall be calculated based on the cumulative diversion rate authorized under all water rights pertaining to the point of diversion.
 - a) Diversions meeting the definition of "domestic purposes" as set forth in Idaho Code §42-111 will not be assessed.
 - b) Diversions, with water rights authorizing equal to or less than 0.24 cfs or 5.0 acres of irrigation shall receive a minimum assessment of \$25. These minimum assessment diversions will not be measured by Water District 120 or the ground water districts or irrigation districts described above.
 - c) Diversions, with water rights exceeding 0.24 or 5.0 acres of irrigation, that are measured by one of the ground water districts or irrigation districts described above, will be assessed an administrative fee of \$0.02 per acre-foot diverted based on a 5-year rolling average.
 - d) Diversions, with water rights exceeding 0.24 cfs or 5.0 acres of irrigation, that are not measured by one of the ground water districts or irrigation districts described above, will be regularly measured and monitored by Water District 120 staff. The assessment for such diversions will include:
 - 1) \$60.00 per diversion;
 - 2) \$0.30 per acre-foot diverted based on a 5-year rolling average; and
 - 3) An administrative fee of \$0.02 per acre-foot diverted, based on a 5-year rolling average.
- 8. BE IT RESOLVED that the Water District 120 budget will be approved for a fiscal year that begins November 1 and ends October 31.
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Water District 120 advisory committee shall hereby be authorized to adopt an interim water district budget for the period between November 1 and the next annual meeting.
- 9. Be it also resolved, that the Watermaster is authorized pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-618, to withhold or suspend deliveries of water to any water user who has not paid their assessment charge by January 1 of the year following the billing date.
- 10. The water users of Water District 120 hereby empower the elected advisory committee to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the Water District and the Director of IDWR that will provide for the following:
 - a) Compensation of the watermaster and all related water district expenses for the 2013-2014 fiscal year shall be provided by the water district.
 - b) The budget for Water District 120 for the ensuing year will be set at this annual meeting in resolution 10. Appointment of a district treasurer for fiscal year 2013-2014 will occur during a regular or special meeting of the advisory

- committee of Water District 120 before assessments from the water district are sent.
- c) The watermaster shall maintain an office for the ensuing year within the IDWR Eastern Regional Office, located in Idaho Falls, Idaho.
- d) IDWR will provide office space, vehicles and the use of all necessary office and field equipment in exchange for compensation as set in the 2010–2014 budget. This arrangement shall not give Water District 120 any ownership interest in any IDWR office space and equipment. However, equipment purchased by Water District 120 will remain owned by Water District 120
- e) Districts identified in item 6 are expected to fund, at their own expense during the 2013—2014 fiscal year, personnel and equipment necessary for measurement and reporting of diversions within these districts.
- 11. These districts designated above may have employees who measure and report diversions to the water master of Water District 120 and IDWR. The water master of Water District 120 may therefore appoint employees or agents of these districts as assistant watermasters for purposes of measuring and reporting water use to the watermaster of Water District 120. The water district watermaster and the Director of IDWR will provide direction and guidance to assistant watermasters for measuring and reporting of diversions in these districts, including but not limited to the following:
 - a) Each district responsible for data collection shall provide an annual report of diversion data to the water district watermaster in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-606, § 42-708, § 42-709, and the direction provided by the Director of IDWR.
 - b) Assistant watermasters shall cooperate and coordinate with the water district watermaster and IDWR in sharing water use information.
 - c) The regulation of diversions, including curtailment of diversions and other water right enforcement actions, shall be the primary responsibility of the water district watermaster and IDWR.
 - d) The designated districts will first be given the opportunity to resolve unauthorized diversions, or other enforcement matters before action is taken by the watermaster or IDWR.
 - e) To the extent that assistant watermasters may otherwise be involved in the regulation or enforcement of diversions, such involvement will be under the instruction of the watermaster and the Director of IDWR.
- 12. WHEREAS, the water district meets in regular annual session, as provided by state law, and;

WHEREAS, an advisory committee shall be elected at each regular annual session to represent the interests of the water users and to provide input to the watermaster and the Director of IDWR, and;

