
# Water Master's 2014 Annual Report

DEPT OF WATER RESOURCES SOUTHERN REGION

I would like to thank all of the Water District Members for the overall cooperation on the call of water during this last irrigation season. I believe in most cases we worked as a team when it counted. Marsh Creek Water District members have all paid their water shares accept for two members which equated to \$44.31 this last year.

It was a very unusual irrigation season. We went into our 3<sup>rd</sup> year of drought. The snow pack moisture was poor in the mountains, really did not have the moisture that everyone was predicting. The rains created the moisture that developed good crops but caught a lot of hay, Bean growers with their crops down, therefore dropping the price of hay and a few fires developed out of bailing too soon. We had no snow fall with any moisture until late April (1 good snow pack in the extreme higher altitude). Then we had some rain fall taking away a lot of the snow pack.

The water district did end up with a billable CFS of 5919.59 short of the projected five year average of 6899.05. The graph below shows, April through the 1st half of June was where half of our Users had a portion of their water and the last half of June the majority had been pulled off of surface water. Therefore pushing the CFS cost up from the Approved operating budget for 2014.



The overall 2014 season the Albion Valley had a total moisture count from my Rain Gage 24.141 inches as indicated above, was due to rain.

Again it will be noted that the Rock Dam Reservoir for Six S Ranch storage right had almost been completely used, the reservoir ended up with less storage since it had been put into operation in 2004.

I was able to start turning water back to the upper valley rights. It will be noted that Howell Creek was the Primary creek maintaining a higher flow than the other two creeks (Marsh and Land Creeks).

Summit Creek that normally extends the upper Users water on Howell Creek by helping those Users on Howell Creek below 1000 south was not available during the whole season. Antone-Pine Creeks ran very short and only one User got the maximum flow at one point, an estimated .35 CFS (Apr-May).

Marsh Creek Water District is primarily a Surface Water Irrigation District. Water in some cases is diverted into ponds and pumped through pivots, wheel lines, hand lines or just surface irrigation. Very few Ground Water rights (29), City of Albion with (4) wells handling domestic and fire Protection.

We are entering into 2015 with decisions that the farmers will either have to set aside ground and or go with crop's that does not extend way into the late summer and fall. As of this report date, if there's no change in the snow pack there will be no high water considered in the MCWD-45F as we have in the past. The Anderson storage pond and slip are currently dry (No water has been delivered to the Snake River). IDWR may again be looking at possible mitigation dates dealing with ground water.

Oakley Water District 140:

As the Watermaster of 45F, I appointed Earl Warthen as Primary person representing MCWD45-F at all meetings with respect to Water District 140, dealing with Ground Water and Shawn Burton, Maintenance Mgr. City of Albion as the alternate member. They were approved at the annual Water District 140 meeting on Feb. 5, 2015.

 The members of the Water District 45F to continue with considering using the Water District No. 140 staff in certifying the wells. Still under consideration is the reading and posting data, generating annual reports for the state by the Water master of 45F, thus eliminating excessive undue cost.

I am requesting as the current Watermaster of 45-F, your consideration for action from this delegation today, for follow up this coming season on the following items:

#### Vaughn Lateral Marsh Creek:

City of Albion, central distributing diversion off of Vaughn Ditch Lateral (located on Six S Merrill Ranch) to the cities central point of distribution (piped) to both the city of Albion and the Albion Heritage Group LLC (known as the Campus) delivering a full 1.35cfs. Cities call of .91cfs and .44cfs to Campus.

