

**THE SUBMERGED ORIFICE**

This form of measuring device is illustrated on page 19. The submerged orifice may be used where physical conditions or lack of fall in ditch make it impracticable to use a weir. The essential requirements in setting and the methods of using the submerged orifice are as follows:

1. The front should be set at right angles to the direction of the flow and in a perpendicular position.

2. The orifice opening should be rectangular and have sharp edges. It should have an area of one square foot or 144 square inches, or an easy multiple thereof, to conform to standard discharge tables.

3. The depth of submergence (the distance from the water surface to the top of the orifice opening) should not be less than the height of the orifice opening, and more is desirable.

4. The bottom of the orifice opening should be not less than the height of the orifice opening above the grade of the ditch—to prevent silt from obstructing the opening.

5. With the orifice two gages are required, indicating the level of water on each side of the orifice opening. The difference between these two elevations is called the effective head, which should not be less than one inch.

6. Care should be taken at all times to see that the submerged opening is not obstructed by trash or silt.

The discharge of the submerged orifice is found by first obtaining the effective head, then looking down the left-hand column of the table printed on page 18, till you find this particular effective head, and then across to the discharge column. As this discharge is computed for an opening of one square foot only, any other size opening must be computed as a fraction, or multiple of this discharge.

## THE CIPPOLETTI WEIR

This form of measuring device is illustrated on page 5. It has a thin horizontal crest and thin sides; the weirs notch is wider across the top than at the bottom, the sides having a slope of one inch out to four inches up, or a 1:4 slope.

The essential requirements in setting, and the method of using the weir are as follows:

1. It should be set at the lower end of a stilling pool of sufficient length, width and depth to give an even, smooth current with a velocity of approach to the weir of not over one-half foot per second. This pool should be straight and of constant cross section, and the center line should pass through the middle of the weir crest.

2. The crest of the weir should be at right angles to the direction of the flow, and the face of the weir should be perpendicular.

3. The crest of the weir should be level so that the water passing over it will be of the same depth at all points along the crest.

4. The height of the crest above the bottom of the pool should be about three times the depth of the water flowing over it, and the sides of the pool, or box should be a distance from the sides of the crest at least twice the depth of the water passing over it.

5. The length of the crest should be at least three times the depth of the water passing over it, and of even feet, or multiples thereof, to conform to the accompanying tables.

6. The crest should be placed high enough to retard the flow above the weir to the required velocity; and so that the downstream water surface is far enough below the crest that air has free access under the falling sheet of water.

7. The depth of the water passing over the weir should be measured with accuracy at a point where the surface curve does not affect the measurement. This may be done by driving a nail partially into the upstream face of the weir structure at the exact level of the crest and far enough to one side that it will be in comparatively still water; or by driving a substantial peg into the bottom of the pool several feet upstream from the crest, in still water, the top of which is exactly level with the crest; then measuring the depth of water above this nail or peg. The discharge in cubic feet per second can then be determined directly by this depth, or head, in inches and the length of the crest in inches from the table printed on page 4.



