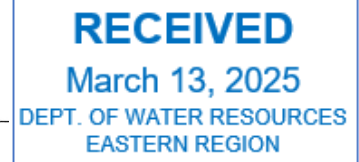


# Annual Water District Meeting Checklist

1. Meeting was held in the Salmon Fish And Game Meeting Room and started at 6:02 PM. 51 people signed the attendee roster.
2. Advisory Committee Chairman, Dave Schuler, introduced the following people:

3. Motion by Jane Dougherty Sandstrom nominating Mike England as meeting chairman, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave Schuler. Motion passed
4. Motion by Joel Griffith nominating Judy Schuler as secretary, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave Schuler. Motion Passed
5. Chairman England asked everyone to review the 2024 annual meeting minutes (handout). Motion by Richard Neustadter to accept the minutes as written, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Dougherty. Motion passed.
6. Joel Griffith gave a presentation on his accomplishments and goals for 2025. Joel reminded water users to call him when they're ready for water. He will respond within 48 hours.

8. Chairman England read the 2025 Proposed Budget. Motion by Richard Neustadter to adopt the proposed budget. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Dougherty. Motion by Jeff Kohlwes to amend the budget to read Watermaster \$25/hr pay rate, estimated total of \$8,000.00. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Janet Bloemeke. Motion passed. David Graybill suggested adding the 2024 carryover amount to the 2025 Proposed Budget. Motion by Jane Dougherty Sandstrom to add the 2024 carryover amount as a line item. 2<sup>nd</sup> John Miller. Motion passed. Chairman England called for a vote on the amended budget. Motion passed.

11. Ty Cole read the four proposed 2025 resolutions. Motion by Richard Neustadter to adopt the 2025 resolutions. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave Schuler. Dave Schuler explained each resolution and answered questions. Motion passed. (See Adopted Resolutions attachment.)
12. Motion by Dave Schuler nominating Jane Dougherty Sandstrom to the group of Advisory Committee members. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Dougherty. Motion by Richard Neustadter to appoint the recommended group of water users to serve on the 2025 Advisory Committee. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave Schuler. Motion passed.

  - A. Headgates are required on every diversion.
  - B. Measuring devices are required on diversions with flow rates greater than .24 cfs or greater than 5 acres.
  - C. Lateral Managers are required for every measured diversion.
  - D. Time extensions may be granted for justifiable reasons, (i.e., Fish Screens, pending NRSC grant funds, federal permits)
15. Discussed the following:
  - A. Watermaster will conduct a measurement visit at least once each month.
  - B. Lateral Managers will provide the watermaster with a measurement at least once each month and whenever an adjustment changes the last measured flow rate.
  - C. Only the watermaster and lateral managers are authorized to make headgate adjustments.
