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SECTION 42-606 IDAHO CODE

REPORTS OF WATERMASTERS. All watermasters shall make an annual report to the department of water resources prior to the expiration of the watermaster's appointment for the current year. This report shall show the total amount of water delivered by the watermaster during the preceding year, the amount delivered to each water user, the total expense of delivery and the apportionment of expenses among users and all debits and credits to be carried over to the following year. Such report shall also include records of stream flow the watermaster used or made in the process of distributing water supplies. The director may ask for other information deemed necessary in assuring proper distribution of water supplies within the district. The reports of watermasters to the department of water resources shall be filed and kept in the office of the department.

Instructions For Completing Annual Watermaster's Report

This form has been developed to assist the watermaster in complying with some of the annual reporting requirements of Section 42-606, Idaho Code. The form provides for summary of the amount of water delivered by the watermaster to each user, the total expense of delivery and the apportionment of expenses among water users, including debits and credits. Water distribution and hydrologic information including stream flow records, daily diversion data, water right information and water right priority cut summaries should be presented in a separate water distribution report.

Complete this annual report form of delivery and costs as follows:

- Enter water right holder name, corresponding IDWR water right number or numbers, and corresponding diversion name and/ or remarks on page 2;
- 2) Enter the total amount of water delivered to each user as total 24-hour second feet under column 1, page 3. Total 24-hour second feet is a flow rate expressed in terms of one day or 24 hours. For example, a continuous diversion of 2 cfs over 20 days would equal 40 24-hour second feet.
- 3) Under column 3, page 3, enter the amount of money assessed or billed to each user at the beginning of the year. The assessment may be found in the previous year's adopted budget report.
- 4) In the work space provided on the right hand side of page 3, add up total watermaster salary costs and expenses and enter as 'TOTAL COST'. Then divide this total cost by the total number of 24-hour second feet delivered (sum of column 1) to obtain the cost per 24 hour second feet delivered, or the unit cost factor.
- 5) Under column 2, page 3, multiply the unit cost factor (obtained in step number 4 above) by each user's total 24-hour second feet delivery in column 1 to obtain the total cost against each user.
- 6) For each user, subtract the total cost amount in column 2 from the adopted budget in column 3 and enter the difference either as a credit or debit (negative differences entered as debits, positive differences entered as credits).
- 7) Sign the report before a notary public and submit the original to the appropriate regional office of the Department of Water Resources. Retain one copy for the Water District.

REYNOLDS CREEK DIST 57R 2014 WATER MASTER DIARY CONNIE M BRANDAU

March 4, 2014 – the annual water district meeting was held at 1:30 pm in Courtroom 2 at the Owyhee County courthouse in Murphy, Idaho. Present were; Richard Brandau, Chairman; Jerry Hoagland, Secretary; Connie Brandau, Treasurer; Kay Walker, IDWR; Tristan Hook; Theron Hook; Chris Davis, ditch rider for RID; Dean Young; Ron Rush; Tim Gross. Water master compensation for 2014 season was set at \$70 per day and \$.50 per mile. Connie Brandau was elected water master with the understanding that Gary Penny would be her assistant, sharing the same compensation rates. The 2013 treasurer's bill was approved for payment. For 2014 season the treasurer will be paid \$12 per hour, receive mileage at \$.50 per mile and be reimbursed for itemized expenses. The district budget was set at \$5,000 for 2014. Dean Young and Lou Sanchez were named as advisors.

March 21 - At the annual meeting the 57R board said they would like the creek water measured about every two weeks to establish and maintain a record of use. The assistant water master ran the creek today. There is still a little water going to the river. The treasurer mailed out the water bills today and they are due by 4/15/14.

Mar 22 – I did calculations and recorded measurements.

April 3 – Forrest Stimpson called about their water situation. They want water for the Calvin Johnston right if it is available.

April 4 – GM Penny measured the creek today. There is no water going to the river. He measured 29.48 cfs, enough to go part way through the 1887 rights.