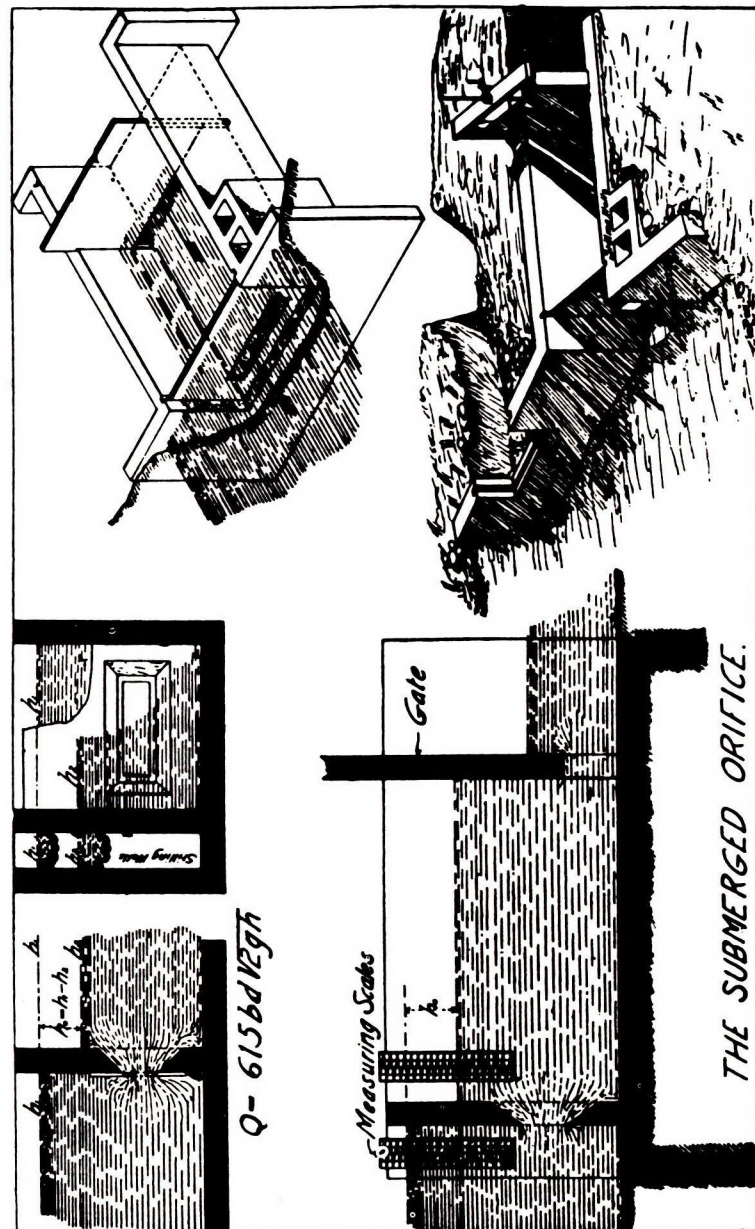
## MEASUREMENT OF WATER

### Hydraulic Equivalents Which Will Be Found Useful To Irrigators

A cubic foot of water per second of time shall be the legal standard for the measurement of water in this state.

1. One Idaho Miner's inch equals approximately 1/50th of a cubic foot per second, or 9 gallons per minute.
2. A cubic foot per second equals approximately 50 miner's inches, or 450 gallons per minute.
3. One cubic foot per second for 24 hours equals approximately 2 acre feet.
4. One acre foot equals enough water to cover one acre exactly one foot in depth, or 43,560 cubic feet.
5. One miner's inch per acre for 100 days equals 3.97 feet deep on the land.
6. One miner's inch per acre for 150 days equals 5.95 feet deep on the land.
7. Five-eighths miner's inch per acre for 100 days equals 2.48 feet deep on the land.
8. Five-eighths miner's inch per acre for 150 days equals 3.72 feet deep on the land.
9. One-half miner's inch per acre for 100 days equals 1.98 feet deep on the land.
10. One-half miner's inch per acre for 150 days equals 2.98 feet deep on the land.



A quick reply before I wrap up my time here.

IDWR is working on an initial package for WD 67: map of Weiser River main stem & major forks showing all the PODs, major storage, known gages etc. Will include a river rights delivery list matching the map. All of this type of information will be funneled thru the Watermaster as it appropriately should be. We will not be "reporting" separately to any Assistant Watermaster since that would not be appropriate. The Watermaster and WD 67 working group can distribute the information provided by IDWR to interested parties, including Assistant Watermasters.

Our department working group continues to be in touch with Brandi as the project develops. Other aspects of delivery lists will be developed for the project, i.e. comprehensive list, Assistant Watermaster area lists etc.

