WATER MASTER'S 2012

ANNUAL REPORT

I would like to thank all of the Water District Members as a whole for the overall cooperation on the call of water during this last irrigation season. Marsh Creek Water District members were all paid this last year. I believe in most cases that we did work as a team when it counted.

It will be noted that I appointed three individuals as assistant Water Master's when I was not in the area this last season. They were Earl Warthen, Leroy Robinson and George Montgomery and I would like to thank you on behalf of the Water District. This is to take-away any liability from the Water District and IDWR in case of an accident.

It was a very unusual irrigation season. We had very small amount of snow pack in the mountains. It created a short fall for our live stream irrigation. Our only storage is with the Six S Ranch's two Reservoirs which were full up into June. I'll give you an example of two seasons: June 27, 2011 we had 92.5 CFS on 18 feet (4,625 ") going over the slip and on June 27, 2012 the following year I had ZERO CFS going over same slip! The season as a whole was very poor, the rain came at the wrong time for growth and we had most of our User's off of water by the middle portion of June. Our projected CFS for 2012 fell way short of pròposed water budget by 3400 CFS thus creating a CFS share cost from \$2.92 to an actual cost of \$4.26 per share. I did call for all of the water right off the first right on Howell Creek the 1st part of July versus leaving 1.0 CFS as of Oct 9, 2011.

- It will be noted that Amos Creek ran all season (estimated 1.60cfs max to .35cfs min).
- Summit. Cow Gulch and Antone/Pine Creeks did not perform their usual task, season very short.
- Rose Creek and Broad Hollow both started out slow but Rose Creek lasted all season with Broad Hollow cancelling out In June for beneficial use.
- Most of the springs along the whole mountain frontage of the Water District have yet to reestablish.

City of Albion, with piping of their delivery system from the central distributing diversion off of Vaughn Ditch Lateral (located on Six S Merrill Ranch) to the cities central point of distribution to both the city of Albion and the Albion Heritage Group LLC (known as the Campus) delivering the full 1.35cfs. Cities call of .91cfs and .44cfs to Campus. The first water right known as (WD-307 originally before transfers)) went on rotation August 5, 2012 consisting of the following Users.

Six S Merrill Ranch, City of Albion, Albion Heritage Group, Ben Chatburn Estates (Vance, Gardner, & Fields)

It will be noted that Most of the decreed surface users have resolved their problems with their delivery systems which have been implemented.

- Some weirs that were implemented again need additional work done to them.
- We still have a few diversion and measuring devices that are not in line legally, who have yet to adhere or comply too the water districts request in the extension given by the board in our last few meetings.
- Howell Creek 18" Parshall Plume, Diversion "HB" was leveled out by Grant Clark and works great.

We need those diversions corrected so delivery of water can be measured correctly and not estimated. Those individuals not in compliance will be sent a personal request.

As your Water Master, again on Feb. 7, 2013, I placed Earl Warthen's name in for nomination to represent MCWD45F at all meetings with Water District 140 dealing in the Ground Water Exercise, Shawn Burton Maintenance Mgr. Albion City, as alternate.

Additional Action Items:

I am requesting as your current Water Master, some action from this delegation today on the following items:

- Again, we need a clarification from the Water master of 140 as to the specific type of Flow-meter that is
 required for the deep wells. I am still receiving inquiries from Deep Well users the type of flow-meter to best
 measure an inline flow on a closed system (surface).
- The members of the Water District 45F to continue with considering using the Water District No. 140 staff in certifying the wells. Still under consideration is the reading and posting data, generating annual reports for the state by the Watermaster of 45F, thus eliminating excessive undue cost. The Watermaster of 45F would not be charging the hourly rate that Water District No. 140 would charge.

Notice of Change in Water Right Ownership: Individual's who purchase property ground, need to get there water right transfers and property deeds inline and registered with Idaho Department of Water Resources. This last year I'm running into this problem with the Asher and Chatburn Estate Ranch's. The diversions need to be recorded within 90 days! As it stands right now I have incomplete data in recording a proper distribution in charging individuals and down the road when an individual calls for his water I might either be long or short depending on the individual's CFS

DELINQUENT BILLING:

> USER'S THAT HAVE YET TO PAY THEIR 2012 water bill will not have water delivered in 2013 till it's been paid per the Resolution Adopted 3/05/2012. Statements were sent out January 25th., 2013.

Attachment "A"

Delinquent Accounts:

Whereas, Water District 45F has by resolution established April 1, as the due date for Water charges as adopted in the approved budget, and

Whereas, Idaho Code Title 42-613 permits the district to set by resolution interest and Penalties for delinquent accounts,

Be It Resolved, Accounts not paid by April 1, of the year they are assessed shall be Delinquent and be charged interest at a rate of 1% per month from April 1, until paid. Further, accounts not paid in full by December 31, of the year billed shall be charged a penalty of 10%. **Interest will continue to accrue until account is paid in full.**

Adopted: March 6, 2006 by unanimous consent

The Legal Pump Diversions in creek's:

The Water District did indicate through Allen Merritt's ruling (a Few Years back) that if that water right is down to a portion of the right and it has to go to the next in line, it is shut off irregardless, if the individual persists to use a pump then there shall be a monitor required instead of guessing on usage.

As the Water-master, here are some following options that <u>SHALL</u> be implemented. 'ABB C-700 Water Meters vary from the Minimum of ¼ GPM to 25 GPM maximum (3/4"size) to a 1" to 2" sizes that will deal in GPM from ¾ to 2 and max out respectively 25 to 50 GPM. See me for more information.

Point of Interest:

Six-S Ranch developed a new Reservoir during the 2004 season, completing the project in December 2004. The dam that was constructed is called "Point of Rocks Dam" was constructed to a height of 25+/- feet. The homogenous/zoned earth fill dam provides storage of 253 acre-feet for irrigation, recreation, and fish and wildlife propagation. Although originally designed as a thin core dam, the dam was constructed as a section dam with the upper 2/3 consisting of impervious material and the lower 1/3 of pervious material. The irrigation project services an area consisting of 1,541 irrigable acres under existing distribution systems from Marsh Creek.