April 5 – After doing calculation and recording measurements I talked to the RID and WR ditch rider. There is no water available for the WR lateral. Muller, Rush & Benson have not paid their water bills. WR got their weir in, but their head gate is not yet repaired (the face plate is rusted through and out of its track). I had to work for over an hour to get the head gate closed and plugged off.

April 10 – I made phone calls to Huff and Richards about how much water they are allowed at this time, and to Clemens to allow live flow through their reservoirs. Brandau turned on his 2 cfs today, which will take away from the next senior downstream right. I will check this evening to see how it settled out. I have been asked to try to keep stock water in the RID lateral. I estimate about 20" or .4 cfs at the head gate and it is not getting past the bend at Trail Drive Road. Clemens called me back about 8:30 pm. He will put the Macks Creek live flow through the reservoirs tomorrow and estimates it will be about 75".

April 11 – Rich helped me pull the weir out of the RID lateral because there is not enough pressure on the head gate to get the water over the weir blade. He needs W7

stock water on down the ditch. Twenty to thirty inches is making it about ¾ of a mile before it subs away at Schuster Gulch. By evening the lower reach measurements indicated that there is only 3.8 cfs to fill rights totaling 10.57 cfs (short 5.77 cfs).

April 12 – Gary and I made a trip up the creek and met Owen Orndorf, Dustin and Kiley of Junayo Ranch. They had 7.03 cfs (11' x 2' P) in the east ditch and 3.17 cfs (8' x 1.5' P) in the west ditch, for a total of 10.2 cfs. They will shut the water out of the west side diversion and take all their water in the east ditch. I also told Owen to put the same amount of water out of Macks Creek as is going in. That should bring about 8 cfs down to the lower reach to fill the more senior rights.

April 13 – The water got through the canyon and is here this morning. It doesn't quite cover my "marker rock" that I can see from my kitchen window. I spoke to Daniel & Bailey Richards about 8 am to let them know they may have some water by this evening or tomorrow morning. Kelly Clemens left a message that he would like me to call him and explain what I did at Junayo Ranch yesterday. Richard Brandau wants to build a smaller weir blade to put in the RID lateral for low flow accuracy.

April 15 - I sat down with Rich Brandau and we determined that a Cipoletti weir, with a four foot crest/blade, built to IDWR specifications could accurately measure a minimum of .94 cfs up to a maximum of 21 cfs. The RID lateral existing seven foot blade needs to be replaced as the supporting wood frame is rotted out.

April 18 – It rained a little last night with a daytime temp of 74 degrees. The creek is up a little this am – over my "marker rock" just a bit. There is very little water going to the river past SH 78. I called Kelly Clemens/Junayo and left a message for him to call me.

April 19 – Creek is back down. Kelly called me back this morning. He said there was a rainstorm up there the night of the 17th and that's "probably what spiked the creek, but it is back down now". Unpaid water bills to date that should not be receiving water are: RID lateral, Agenbroad, Frisbie, Heart Diamond; West Reynolds, Jerry Benson, Goering, Gerald Muller, Ron Rush; upper valley, Tony Richards, James McCabe

April 25 – Gary ran creek and brought measurements to me.

April 26 – I did calculations and recorded measurements. No changes necessary.

May 8 – Gary ran the creek and brought the papers to me late this evening.

May 9 - I did calculations of measurements. No adjustments needed at this time. West Reynolds does not have their head gate fixed where it can be opened, closed, or adjusted, and the people who could be taking water have not paid their water bills and the districts have their river pumps on.

May 28 – Gary ran the creek

May 30 – After I got Gary's figures calculated I called Kelly Clemens/Junayo and let a message telling him they needed to shut down to one head of water – his choice which side - and that if I didn't see a change in the creek by tomorrow (Sunday 6/1/14) I would be up to adjust it. Every one else is running pretty close to their right(s) and pretty steady.