A river rights delivery list is not ready at this time.

Good morning, all.

I am following up on our meeting on February 17th at IDWR regarding flow measurements in the Weiser River Basin.

As shown in the email chain below, on February 18th Randy received the 2014 records from Jim Brock, so this reporting process was completed. In future years we anticipate Jacque will submit the records using this format.

As late-breaking news, I met with the Lost Valley Reservoir Company last night in Council. Their Board subsequently voted to cost-share in the installation of a measuring device for the reservoir level (like the one for Crane Creek Reservoir), with the understanding that Water District 67 will cost share in the device for Lost Valley Creek. Thus, we have the following potential funding sources for additional gaging in the Weiser River Basin:

- Water District 67 (flow measurement was discussed at the annual meeting)
- Lost Valley Reservoir Company (see above)



- Weiser Irrigation District proposal for funding has been made to WID Board -- no action taken yet)
- Idaho Water Resource Board
- Other state and federal agencies

What was remarkable about the meeting last night (to me) was that Harmon Horton and I had the same message. Harmon expressed support for broad-based instrumentation of the Weiser River Basin to "come out of the dark ages" (his term). Harmon and I often have different viewpoints so this is a change.

At this point I would propose two steps:

1. Jacque has requested a listing of water rights in the Weiser River Basin above Galloway Diversion. Her understanding has been that Steve would provide this prior to his retirement. Is it possible to make that happen?
2. Conduct a follow-up meeting to further discuss automation in the Weiser Basin. This does not mean that IWE must be selected to do the work. While we would like to do this work, we do understand that a bid process is preferable, if IDWR does not have the people power to do the work. My interest, on behalf of Lost Valley Reservoir Company, is that the devices on Lost Valley Reservoir and Lost Valley Creek be installed ASAP this summer, to begin to build a record of flow information. Raising Lost Valley Reservoir has the support of the County Commissioners in Adams and Washington counties and the support of many others. Flow measurement is a critical element of this investigation. Additional flow information will also be helpful in the Galloway Dam analysis.

Why oh why are the 2 reddest spots in Western? Yikes, I smell trouble in 2015! I'm just saying...

Along those lines, our ideas for starting down the water accounting path for Weiser River water district got somewhat derailed by totally unexpected staff shortages at Western. Between last October and sometime this summer, we will have experienced turnover in 8 of 12 positions here, unbelievable! We are focused on keeping the doors open and rebuilding staff while still getting some stuff done this year. It's a handful.

That said, I have been talking to Watermaster & others about getting started, building on Tuthill et al 2014 work partly funded by IWRB to install measurement equipment in lower part of WD 67, so far so good. He's pitching for more funding to continue this up the middle and upper reaches of the river, including Lost Valley Reservoir. Good stuff. The Watermaster and I, along with Jay Edwards of Weiser Irrigation District (Galloway Canal, Crane Creek Reservoir etc.), were surprised and pleased with WD 67 voting to raise money this year to help with measuring equipment and so forth. I got a pretty good reception at their annual meeting early this month in this regard, saying IDWR wants not to boss them around but to facilitate this progress as much as we can (re staff issues etc.). At the very least, I want us to coordinate with Watermaster during delivery calls this year so we can learn first-hand how it's been done, what else is needed, where etc. Of course all this will take time, money & hard work but at least enough people are on board with the realization the time has come for this effort.

I say all this to let you know where things are at now & hope we can work together this year as our situations allow to make a positive contribution for WD 67. My remaining time is short with IDWR but want to at least talk about it some & get things primed for some good follow up.

There probably is not any easy/quick way to do that, assuming Weiser Irrigation Rights do not include special conditions of approval addressing this issue – please see attached summary of possible options.

Temporary right does not look good unless 5 AF will help.