WHEREAS Idaho Code 42-605 provides for voting by water users and election of an advisory committee,

BE IT RESOLVED that the credentials for voting in any district meeting and for serving on the district advisory committee will be as follows:

- a) The advisory committee shall consist of 11 members, of which no more than 3 of these shall represent non-irrigation water users. And be it further resolved that when available there shall be at least three committee members from both the Aberdeen-American Falls Ground Water District and the Bingham Ground Water District and at least two committee members from the Bonneville-Jefferson Ground Water District.
- b) Must be a water user of the district as evidenced by a valid water right or an assessment for water delivery the previous year.
- c) Must have paid all assessments owed to the water district.
- 13. Copies of the minutes of the annual meeting, the budget as approved, all resolutions approved, and the report prepared in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-615, shall be filed with the director of the Department of Water Resources in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-617.
- 14. The watermaster of Water District 120 shall be responsible for submitting to IDWR annual reports showing water use and such other information that may be deemed necessary by the Director of IDWR in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-606, § 42-708, and § 42-709.
- 15. The watermaster and assistant watermasters are authorized under Idaho Code § 42-1701(5) to make reasonable entry on lands within the district to carry out the duties of the watermaster as instructed by IDWR. These duties include but are not limited to:
 - a) Monitoring diversion and measuring rate and volume of water diverted from ground water and other public water sources.
 - b) Measuring the depth to water in wells.
 - c) Monitoring the place, period, and nature of use of water to identify unauthorized diversion and use and to determine compliance with mitigation provisions required by agreement or order of IDWR.

Special Resolution

WHEREAS, the Idaho Water Resource Board and the Idaho Department of Water Resources operate a Water Supply Bank, which allows water users to rent unused water rights, which have been leased into the Water Supply Bank, to satisfy short-term water needs; and

WHEREAS, there is not currently a date set in which rental applications are considered "timely" in a given irrigation season, which has led to a competition to have the first rental application filed; and

WHEREAS, in 2012 and 2013 most of the ground water rights available in the Water Supply Bank within the boundaries of Water District 120 were rented by two large-acreage water users, leaving little or no water available for rental by other water users within Water District 120;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the water users of Water District 120 encourage the Idaho Water Resource Board to evaluate the rules governing the Water Supply Bank and to revise or adopt rules to create a more equitable distribution of available water rights to water users filing Water Supply Bank rental applications. Further, the Water Supply Bank rules should be revised to set a date when rental applications may be filed and considered "timely" for the subsequent irrigation season.

Water District 120 Advisory Meeting January 29, 2014 IDWR, 900 N Skyline Dr, Suite A Idaho Falls, ID 83402

Tim Deeg called the meeting to order at 2:07 pm. Those in attendance are: Neil Morgan, Steve Howser, Terrell Sorensen, Gaylen VanOrden, Marla Trible, Heather Bohac, Brian Lebrecht, Layton Walton, Wendy Murphy, Dane Watkins, Stephanie Mickelsen, Scott Bergendorf, Cooper Fritz, James Cefalo, Craig Evans, and Tim Deeg.

Dane Watkins moved to approve the minutes as written. Stephanie Mickelsen seconded the motion and the motion passed.

James Cefalo introduced the IDWR staff. James indicated the office is fully staffed again although some satellite offices in Salmon and Soda Springs are permanently closed. Cooper Fritz and Scott Bergendorf performed the measurement in 2013. Cooper and Scott are now going to be doing permits and transfer review. Heather Bohac and Layton Walton will be performing the measurements in 2014. Layton provided a quick review of the work performed in 2013. A more detailed report will be presented at the annual meeting. Power records were recently received and are being reviewed as well. It was a hot/dry summer which pushed water users to their volume limits. The current snow conditions are about 70% of normal. James indicated Aberdeen-Springfield asked the watermaster to list of potential violations in their area. About 1/3 were within the +(-) 5%, 1/3 were fine, and 1/3 were violations. Currently working on getting those resolved. He also indicated Lance Funk had secured water rights to cover the irrigation for the 2013 season, manly by utilizing the state water bank. After much discussion regarding the Water Supply Bank, the board asked James to draft a resolution that expressed concerns over the ability of one large user taking all the water in the supply bank to satisfy new development rather than allowing other users access as well and potentially shutting off wells that have been in existence for several years. James Cefalo also indicated this is looking to be a year that is at risk to require regulation.

