MINUTES OF THE

ANNUAL ROCK CREEK WATER DISTRICT 47-0 MEETING

MARCH 5, 2018

The meeting was called to order by David Funk, the 2018 meeting chairman. There were 12 Rock Creek Water Users and guests, Amie Helman, Watermaster and Nathan Erickson of IDWR in attendance.

The 2017 minutes were read and approved.

Old Business: None to act upon at this time.

New Business: Election of Secretary/Treasurer and Watermaster. A motion was made and seconded, to retain Shari Helman as Secretary, and Amie Franklin as Watermaster; Motion carried.

There was a unanimous decision to leave the budget at \$7300 for the water year of 2018. This being \$6000 for the Watermaster; \$650 for Secretary/Treasurer; \$525 for Workers comp and \$125 for miscellaneous expenses.

Advisory Board: A motions was made and seconded to leave the Advisory Board members the same as last year; which were: Poncho of RCR, East Ditch & Main Creek; Brian Beckman minimum users on the Main Creek; and Rodney Hopwood, West Ditch and Billy Williams, the expansion area.

Watermaster Report: Amie reminded all users to be sure that all diversions and flow meters be in good working order before water deliveries begin.

Other Business: Valerie Smith mentioned she was wanting to change some of her water rights to be placed on different acreage; she is working through the Water Resources to accomplish this. The Historical Society Water Right was discussed for the Stricker sight, especially later in the year when getting the water down to them is so difficult.

The beaver issues, in the creek, was briefly discussed with, as usual, no real answers. David Funk mentioned that he had cleaned out a lot of the downfall blockage in the Rock Creek just North of the Rock Creek Store. Nathan, of Water Resources, mentioned that before doing this type of work we should go through certain steps to get proper authority to do so.

Motion to adjourn was made, seconded and passed.