Water Supply Bank is potentially more promising than temporary right, although timing could be a problem. There is no rental pool for Basin 67. However, some Basin 67 surface water rights are leased to WSB, see following link:

If there is enough available to make a difference, please realize a backlog of rental applications are being processed now for this season. IDWR staff at our downtown Water Center office are processing those rentals as fast as possible, so Weiser Irrigation District would be subject to not being near head of the line if you find it worthwhile to apply (IDWR Regional Offices are not processing WSB applications). Please call our main office at 208-287-4800 and ask for WSB help if you want more details for that option.

## **“EARLY USE” OF A WATER RIGHT**

A water user seeking to use a water right prior to the earliest annual start date defined by the right cannot apply to IDWR for an “early use” approval – there is no such thing included as part of that water right. (Example: irrigation right with March 15<sup>th</sup> start date cannot be diverted before then<sup>1</sup>.)

### POSSIBLE BUT PERHAPS DUBIOUS TEMPORARY ALTERNATIVES

1) Application for Temporary Approval of Water Appropriation, \$50 -- seek a temporary water right.

- Temporary right is limited by total volume not to exceed 5 acre-feet (AF) during the approval period.
- Approval period cannot exceed 1 year.
- Temporary right is subject to existing rights.
- IDWR might seek comments for the application – watermaster etc.
- Legal notices generally not required.
- “Stacking” temporary rights for duplicative approvals totaling more than 5 AF probably viewed skeptically by IDWR (loopholes?).

2) Application to Rent Water from the Water Supply Bank (WSB), rental rate per AF set by Idaho Water Resource Board (IWRB).


- Rights leased into WSB cannot be used at their current described place of use during the lease period.
- Leased rights can be rented from WSB for 1 to 5 years period, possibly renewable.
- Source of water proposed in a rental application must be hydraulically connected to source for right leased into WSB. (Example: Hornet Creek right leased to WSB, Weiser River water rented from WSB).
- Point of diversion, place of use, nature of use &/or period of use change possible in rental application, could seek season of use change for earlier use.
- IDWR might seek comments for the application – watermaster, ditch company etc.
- Legal notices generally not required.
- Approvals based on IDWR analysis (for IWRB) -- enlargement, injury, public interest etc.
- Some areas sometimes have storage water in a Rental Pool subcategory of WSB.
- IWRB delegates authority to rent from a Rental Pool to watermaster of the water district (WD). (Examples: WD 63 Boise River rental pool, WD 65 Payette River rental pool.)

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<sup>1</sup> Some irrigation rights include a condition of approval authorizing use under limited criteria prior to the beginning of the irrigation season stated on the face of the right.

