

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Water District 13T Meeting Minutes 2025

Annual Meeting of Water District 13-T
February 11, 2025 @ 10:00 a.m.
Grace Legion Hut

Jason Stoddard called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. He introduced Jon Davidson from the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) who was present at the meeting.

Colter Welch was unanimously elected to serve as meeting chairman.

Jason Stoddard was unanimously elected to serve as secretary of the meeting.

A motion passed unanimously to approve the minutes of the 2024 annual meeting as written

Kaid Panek provided a watermaster report. He stated he surveyed 71 sites in WD13T last year and this year he will continue to inventory and locate each point of diversion. He will continue this until he receives further instruction from IDWR.

Jon Davidson confirmed that water rights that haven't been used for 5 years are forfeited, unless they are banked in the water bank

Andrew Simonson provided a treasurer report. Expenses currently exceed revenue because some of the assessments have not yet been collected. Jon clarified that the City of Bancroft does need to pay their assessment even as a municipality. The assessment is not a tax. Jon instructed the next step would be to turn to the county for collections and then IDWR. If necessary, the Attorney General could get involved after IDWR. Andrew also stated the cell phone, computer & internet allocations were eliminated from the budget because Kade & Andrew did not feel like they needed compensated for that.

A motion passed unanimously to approve the budget presented by Andrew.

A motion passed unanimously to make the due date for assessments April 1st each year.

Kaid Panek was unanimously elected to continue to serve as water master.

Andrew Simonson was unanimously elected to continue to serve as Treasurer

The advisory committee was unanimously re-elected to serve as is (Colter Welch, Jason Stoddard & Ryan Christensen)

A motion passed unanimously vote that Next year's meeting date and time will be February 10, 2026 (2nd Tuesday in February) @ 10:00 a.m. at the Legion Hall

The group determined that no additions or revisions to the district resolutions were needed.

Jon Davidson provided an update from IDWR. The IDWR Hydrologic project is intended to help us understand where water is flowing underground. It also includes some surface water monitoring. It will take several years to complete. He provided those in attendance with a handout outlining the project. It was suggested that the group consider forming a groundwater district. That would involve consulting with county commissioners. An order will come out in the next 30-60 days requiring users to install an approved measuring device within the next 2 years. This will be required of anyone irrigating 5 acres or more or who divert more than 0.24 cfs. Domestic wells are not required to have a measuring device. It is possible to apply for a variance but those are rare. The Bureau of Reclamation and other ag groups have some grants that could be pursued to help offset costs. Chris Banks is working on a grant for basin 129 for measuring devices and is interested in helping WD13T users with a grant as well. He was given Andrew Simonson's phone number to contact.

A motion was passed unanimously to adjourn the meeting.
