On March 15, 2013 I traveled to the head of Cold Springs Creek to assess the water available to be distributed among the water users. All water at the Charter Mountain Ranches diversion was directed into the main line. According to the magnetic flow meter on the mainline, Charter Mountain was within their 3.38 CFS early water rights. Stock water usage was less than 1CFS and irrigation usage was 1 CFS. There was no additional water for down stream users.

On April 8th Double Anchor called for a check on available water. There still wasn't sufficient water to pass the diversion at the head of the stream. I took pictures of the stream and showed them to Harly at the Double Anchor Ranch.

I checked the stream one more time in late April and found less than 2 CFS total in the stream and felt there was no further need for a Water Master to check the stream and didn't receive any call outs.
