Just wanted to say thanks for meeting with Ed and I regarding Cold Springs Creek water rights distribution last week. We were quite pleased with the conversation - as we stated, the actions of IDWR and the watermaster have been beneficial for the water users on Cold Springs Creek over the past couple of years.

As an aside, at last week's meeting we spoke about CDN's right no. 61-10383 diverted from springs. My client explained to me today that the pipe diverting that right is flowing at a very high rate - so high that if the water were measured and CDN's right restricted to its entitled flow, that the remaining flows from that spring would be significantly contributing to the flows of Cold Springs Creek.