Wendy Murphy presented a Balance Sheet ending October 31, 2013 compared to January 27, 2014. The Profit and Loss Budget Performance ending October 31, 2013 was also presented. Questions were raised regarding the Mitigation costs of Water District 120. It was indicated the mitigation costs are handled through the ground water districts. The large retained earnings were built over years where positions were vacant for periods of time. The board has been attempting to reduce the retained earnings slowly by operating at a loss. There was also a discussion regarding the interest earned and options available for investing and holding the one year reserve account. Discussion then moved to the 2014 Budget. Even though we were under budget in 2013 the department is better staffed to cover all the requirements for the Water District. With the anticipation of some curtailment and to cover items that were not able to be accomplished in prior years the budget is proposed to be higher than the 2013 budget. Stephanie Mickelsen proposed keeping assessment rates the same as last year. Dane Watkins seconded the motion, and the motion passed. Steve Howser offered an amendment to the motion to adopt the 2014 budget as presented but adjusting the income side to reflect keeping assessments the same as

2013 and making up the deficit with the retained earnings. Stephanie accepted the amendment, as well as Dane Watkins who seconded the motion. The amended motion passed.

The proposed 2014 resolutions were also presented. Terrell Sorensen moved to present the resolutions as presented to the water users at their annual meeting with the addition of the water bank resolution to be drafted. Stephanie Mickelsen seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Tim Deeg adjourned the meeting at 3:26 pm.

Water District 120 Advisory Meeting January 31, 2013 IDWR, 900 N Skyline Dr, Suite A Idaho Falls, ID 83404

Meeting was called to order at 1:00 pm by Tim Deeg. Those in attendance were: Tim Deeg, James Cefalo, Wendy Murphy, Kenda Jones, Dane Watkins, Craig Evans, Neil Morgan, Marshall Jensen, Brian Lebrecht, LaVerelle Stecklein, Steve Howser, and Stephanie Mickelsen.

Minutes from the February 6, 2012 advisory meeting were reviewed. Corrections were made for the 2nd paragraph to correct the date to "February 2, 2011"; page 2, 2nd paragraph to correct the spelling of "charges"; and to correct "Lance" Funk's name. The minutes were approved as corrected.

Wendy Murphy presented the financial report. Balance sheet shows a balance of \$219,515 in checking and savings. Outstanding accounts receivables are \$2,057. Total current assets are \$221,572. Projected accounts payable for January are \$6,460, which is the bill from IDWR. Retained earnings are \$194,427. Total equity in the District is \$215,111. Total liabilities and equity is \$221,572. Profit loss indicates total income was \$87,463, which includes interest and finance charges. Total expenses were \$66,779. Net income was \$20,684. The expenses were considerably under budget with cost sharing for an IDWR employee position. Steve Howser expressed his interest in utilizing some of the retained earnings for purchasing pressure transducers to gather changes in water elevation in the area. No action was taken on this proposal.

James Cefalo indicated there was a violation this past year with Lance Funk irrigation over 2000 acres without a proper water right. He also indicated out of the violations mentioned in 2012, Foster Farms and Deloy Ward moved water to correct their violation. Monty Funk and Dyer Family Trust have also resolved their violations. Stephanie Mickelsen moved to accept the Watermaster report, LaVerelle Stecklein seconded the motion and the motion passed.

The proposed resolutions were reviewed for presentation at the annual meeting. Resolution 5 (b) was changed to reflect a \$0.30 charge for measurement, and #5 (c) changed to \$0.02 for administrative purposes. There was also an addition to Resolution 5 – (d) to add language for the minimum charge. Resolution 10 was also changed to reflect the 2013 fiscal year and to reference resolution 5 for charges. James Cefalo indicated he would like to review the resolutions in more detail and arrange resolutions to a more logical order. Steve Howser moved to approved the proposed changes and authorize James to correct language and the resolution order prior to the annual meeting. Dane Watkins seconded the motion and the motion passed.

