Budget

Terry Horton presented the proposed 2019 budget. She stated that upon finding out last year we are bonded by the Idaho Department of Water Resources, we no longer need the Bond insurance policy with CNA Surety and therefore did not renew the policy. Line item PERSI will go up in July as there will be a rate increase. Mileage went up from \$.545 to \$.58 per mile for the 2019 season.

Dick Thompson moved to accept the 2019 proposed budget as presented, Randy Noah 2nd, motion passed.

Terry Horton introduced Paul Arrington from the Idaho Water Users Association. She invited him due to the questions asked each year as to "What do they do for us?" Mr. Arrington introduced himself. John Sachtjen asked-What issues have they addressed in the past three years and how will it benefit us and what effects will it have on us? Mr. Arrington started with addressing the Endangered Species Act, especially the fish and how they affect irrigators. He then followed with discussions about water issues and problems in other parts of the state, ending with infrastructure projects across the state.

Harmon Horton suggested we move to a new venue next year due to the increased numbers at this meeting.

Harmon Horton moved that we move to the Exhibit Hall at the Washington County Fairgrounds, Paul Striker 2nd, motion passed.

Randy Noah asked about the water outlook. Vernon Lolley reported on the last snow measurements and with the recent storms the outlook is improving.

Nick Miller from Idaho Department of Water Resources introduced Aaron Skinner and that he has appointed him as the liaison to this district to get things back up and moving forward with the 2018 Measurement Compliance Order.

Watermaster mention that most are in compliance and that there are still a few waiting to hear back from the department about their request for variance or extensions.

Harmon Horton moved to asked Adams and Washington counties if they will continue to collect and disperse the monies through the taxing system, Dick Thompson 2nd, motion passed.
