# Little Canyon Creek Water District #61-D Minutes of the Meeting January 14, 2019 At 11:00 am Glenns Ferry City Hall

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 11:05am, January 14, 2019, by Nathan Jones.

Water users in attendance: Rusty Trail, Mark Anderson, Angela Anderson, Paul Batruel, Ann Cornell, Nathan Jones, Teresa McCallum, Bob and Mary Hall, Erik Boe-IDWR, and Rob Whitney-IDWR.

Reading of Minutes: Heather Williams provided minutes. Rusty moved to approve as submitted, 2nd by Mark. Motion was passed by unanimous consent.

Treasurer's Report: Heather provided treasurer's report the current balance in the bank account is \$2721.48.

Previous years water report: There were 5 call outs last year. Rusty asked to be present at all water delivery changes at his diversion. Water Resources suggested that we attempt to find a more permanent Watermaster.

Old Business: None

New Business: Rob Whitney passed out a flyer and presented a new operations manual. Also informed the district that the State is now pushing for there to be a logging of water usage by the users, that the Watermaster should record usage. There was a long discussion about timing and creek flow changes. The records would be used to determine assessments as averaged over 5 years. It was decided to remain as we are on assessments, even though it is not according to State Statue. It was discussed that all measuring devices need to be in working order for the records to be kept also. This topic needs to be considered for next year.

Proposed Budget: Heather provided a budget for next year, this was moved by Rusty, 2nd by Paul. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Motion was made by Rusty to approve the By-Laws for the 2019 irrigation season, 2nd by Bob. Motion was passed by unanimous consent.

Nathan Jones questioned Paul Batruel that if a grant or some other funding could be found if he would be willing to move his upper diversion to the lower location at the Trails diversion. Paul answered that he would be unwilling to move the diversion.