June 1 – Kelly didn't call me back so I drove to Junayo's lower place. Kelly has shut off the east side ditch and is taking water out of the west side diversion. The bank behind their west side 1.5' Parshall flume has sluffed off causing the staff gauge to submerge. Even though it measures 2 cfs I estimate that they are only getting about 1 cfs.

June 2 – Bailey Richards made a call for water at 8:30 am. She only had about 10 inches in the GP horse pasture this morning. I need to run the entire creek this afternoon. 57R chairman went with me. I measured enough water to fill part way through the 1883 / #9 priority rights on the way up. Then on the way back I shut the High Ditch down to where it should be. Jaca's right is full in their west ditch. There is not enough water at the rest of the diversions to fill those ditch rights through the rest of the upper valley (water is "sinking") until Junayo's west side diversion. I spoke with Theron Hook, Kelly Clemens and Martin Jaca on the way home explaining the situation.

June 3 – At 9 am I made calls to Brad Huff, Tony Richards and Bailey Richards explaining that the creek was drying up. There is no more water to "bring down" and whatever they could get at their diversion(s) was all that they could expect.

July 3 – Elias Jaca called. He is making a call for water out of the High Ditch. I called Brad Huff and Jerry Hoagland. They had been leaving it on for stock water. Brad will shut it off this afternoon. I will make a courtesy call to Tony Richards to let him know that stock water in the Babbington Field will be gone. I reminded Jerry Hoagland that the RID lateral needs to be looked at. The ditch is "undercut" (from a flash flood that occurred in September 2013) above the Stone Quarry field. It is in a very fragile location and needs to be repaired before a ditch full of water can be allowed in it.

July 5 – I read a legal notice in the Owyhee Avalanche that Orndorff has filed for a storage right on Little Salmon, which could negatively impact all senior downstream water rights and BLM stock water rights. Did research at request of 57R officers.

October 7 – GM Penny came up for his assistant water master paycheck. I researched water right 11707 and printed off 10 pages from IDWR web search

October 8 – I contacted IDWR about transfer to BLM of water right 57-11707 which should have been revoked per BLM letter dated 3/10/2011 to Orndorff (per item #6 of conditions) canceling his LUP ID 36452.

October 9 – I wrote a letter to IDWR at the request of Patrick Kelly detailing my concerns and issues with water right 57-11707. The letter was sent to Patrick Kelly,

IDWR with copies to Darla Block, IDWR; BLM Marsing Field Office; Reynolds Creek Dist. 57R Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and Water Master.

December 29 – Worked on water master books.

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL WATER USERS MEETING OF WATER DISTRICT 57R

Tuesday, March 4, 2014 1:40 P.M. Owyhee County Courthouse

Chairman Richard Brandau called the meeting to order.

Those in attendance: Ron Rush, Tim Gross, Kris Davis (Reynolds Irrigation District ditch rider), Theron Hook, Tristan Hook, Connie Brandau, Richard Brandau, Dean Young, Brad Huff, Kay Walker (IDWR), and Jerry Hoagland.

Chairman Brandau called for nominations for Chairman. Tristan Hook moved to nominate Richard Brandau for Chairman. Connie Brandau seconded. There were no other nominations. Richard was elected as Chairman by unanimous vote.

Chairman Brandau called for nominations for Secretary. Connie Brandau moved to nominate Jerry Hoagland as Secretary. Theron Hook seconded. Jerry was elected Secretary.

Chairman Brandau called for changes or acceptance of the Minutes of the Annual Water Users Meeting of March 5, 2013. Connie made moved to approve the minutes as presented. Tristan seconded. Motion passed, none opposed

Chairman Brandau called for nominations to the Advisory Committee. Tristan moved that Lou Sanchez and Dean Young be the Advisory Committee. Ron Rush seconded. Lou Sanchez and Dean Young were elected by unanimous vote as the Advisory Committee.

