RECITALS

1. The Board is authorized under chapter 17, title 42, Idaho Code to operate a water supply bank and to contract with lessors to act as an intermediary in facilitating the rental of water.
2. The Lessor has filed a completed application to lease water rights described below into the Water Supply Bank on forms supplied by the Idaho Department of Water Resources and received by the Department on December 22, 2022.
3. The Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources has reviewed the application for compliance with the Water Supply Bank rules and has approved the Lease subject to conditions listed below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and contracts herein contained, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. **WATER RIGHTS:** The Lessor shall lease and the Board shall accept into the Bank the Applicant's water rights described as follows:

2. **COMPENSATION:** The Lessor shall accept and the Board shall pay compensation determined by the amount of water rented under the following rental rate during such times as the water is rented from the Bank over the term of this Lease.

Minimum Payment Acceptable: Current Rental Rate

3. **TERM OF LEASE:** The term of this lease shall be January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2025. This Lease shall bind the parties and take effect when both parties have signed it.
4. **WATER SUPPLY BANK CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE:** The Lessor shall abide by all terms and conditions contained in the Water Supply Bank Conditions of Acceptance, attached hereto as "Attachment A" and incorporated herein by this reference.
5. **CHANGE OF WATER RIGHT:** This lease specifies water right elements including but not limited to: diversion rates; diversion volumes; number of acres authorized to be irrigated; places of use; points of diversion; beneficial uses; and seasons of use. During the term of this lease, if a water right is administratively changed due to a water right split and renumbering, this lease may be reduced by an equal amount to reflect the water right elements as legally defined under the water right. If a lease contract cannot be reduced sufficient to reflect the legal definition of a water right as amended through a water right split and/or water right transfer, the Board may release the water right from the Water Supply Bank.
6. **ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT:** This lease is between the Board and the Lessor, who is the recognized owner or designated representative of the recognized owners of water rights described herein. Should ownership of any part of a water right herein described change during the term of this lease, either through a water right split, a water right transfer, sale of property to which the water right is appurtenant, or through any other recognized water right reassignment, the lease benefits and obligations to the conditions of acceptance for any such water rights will be assigned to the new owners.
7. **DUPLICATE ORIGINAL:** This Lease is executed in duplicate. Each of the documents with an original signature of each party shall be an original.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

1. The water rights referenced above will be rented from the bank at the current rental rate.
2. There is no rental payment to the lessor of the water right if the right or a part thereof is not rented from the bank.
3. While a right is in the bank, the lessor may not use the right without approval of the Department even if the right is not rented from the bank. Any violation of the terms of this lease may result in enforcement procedures pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-351 for illegal diversion and use of water and may include civil penalties pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701B.
4. A right accepted into the bank stays in the bank until the Board releases it, or the lease term expires. A right may be released from the bank upon request, provided the Board approves the release. Unless approved by the Department, leased rights may not be immediately available for release.
5. While a water right is in the bank, forfeiture provisions are stayed pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-223(5).


6. Rental of water under this right is subject to the limitations and conditions of approval of the water right.
7. Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of acceptance is cause for the Director to rescind acceptance of the lease.
8. Acceptance of a right into the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other Department application process.
9. In accordance with Idaho Code § 42-248 and § 42-1409(6), all owners of water rights are required to notify the Department of any changes in mailing address or change in ownership of all or part of a water right. Notice must be provided within 120 days of the change.
10. If a water right leased into the Water Supply Bank is sold or conveyed during the lease term, and if the leased right was rented, the rental proceeds will be disbursed in the following manner regardless of any arrangements between the buyer(s) and seller(s) to the contrary:
 - a. Rental payments will go to the lessor(s) of record at the beginning of the rental season, even if the Department processes a Notice of Change in Water Right Ownership during the rental season.
 - b. New lessor(s) of record will receive payment for any subsequent rental seasons.
11. The water right(s) is leased to the bank subject to all prior water rights and shall be administered in accordance with Idaho law and applicable rules of the Department of Water Resources.
12. The right holder shall maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type approved by the Department in a manner that will provide the watermaster suitable control of the diversion.
13. Use of water under this right may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 37.
14. The quantity of water decreed for this water right for stockwater use is not a determination of historical beneficial use.
15. The quantity of water under this right for stockwater use shall not exceed 13,000 gallons per day.
16. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 3.5 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
17. The right holder shall make full beneficial use of all surface water available to the right holder for irrigation of lands within the authorized place of use for this right. The right holder may divert ground water under this right to irrigate land with appurtenant surface water rights when the surface water supply is not reasonably sufficient to irrigate the place of use for this water right or is not available due to drought, curtailment by priority, or the seasonal startup and shutoff or maintenance schedule for canal company deliveries. The right holder shall not divert ground water for irrigation purposes under this right if use of the surface water supply is intentionally discontinued or reduced (for example abandoned, forfeited, sold, disallowed by court decree, or leased to the Water Supply Bank), or is not deliverable due to non-payment of annual assessments, without an approved transfer pursuant to Section 42-222, Idaho Code, or other Department approval.
18. The unleased portion of right 37-22124 shall not exceed the irrigation of 0.4 acres.