The proposed budget was changed to reduce income from \$87,782 to \$54,354 and to remove the audit cost from the expenses reducing the expenses to \$77,704. It was also recommended to add the projected loss on the report. Stephanie Mickelsen moved to approve the budget as presented and

authorizing reserved to be used for the shortfall in assessments. Craig Evans seconded the motion and the motion passed.
No other business was brought before the committee and the meeting adjourned.

Water District 120 2013-2014 Resolutions

- 1. The annual Water District 120 meeting shall hereafter be held on the second Monday of February, of each year unless the Director of IDWR or the Water District 120 advisory committee should find it necessary to change the meeting date or unless changed by resolution of the district at any annual meeting.
- 2. The watermaster shall perform the duties as required by Chapter 6, Title 42, Idaho Code and in accordance with:
 - 1) The duties described in the Final Order Creating Water District 120, signed by the Director of the IDWR, February 19, 2002, including:
 - a) Curtail illegal diversions;
 - b) Measure and report the diversions under water rights;
 - c) Enforce the provisions of the stipulated agreements approved by the Director, and:
 - d) Curtail out-of-priority diversions determined by the director to be causing injury to senior priority water rights if not covered by a stipulated agreement or a mitigation plan approved by the Director.
 - 2) Direction and guidance provided by the Director of IDWR pursuant to Idaho Water Law.
 - 3) The annual water district resolutions as adopted herein.
- 3. James Cefalo be elected the watermaster for Water District 120. The Director of IDWR shall appoint James Cefalo, an employee of IDWR, to provide watermaster services for the ensuing year.
- 4. As provided in <u>Idaho Code</u> § 42-608(4), the watermaster shall serve throughout the entire year after election at this meeting and upon appointment by the Director.
- 5. The attached budget represents the expenses to be incurred by Water District 120 in the current year (November 1 October 31). The attached budget is hereby adopted as a component of these resolutions.
- 6. Water District 120 includes one or more ground water districts, irrigation districts or other geographical areas where the source of water or nature of water use is common among water right owners and users. The following ground water districts and irrigation districts may already be measuring and reporting diversions on their own to promote efficiency in the administration of water rights and water management.
 - 1) Aberdeen-American Falls Ground Water District
 - 2) Bingham Ground Water District
 - 3) Bonneville-Jefferson Ground Water District
 - 4) Falls Irrigation

- 7. Water Users within Water District 120 shall be assessed as follows. For purposes of these resolutions, the diversion rate for a point of diversion shall be calculated based on the cumulative diversion rate authorized under all water rights pertaining to the point of diversion.
 - a) Diversions meeting the definition of "domestic purposes" as set forth in Idaho Code §42-111 will not be assessed.
 - b) Diversions, with water rights authorizing equal to or less than 0.24 cfs or 5.0 acres of irrigation shall receive a minimum assessment of \$25. These minimum assessment diversions will not be measured by Water District 120 or the ground water districts or irrigation districts described above.
 - c) Diversions, with water rights exceeding 0.24 or 5.0 acres of irrigation, that are measured by one of the ground water districts or irrigation districts described above, will be assessed an administrative fee of \$0.02 per acre-foot diverted based on a 5-year rolling average.
 - d) Diversions, with water rights exceeding 0.24 cfs or 5.0 acres of irrigation, that are not measured by one of the ground water districts or irrigation districts described above, will be regularly measured and monitored by Water District 120 staff. The assessment for such diversions will include:
 - 1) \$60.00 per diversion;
 - 2) \$0.30 per acre-foot diverted based on a 5-year rolling average; and
 - 3) An administrative fee of \$0.02 per acre-foot diverted, based on a 5year rolling average.
- 8. BE IT RESOLVED that the Water District 120 budget will be approved for a fiscal year that begins November 1 and ends October 31.
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Water District 120 advisory committee shall hereby be authorized to adopt an interim water district budget for the period between November 1 and the next annual meeting.
- 9. Be it also resolved, that the Watermaster is authorized pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-618, to withhold or suspend deliveries of water to any water user who has not paid their assessment charge by January 1 of the year following the billing date.
- 10. The water users of Water District 120 hereby empower the elected advisory committee to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the Water District and the Director of IDWR that will provide for the following:
 - a) Compensation of the watermaster and all related water district expenses for the 2013-2014 fiscal year shall be provided by the water district.
 - b) The budget for Water District 120 for the ensuing year will be set at this annual meeting in resolution 10. Appointment of a district treasurer for fiscal year 2013-2014 will occur during a regular or special meeting of the advisory

