

Minutes of the meeting of Watermaster District 37N held February 7, 2017, at the Carey City Hall at 7:00 p.m. Present were board members Dusty Simpson, Dave Parke and Milo Mecham. Also Bryan Wood and Bob Simpson, and Dawn Bennion .

Waterusers present were Darin Parke, Greg Mann, and Nathan Erickson with IDWR.

Milo Mecham called the meeting to order and asked for nominations for a meeting chairman. Bob nominated Milo, Dave seconded. Voting was unanimous.

Milo then asked for nominations for a meeting secretary. Dusty nominated Dawn, Dave seconded and voting was unanimous. Kathi was nominated as treasurer by Dave, seconded by Greg and voting was unanimous.

Bryan Wood presented the watermaster budget for 2017. He noted that there was a slight increase in the budget due to a small salary increase for him and repairs for the truck. He noted that the board has decided to keep the old truck one more year and put new tires and brakes on . Hopefully, it can be replaced next year. Greg moved that it be accepted, Dave seconded it and the voting was unanimous.

Milo then opened the floor to nominations for watermaster. Dusty nominated Bryan Wood. Dave seconded the motion, voting was unanimous. Everyone expressed their happiness with the job Bryan did last year as his first full year as watermaster.

Bob gave a water report for our basin and the surrounding area. It was a much more positive outlook than the last couple years, with Little Wood at 160% of last year. Currently there is 23,405 a/f water in the reservoir and they opened the dam on Monday to lower the levels some. He noted that the city well has risen dramatically because of the water in the river. He will also start the hydro plant soon to generate some income on the release.

Greg expressed concern about the possible need for flood control. He will check on permits that may have expired and get an extension on maintenance.

Milo informed the waterusers that there is a non-election for the directors of the irrigation board since only two candidates filed. Dusty will represent district #4 and Dave district #5.

Next year's meeting will be the first Tuesday in February at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:44 p.m.