13	<p>Narrative: The Department received these applications on December 22, 2022. The applicant wishes to place 1.1 acres and the stockwater from 37-22124 and the entirety of 37-23060 in the Bank. The parent of 37-23060, 37-2639B, and 37-22421 were decreed in 2010. The rights were involved in transfers in 2017, which validated the water rights. Before the transfers, there were no supplemental conditions on 37-23060. The portions offered to the Bank were placed in the Bank in 2018-2022. There are no issues with forfeiture. 37-22124 is an irrigation and stockwater right of 1.5 acres from the Big Wood River. 37-23060 is an irrigation right for 1.1 acres from ground water. This will leave 0.4 acres for irrigation around the house. These rights are currently within WD 37, Big Wood River moratorium, SRB area moratorium, BWR groundwater management area and the Galena Groundwater District.</p>

All,

First, it looks like on the 2017-2022 lease, they requested to lease in only 0.7 acres of the ground water, per their Attachment 2, but I leased the entire right. (I don't know why, but considering I was 3 months new it's likely a mistake). The new applications for 2023-2027 have a duplicate of the same attachment 2 for the surface right with them, so the one for the ground water right wasn't submitted to us for only 0.7 acres of the ground water. Both the previous and current lease applications state only a portion is offered of each right, and that they need to install a new pump to divert the surface right. The applicant should have resolved the pump issue during the last 5 years, and perhaps this should be a requirement before we approve another lease to avoid enlargement of the ground water right. A new lease for these rights should probably be as they requested, with 0.4 acres of both sources unleased.

Sunny with WD 37 is now aware of their delivery of ground water over surface water, and ***should*** work with them to resolve the discrepancy, but we can guide the applicants as well by sending an email that -1. While the attachment 2 for the ground water right was not included, the amount of ground water leased would only be 0.7 acres vs 1.1 acres. -2. They are required per a condition of their water rights to use the surface water first (-3. They are required to install a new surface water pump before we would lease in the remainder of the two rights into the bank to avoid enlargement of the rights).

Considering they asked to do something right the first time, and my mistake made them ***partially*** out of compliance, I don't think what they did in the past was entirely their fault. We should work to set them up for success going forward.

I sent an email to the watermaster (see below) and she isn't sure why the water hasn't been delivered. I am going to send an email to the applicant and the attorney that has helped her in the past to see if I can get some answers. I am not sure how to state that we could place the entirety of the surface water right in the Bank and 0.7 acres of the groundwater right so she can continue to irrigate 0.4 acres but then we will turn this over to compliance for a violation if there is in fact a violation. Below is what I have started:

I am in the process of reviewing these applications to lease a portion of 37-22124 (surface water) and all of 37-23060 (groundwater) to the Water Supply Bank. It appears you wish to continue to irrigate 0.4 acres with the groundwater right, 37-23060 as there is no system in place to divert the surface water right, 37-22124. There is a condition on water right 37-23060 that states: *"The right holder shall make full beneficial use of all surface water available to the right holder for irrigation of lands within the authorized place of use for this*

right. The right holder may divert ground water under this right to irrigate and with appurtenant surface water rights when the surface water supply is not reasonably sufficient to irrigate the place of use for this water right or is not available due to drought, curtailment by priority, or the seasonal startup and shutoff or maintenance schedule for canal company deliveries. The right holder shall not divert ground water for irrigation purposes under this right if use of the surface water supply is intentionally discontinued or reduced (for example abandoned, forfeited, sold, disallowed by court decree, or leased to the Water Supply Bank), or is not deliverable due to non-payment of annual assessments, without an approved transfer pursuant to Section 42-222, Idaho Code, or other Department approval." This condition makes the groundwater right a supplemental right. The transfer approved in 2017 was to move the point of diversion. It appears that this has not been accomplished within the one-year time frame allowed with the transfer.