- committee of Water District 120 before assessments from the water district are sent.
- c) The watermaster shall maintain an office for the ensuing year within the IDWR Eastern Regional Office, located in Idaho Falls, Idaho.
- d) IDWR will provide office space, vehicles and the use of all necessary office and field equipment in exchange for compensation as set in the 2010-2014 budget. This arrangement shall not give Water District 120 any ownership interest in any IDWR office space and equipment. However, equipment purchased by Water District 120 will remain owned by Water District 120
- e) Districts identified in item 6 are expected to fund, at their own expense during the 2013—2014 fiscal year, personnel and equipment necessary for measurement and reporting of diversions within these districts.
- 11. These districts designated above may have employees who measure and report diversions to the water master of Water District 120 and IDWR. The water master of Water District 120 may therefore appoint employees or agents of these districts as assistant watermasters for purposes of measuring and reporting water use to the watermaster of Water District 120. The water district watermaster and the Director of IDWR will provide direction and guidance to assistant watermasters for measuring and reporting of diversions in these districts, including but not limited to the following:
 - a) Each district responsible for data collection shall provide an annual report of diversion data to the water district watermaster in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-606, § 42-708, § 42-709, and the direction provided by the Director of IDWR.
 - b) Assistant watermasters shall cooperate and coordinate with the water district watermaster and IDWR in sharing water use information.
 - c) The regulation of diversions, including curtailment of diversions and other water right enforcement actions, shall be the primary responsibility of the water district watermaster and IDWR.
 - d) The designated districts will first be given the opportunity to resolve unauthorized diversions, or other enforcement matters before action is taken by the watermaster or IDWR.
 - e) To the extent that assistant watermasters may otherwise be involved in the regulation or enforcement of diversions, such involvement will be under the instruction of the watermaster and the Director of IDWR.
- 12. WHEREAS, the water district meets in regular annual session, as provided by state law, and;

WHEREAS, an advisory committee shall be elected at each regular annual session to represent the interests of the water users and to provide input to the watermaster and the Director of IDWR, and;

WHEREAS Idaho Code 42-605 provides for voting by water users and election of an advisory committee,

BE IT RESOLVED that the credentials for voting in any district meeting and for serving on the district advisory committee will be as follows:

- a) The advisory committee shall consist of 11 members, of which no more than 3 of these shall represent non-irrigation water users. And be it further resolved that when available there shall be at least three committee members from both the Aberdeen-American Falls Ground Water District and the Bingham Ground Water District and at least two committee members from the Bonneville-Jefferson Ground Water District.
- b) Must be a water user of the district as evidenced by a valid water right or an assessment for water delivery the previous year.
- c) Must have paid all assessments owed to the water district.
- 13. Copies of the minutes of the annual meeting, the budget as approved, all resolutions approved, and the report prepared in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-615, shall be filed with the director of the Department of Water Resources in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-617.
- 14. The watermaster of Water District 120 shall be responsible for submitting to IDWR annual reports showing water use and such other information that may be deemed necessary by the Director of IDWR in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-606, § 42-708, and § 42-709.
- 15. The watermaster and assistant watermasters are authorized under Idaho Code § 42-1701(5) to make reasonable entry on lands within the district to carry out the duties of the watermaster as instructed by IDWR. These duties include but are not limited to:
 - a) Monitoring diversion and measuring rate and volume of water diverted from ground water and other public water sources.
 - b) Measuring the depth to water in wells.
 - c) Monitoring the place, period, and nature of use of water to identify unauthorized diversion and use and to determine compliance with mitigation provisions required by agreement or order of IDWR.