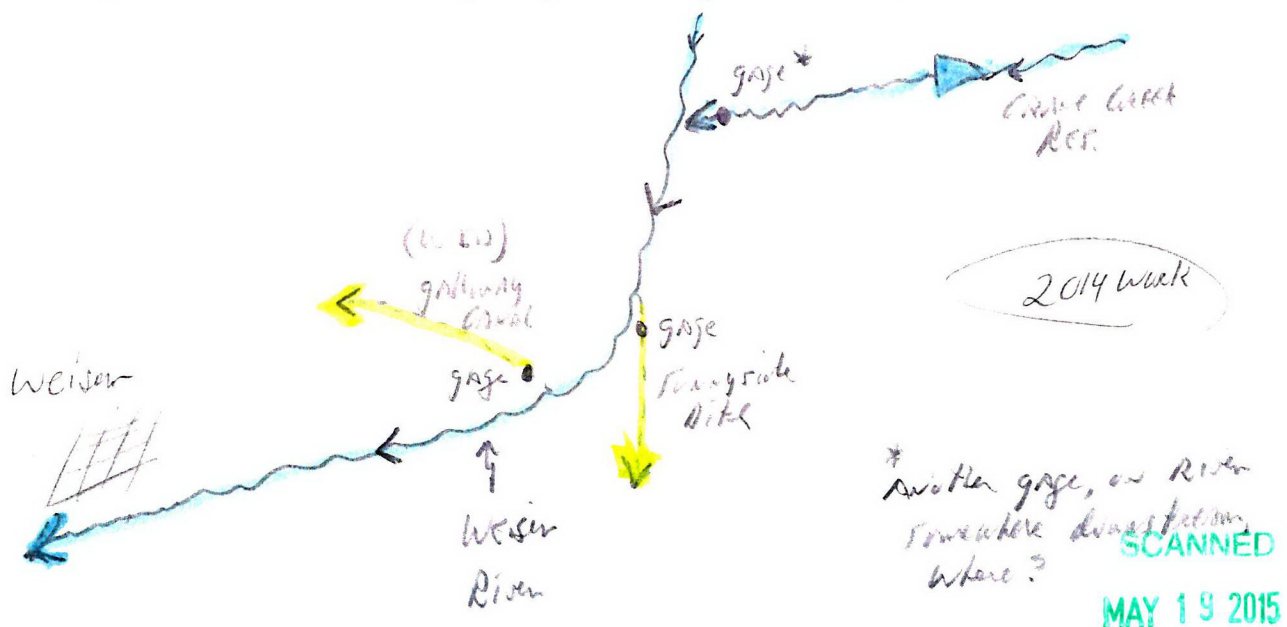
Dave Tuthill for Idaho Water Engineering made a presentation to IDWR staff today at SO. A number of SO and Western Region people attended.

He summarized 2014 work to install equipment, including telemetry, for Crane Creek Reservoir, Sunnyside Ditch and Weiser Irrigation District (Galloway Canal). IWRB funded some of this work. Results reportedly helped water users manage their available water in a poor runoff year, including using less storage and increasing carryover for 2015. This included some remotely accessed real-time data.

These irrigation entities are the primary users in lower part of the water district. Deputy Watermaster Jacque Wray (Crane Creek Reservoir water) was present and provided her (?) delivery records to SO staff resulting from this 2014 measurement work. She provided Western Region a copy of the records at the annual water district meeting in Cambridge earlier this month. IDWR needs to confirm if these records are consistent with proper Watermaster delivery information suggested by our records.

Tuthill proposed additional IWRB funding to install more equipment somewhere along midpoints and upper reaches of the Weiser River and for Lost Valley Reservoir releases. The combination of 2014 work and proposed 2015 (& beyond?) work could provide useful tools for the Weiser River Watermaster to improve water management.

I spoke to support this work, regardless of who funds it. I mentioned WD 67 voted to increase its 2015 assessment to raise money for a Watermaster raise and a fund for improved measurement equipment in other key parts of the district. WD 67 could assist with seeking IWRB help with such work. IDWR could help facilitate WD 67 work on improving water management for the users.