- Note: The cities new POD/POU transfer of .26cfs was approved for that portion of the City of Albion's .91cfs to be used to supplement the city's sewage ground (East of Albion) due to a DEQ requirement. Therefore, the city of Albion has only .65cfs for regular irrigation during regular flow of Marsh Creek. Also, when All of Marsh Creek has been diverted to Vaughn Ditch Lateral, the transfer does not prevail and the .91cfs is then available for their full right for irrigation.
- The Heritage Campus (Troy Mortensen) is considering making changes and a Diversion change on the Cities delivery system directing their water right to a pond and piped to his pump system.
- The other consideration presented to the city of Albion is to rid the waste water from the Heritage Campus down Main Street (Hwy 77) to ground that use to go back to creek for beneficial use to be redirected from the Wickel diversion to Whitman creek return (using an ole channel). Would require approximately 150 feet of travel. This was reviewed last season by all concerned parties (Albion Mayor/Council member and Maintenance Supervisor plus Heritage Campus and the other First Right Water User's 4/1/1873.

#### Starrh Ditch Lateral:

The Users have yet to apply a diversion head-gate and weir with a staff gage at the Adam-Meyer diversion on Starrh Ditch to handle the proper delivery of water call, when the call for 45-0217 is also being called.

Also, the 9" Parshall Flume (directly off Marsh Creek) needs to be repaired (balanced both horizontal & vertical) in order to get a proper reading.

Most of the decreed surface users have resolved their problems with their delivery systems which have been implemented.

- We still have a few diversion and measuring devices that are not inline legally, who have yet to adhere or comply too the water districts request with the extension given by the board in our last few meetings.
- (Anton-Pine has yet to comply at POD's with weirs, head-gates and staff gauges.
- The same with the Berrert Lateral has yet to comply along the lateral.
- Kelley's portion of Berrett channel going thru the Elk Ranch needs maintained so water can be delivered when called by the GCW Ranch on the Upper Bench meadows.
- Some weirs that were implemented need additional work done to them and maintained with maintenance and cleaning of surface growth. Note primary problem below with Water Speedwell.

#### Additional Action Items:

THE WATER DISTRICT currently has two water transfers in motion. One (1) is currently in protest Application Permit No. 45-14456 and the other has yet to be published (WD 45F-13463 (Elaine Asher) which, will directly involve the Starrh Ditch Lateral, if approved, will decrease total CFS that has been currently released in the previous years on rotation.

There is a new weir at the Cities approved POD on Marsh Creek which will need to be GPS by IDWR and at the same time I will be requesting additional POD's to be GPS.

**Notice of Change in Water Right Ownership / and Water Transfers:** Individual's who purchase property need to get their water right transfers and property deeds inline and registered with Idaho Department of Water Resources and the MCWD Watermaster. The new property, owners need to be recorded within 90 days!

Note: The Black Jack Ranch no longer owned by the Mahoney's was just recently purchased by the Albion 12 Investments LLC under the direction and operation of Mike Merriman.

The Legal Pump Diversions with in the creek's: The User will call the watermaster for delivery and the Water District through Allen Merritt's ruling, if the water right is down to a portion of the right it has to go to the next in line, it is shut off regardless. If an individual persists to use a pump then there shall be a monitor required instead of guessing on usage.

 Also, if pump has been used after they have been shutoff and notified, there is no water for the decreed date, the pump will be pulled with a possible fine. The following is an option that <u>SHALL</u> be implemented by the watermaster.

**Veronica anagallis Aquatica**, common name "Water Speedwell". Cassia County Weed Abatement, Gordon Edwards indicated that Rodeo will take it out. This weed has been mistaken as Night Shade by some. It is throughout all creek channels, delivery ditches within the Albion Valley and also the reservoirs. This weed is in the process of chocking off the water channels, especially Howell Creek and note below the picture on Land Creek.

## Water speedwell

Family: Scrophulariaceae

Range: Throughout the United States.

Habitat: Near aquatic environments, including ditches, slow streams,

pond and stream margins, wet meadows, and marshy places.


Impacts. Can form dense stands in aquatic systems and impede the flow of water. Also weeds in Canada and South America.

Water speedwell is an emergent biennial or perennial to 3 ft tall, with glabrous opposite leaves. Plants typically develop a system of rhizomes and for stolons. The stems are erect to spreading, sometimes creeping and often rooting at lower nodes. The leaves are usually sessile and 1 to 4 inches long with a smooth to serrate margin.
