Chairman Doyle Fackler called the meeting to order.

Minutes:

The July 9, 2012, meeting minutes were presented in written form to all persons in attendance to review. Chairman Fackler asked if there were any additions or corrections. Howard Sevy moved and Darlene Maxwell seconded to approve the July 9, 2012, minutes as presented. Passed.

Financial

Report:

Chairman Fackler asked Ron to review the financial statement for the district. Ron reported a checking account balance of \$1,676.49 and a balance in the State Treasury Fund of \$172,516.31 resulting in a checking and savings total of \$174,192.80. Total accounts receivable equaled \$8,235.71. The fixed assets will remain at \$72,037.21 producing a total assets balance of \$254,465.72. Ron then reviewed the profit and loss statement and stated that as of August 13, 2012, the District is showing a negative net income of -\$61,972.90. Ron reminded members that this balance will change when the administration fees from the water bank are received. Chairman Fackler asked if there were any other questions or concerns. Dennis Lammey moved and Wayne Martin seconded to approve the Financial Statement as presented. Passed.

At this time, Ron took the opportunity to introduce Mark Haws who is the representative for Letha, Rasmussen Ditch and Lake Reservoir.

IDWR

Report

Chairman Fackler turned the floor over to Liz Cresto with the Idaho Department of Water Resources. She reviewed the daily accounting flow charts as of August 12, 2012 and the stored water supply figures. Accounted storage is 834,703 AF unaccounted storage is 37,737 AF for a total storage available of 872,440 AF. Total storage used is 193,080 AF which results in an averaging error of 1,288 AF.

Watermaster's

Report:

Ron then reported on the storage use to date. Black Canyon has used a total of 50,058AF with 164,741AF remaining; Emmett Irrigation has used 6,480AF with 44,005AF remaining and Farmers Co-op has only used 3AF with a remaining 22,179AF available.

The teacup chart for the Boise River system is at 72% of capacity and the Payette Reservoir System is 75% full, which includes Cascade Reservoir at 75% full and Deadwood at 77%.

Cost Share

Program:

Ron reviewed the 2012 Cost Share Applications. He stated that the Washoe Irrigation river diversion improvement project will not be completed this year, therefore, freeing up funds. Farmers Co-op Irrigation has requested the money be applied to their Rome Beauty Lateral Improvement project. Much discussion ensued. Washoe's Chairman, Wayne Martin stated he has discussed this with his board but will phone poll them to confirm this project will not be completed in 2012. Moved by Darlene Maxwell and seconded by Dennis Lammey to release funds from the Washoe Irrigation 2012 Cost Share project to the Rome Beauty Lateral Project, contingent on Washoe Irrigation board approval. Passed.

Rental Pool

Committee:

Ron opened discussion and presented the new format of the proposed Rental Pool Rules. As discussed at the July meeting the option approved to set the rates was 10% of \$17.00 or \$1.70 to be paid to IWRB; \$1.30 to be paid to the WD #65 Administration Fee and \$14 to the Lessor. Ron encouraged the members to take home and compare the old format to the proposed new format. Also included in the changes was the addition of special conditions for rental of water for in basin and downstream hydropower generation. Any suggestions or comments will then be discussed at the next regular board meeting.

Radio

Repeater:

Ron reported on the radio Repeater Tower progress and stated that the top half of the free standing tower purchased from Mr. Henggeler will be used for the South Tower and the bottom half could be placed at Squaw Butte at a later date it the district finds a need to do so. Ron is planning to start the tower construction next week and stated he will wait until the 2013 budget to install the equipment.

<u>September</u>

Meeting:

Chairman Fackler opened discussion on whether a September meeting needed to be held or not. Discussion ensued. Moved by Dennis Lammey and seconded by Howard Sevy to skip the September meeting. Passed. The next regular board meeting will be held on Monday, October 8, 2012.

Adjournment: Chairman Fackler asked if there was any further business that should be considered at this meeting, hearing none the meeting was adjourned.