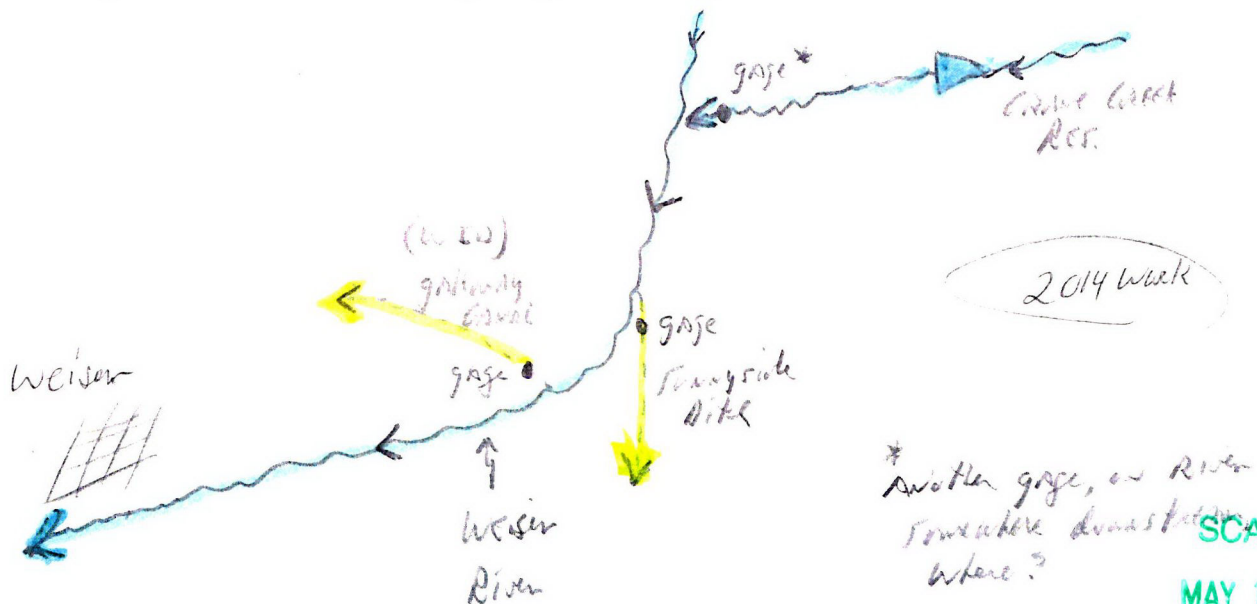

Hi Steve!

I've been working on the water assessments for the water district, which has brought up a question that I can't answer. Since the SRBA is finally done with, I decided that now was the ideal time to rebuild the books with the most accurate information available.

Bosco created the original Excel spreadsheets that we've been doing our assessments from, and those spreadsheets didn't include many water rights which were either contested, changed, split, assigned new numbers...etc. So I'm creating new spreadsheets using info from the IDWR search engine. I've completed Adams County, and that's when the question came to me.....

In the past, only those who's water is routinely regulated by the watermaster and deputies have paid an assessment. Many of the water rights listed in the new books were previously unknown to myself and my deputies, and as a result weren't regularly measured, nor assessed. But with the proposed changes/improvements to the water district, many more are going to be regulated, eventually. So do I include all the rights now? Since we're transitioning to a greater knowledge of and delivery of all rights in the district, shouldn't they be paying an assessment for that?

I haven't included in the books any of the "unnamed streams" as these don't have enough water by March/April to run to the creeks they are listed as tributary to. I also haven't included any domestic water rights, as these are considered non-consumptive use. And all the water rights not included in the book are 0.02cfs or less.

I'm about 90% of the mind that these previously un-assessed water rights should be included, but wanted to know where the state stands before running out and getting myself in trouble. I attended the annual meeting in Cambridge today. Attendance was good, "full house."

Results

Officers, WM, Advisory Committee – same.

Funding – Current balance is good, about 1.5 (?) times annual budget. It was suggested by 1 member that this is about the right cushion organizations should have.

**Budget** – Approved 50% increase to restore assessment to \$0.90/acre (where it was several years ago). Will raise about an additional \$12-13,000. **Designate half for Watermaster raise and half to save for measuring equipment etc. fund.** Also adopted \$15 minimum if individual assessment is less than that (but this is not a minimum assessment per right owner?).

Oath & Certificate of Appointment – Deputy Watermasters have not been covered by this in past and should be. They will submit completed oaths to IDWR so we can issue certificates.

Discussion

I discussed recent work completed on lower ½ of system and how it starts the **process of upgrading water management so people get more benefit from it.** Said IDWR will try to help them by providing information and other tools, work more closely with Watermaster, help identify key sites for measurement etc. This will include site visit(s) with Watermaster to understand how delivery decisions are made and deliveries accomplished.

IDWR can facilitate this work starting this year, although we are experiencing significant staff turnover. Told them we will do our best to help.