Chairman Brandau asked for a Treasurer's Report. Treasurer Connie Brandau presented the financial statement for Dist, 57R. (It is attached to these minutes) Cash on hand 3/5/13: \$2,998.59, plus \$2,314.10 received, less administration costs: \$646.86, and less Water Master costs: \$1,095.38. Leaving cash on hand 2/6/14: \$3,570.45. With accounts receivable: \$248.76. Tristan made motion to accept treasure's report. Ron seconded. Motion passed.

Connie reported that IDWR needs an annual financial statement from each Water District. The attached Treasure's Report will be sent by Connie to IDWR as the financial report for Water District 57R.



Connie requested pre-approval of payments for State Insurance Fund of \$300, and Treasure's bills for 2013 of \$239.49. Theron made motion to pay past bills. Tristan seconded. Motion passed.

Connie will accept the position of Water Master if she is allowed to appoint an assistant such as Gary Penny.

Chairman Brandau called for nominations for Treasure. Tristan made motion to nominate Connie Brandau as Treasure, with the compensation of \$12 per hour, \$.50 per mile, plus office expenses and to cease further nominations. Tim Gross seconded. Motion passed, none opposed.

Chairman Brandau called for nominations for Water Master. Connie reported that Mr. Orndorf is building ponds on Salmon Creek. Unsure if there are permits applied for. Concern is the water from Salmon Creek provides the early water for the lower users. The Advisory Committee and the Water Master will request a follow up from IDWR. Dean made motion to nominate Connie Brandau as Water Master and is allowed to appoint an assistant Water Master, Gary Penny. Tristan seconded. Motion passed, with one opposed.

Chairman Brandau called for a motion setting the compensation for the Water Master. Water Master Connie Brandau requested the compensation for 2014 will be \$70 per day plus \$.50 per mile with the normal maximum mileage of 82 miles per day, generally it is less. She also recommended that a measurement of all waters be made at least every 2 weeks during the active irrigation season. Tristan made motion for \$70 per day plus \$.50 per mile and to measure all waters once every 2 weeks during the active irrigation season. Dean seconded. Motion passed, none opposed

Chairman Brandau called for resolutions pertaining to the time and manner of collection the budget, approval of measuring devices, and term of Water Master.

Chairman Brandau called for adoption of Resolution 1, time and manner of collecting the budget:

BE IT RESOLVED: That no ditch, canal company, or other water user has the right to
demand and receive any water, and the water master shall not deliver to such person until
the amount due and payable from such user, as fixed by the budget, has been paid.

Connie moved to adopt resolution 1. Tristan seconded. Motion passed.

Chairman Brandau called for the adoption of Resolution 2, approved measuring devices:

BE IT RESOLVED: That no water will be delivered to any water user until a measuring device approved by the Advisory Committee is in place on each diversion.

Connie made motion to adopt resolution 2. Dean seconded. Motion passed.

Chairman Brandau called for the adoption of Resolution 3, term of Water Master:

BE IT RESOLVED: That the Water Master will be on for the full year.

Theron made motion to adopt resolution 3. Tristan seconded. Motion passed.

Chairman Brandau called for a motion to set the budget. Water Master Connie Brandau recommended a budget of \$5,000. Tristan made motion to set the budget at \$5,000. Dean seconded. Motion passed, none opposed. (Adopted budget is attached)

Chairman Brandau called for any further old business. There are still water rights that need updated with current owners. Ron asked about West Reynolds lateral where there was no water for the end users. The head gate is out of its track and the weir is washed out. There are plans for head gate repairs

and moving the weir to a better spot. Some of those lateral users bills have not been paid. There is a 60 inch loss from the creek to the end user. And the creek did not run good last year. At some point it is a futile call.

When there are complaints about the Water Waster, those complaints should be directed to the Advisory Committee if not resolved with the Water Master.

Kay Walker had nothing to report from IDWR. She had Connie's certificate and will report our concerns with the Orndorf ponds on Salmon Creek.

The next Annual Water Users meeting will be the first Tuesday in March of 2015 at 1:30 P.M. in Murphy if available.

Dean made motion to adjourn. Meeting was adjourned.
