

MINUTES OF THE
ANNUAL ROCK CREEK WATER DISTRICT 47-0 MEETING
MARCH 2, 2026

The annual meeting of the Rock Creek Water District was held in the conference room at the Office of IDWR at 2:30 PM.

The meeting was called to order by the 2026 meeting Chairman, David Crockett. In attendance were nine members, or representatives of members, and three representatives of IDWR.

The minutes of 2025 were read and approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT: It was reported that we are continuing to maintain a sufficient amount of overage each year to take us through the winter months and get ready for each new season.

ELECTION OF WATERMASTER AND SECRETARY/TREASURER: The existing Watermaster, Amie Duke and Secretary/Treasurer Shari Helman agreed to continue in their positions with the District. A motion was made and seconded to retain them both for another year. Motion carried.

WATERMASTER 2026 BUDGET PROPOSAL: The budget proposed and approved was to remain the same as it was in 2025: Which was \$6500 Watermaster, \$750 for Secretary/Treasurer; \$525 for Workers Comp and \$125 for Misc expense.

OLD BUSINESS: There didn't seem to be any business of concern from the previous year.

NEW BUSINESS: The only thing that seemed to be on the mind of all users was: "What is going to happen this irrigation season since we have had very little snow". An IDWR member showed the group some video's of what the water storages in different areas are looking like at this time. Some areas, are looking quite dismal for the 2026 irrigation season.

WATERMASTER REPORT: Amie shared with the group the difference in the times that she has had to cut the use of the certain water rights for the last several years. It seems as though she was trying to soften the blow for this upcoming irrigation season. She did tell all larger user to go ahead and start charging their ditches etc. so that what water they get during the season will get to them a bit easier.

Be sure all your headgates and measuring devices are in good working order for the upcoming irrigation season.

ADVISORY BOARD: No changes needed concerning the Advisory Board. Members for 2026 remain to be Trevor Mulberry, Main Creek and East Ditch; Hal Frazier, Minimum Users on Main Creek and David Funk, West Ditch.

RESOLUTIONS: No changes in the resolutions, at this time.
