Chip opened the meeting at 7:02

Chip motion's to have Aaron Andrews be the speaker of the election meeting. Sherri seconds the motion.

Aaron opens the floor for nominations for Water Master.

Doug Surerus nominates Lawrence Kimball to be Water Master for the 2015 water year. Ed Wilde seconds the nomination.

Ed motions to close nominations. Paul seconds the motion. Aaron calls nominations ceased.

Aaron-all in favor of Lawrence Kimball. All present vote in favor of Lawrence Kimball. No opposed votes. Lawrence Kimball will be the 2015 Water Master for Water District 37U Fish.

The past wages for the Water Master has been \$160/day. Aaron motions to keep the wages the same. Sherri seconds the motion. Motion passed.

Last year the water master worked for a total of 200 days from April 15<sup>th</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015. At 160/day that comes to \$32,000.

Aaron motions to set the budget at \$35,000. This will cover the water master wages and his insurance (\$1,600). Sherri seconds the motion. All in favor, motion passed. The water ran last year was 3,769.6 acre feet so the rate will be \$9.28 per acre foot ran.

The delivery rate will be set at a later time and depends on any moisture we may receive.

Assessments will go out the first of April and be due the first of May unless someone calls for water sooner.

Sherri motions to close the meeting. Chip seconds the motion. Meeting closed at 7:22.
