The Permit Holder submitted Extension Request on July 30, 2025, requesting a one-year extension. I called the Permit Holder on August 12, 2025, and advised that there were no more extensions allowed for good cause pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-204(3)(f).

I advised that if the Department processed the Extension Request as it was submitted, it would be denied. I offered the Permit Holder to withdraw their Extension Request and submit a Statement of Completion (Proof) for the beneficial use that has been developed. To Whom it may Concern:

We filed the first extension in 2020 and were struggling to get a well driller to come. We contacted Mike Frandsen with Mountain West Well Drilling and at that time they were booked out and I got on his waiting list and he just kept pushing us off so in September of 2023 we were able to get hooked up with Kenny Vulmer with Vulmer Well Drilling and he said he could come in the Spring of 2025 so he came in May of 2025 and started drilling the well. He finished June 20th, 2025, and he worked with John from PumpCo to schedule a time to pump the well and develop and test for gallons per minute which got delayed due to John having health issues and they were unable to come until July 22nd figuring they will have it completed on July 31st. After this process is completed the work on designing the pump to meet this water right. It would be beneficial to have a one-year extension, so we are not rushing it and get everything put in correctly.