Jay Edwards of Weiser Irrigation District discussed good results they got from installing modern measurement & telemetry devices, partly funded by IWRB. Installation, calibration etc. work done by Idaho Water Engineering (Tuthill et al). Includes real-time remote access to data.

This message was surprisingly well received. District voted to proceed with this work, suggesting **a steering committee to work with Watermaster.** Jay would be good candidate for that working group.

1922, IDWR records describe water master reports for Water District 41, which included the Weiser River and South Fork Weiser River and surrounding creeks such as Mann Creek, Mill Creek, Hornet Creek, and South Fork Ditch.

Did not find definite record stating when entire river drainage except Little Weiser River system was renamed & renumbered as Weiser River Water District #67. But staff thinks this happened sometime in the late 1970's.

The river has been part of a water district in one way or another since at least the early 1920s. Anyone wanting more details is welcome to visit the IDWR State Office located in downtown Boise, 208-287-4800, ask for Water Distribution Section.

The Middle Valley Ditch Co. delivers only their water through their canal. Brandi Horton provided me a copy of her 2014 measurements. Historically when the Weiser River drops below 300 cfs at USGS site 13266000, we turn on Crane Creek storage water to keep the flow above 200 cfs during the irrigation season. As you can see from the USGS historical data, around July 12<sup>th</sup>, the River dropped and we supplemented with Crane Creek water. The turn on date is moving earlier into June apparently from unmeasured upstream diversion as well as decreased natural flow. Attached is USGS, Brandi's data and s synopsis.

On June 24 the Weiser Irrigation District started on Crane Creek water storage and by July 9<sup>th</sup>, River flow according to the USGS Weiser Site, was down to our 1902 water rights from Muir vs Allison for 120 cfs (6000 inches).

Technically, the Middle Valley right 67-4434 (1600 inches) should have been shut off about June 24, leaving only 2200 inches of adjudicated water for the June 30<sup>th</sup> measurement at the Middle Valley headgate.

In layman terms, Middle Valley's storage water should have been turned on about June 24<sup>th</sup> or earlier and 10 day of natural flow passed to the Galloway Dam. The Weiser Irrigation District could then start drawing on Crane Creek storage shortly after the 4<sup>th</sup> of July adding 10 days of river flow for irrigation.

## WATER DISTRICT MEETING NOTES WEISER RIVER #67



Steve Lester February 2, 2015

I attended the annual meeting in Cambridge today. Attendance was good, "full house."

### Results

Officers, WM, Advisory Committee – same.

Funding – Current balance is good, about 1.5 (?) times annual budget. It was suggested by 1 member that this is about the right cushion organizations should have.

Budget – Approved 50% increase to restore assessment to \$0.90/acre (where it was several years ago). Will raise about an additional \$12-13,000. Designate half for Watermaster raise and half to save for measuring equipment etc. fund. Also adopted \$15 minimum if individual assessment is less than that (but this is not a minimum assessment per right owner?).

Oath & Certificate of Appointment – Deputy Watermasters have not been covered by this in past and should be. They will submit completed oaths to IDWR so we can issue certificates.

### Discussion

I discussed recent work completed on lower ½ of system and how it starts the process of upgrading water management so people get more benefit from it. Said IDWR will try to help them by providing information and other tools, work more closely with Watermaster, help identify key sites for measurement etc. This will include site visit(s) with Watermaster to understand how delivery decisions are made and deliveries accomplished.

IDWR can facilitate this work starting this year, although we are experiencing significant staff turnover. Told them we will do our best to help.

Jay Edwards of Weiser Irrigation District discussed good results they got from installing modern measurement & telemetry devices, partly funded by IWRB. Installation, calibration etc. work done by Idaho Water Engineering (Tuthill et al). Includes real-time remote access to data.

This message was surprisingly well received. District voted to proceed with this work, suggesting a steering committee to work with Watermaster. Jay would be good candidate for that working group.

2016 meeting same schedule as 2015 for date, time and place.
