Annual Meeting

February 20, 2020

The annual meeting was called to order at the home of Ryan & Susanna Hughes at 7:00. Members present were Pat Hawkins, Jim & Tina Hawkins, Susanna & Ryan Hughes, Doug Parkinson and Ron Jones.

Copies of the minutes of the 2019 meeting were passed out by secretary Tina Hawkins. Ryan moved and Ron seconded the motion to approve them. The motion carried.

The 2019 Treasurers report was then given. The beginning balance was \$462.26 and the assessments collected were \$2,723.38, bank interest received of .50 which brings our total to \$3,186.14. The expenses were \$300.00 for workman's compensation insurance and \$2,545.40 in water master mileage. Making total expenses \$2,845.40, which leaves a balance of \$340.74. The 2020 Budget was then given in the amount of \$3,220.00. Pat moved that the treasures report be approved as given, Doug seconded and the motion passed. Ron moved that the 2020 budget be approved, Ryan seconded and the motion carried.

Jim attended the WD#170 January annual meeting in Challis. The possibility of filing for stock water rights on grazing allotments was reviewed. Scott Bedke an Idaho state legislator will be contacted by Jim about the proposed legislation. The IDWR now has their smart phone app up and working. It was decided that our district will continue to use paper reporting as before, after discussion was held. The types and costs of measuring devices available for pumps were then reviewed. The constant changes in IDWR requirements have been an issue for our district pumpers. Ron asked if there was any funding available for purchase of these measuring devices.

Water master Pat Hawkins received a letter from IDWR concerning a temporary drafting permit for water for drilling exploration for Breccia Gold of Canada. They will be exploring in the Panther Cr. drainage, but applied for eight drafting sites with one drafting site location in upper Morgan Cr. The permit will be for 120 days of use, with 12 hr. shift draft amounts of 5,000 with 12,000 gallons maximum in any 24 hour period. Ron reminded those present that the flow of Morgan Cr. as it crosses Highway 93 is 2 to 4 CFS in late summer. The consensus of those present is we agree to the "temporary use" IF:

- 1. The water being drafted does not affect the current water right deliveries.
- 2. The water being drafted does not affect the water temperatures in lower Morgan Cr. or in any way affect the Morgan Creek Grazing Association permits.
- 3. The water being drafted does not affect the minimum stream flow at the measuring site.
- 4. The mining company has looked into use of well water from the Cobalt and/or Panther Cr. Inn, or USFS Ranger Dist. areas, instead of the drafting of creek waters and the trucking costs involved in hauling it back over the summit to the work site?

The logistics of the water master job was then talked over. Pat again agreed to share the job and get it done as they did last year. Tyler will be contacted and allowed to decide before confirmation is given.

Elections were next. Ryan moved that all officers remain as 2019. Pat Hawkins & Tyler Hughes as joint water masters. Jim Hawkins as chairman, and Tina Hawkins as secretary/treasurer. The Hawkins' all agreed, then Doug 2nd and the motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM and everyone enjoyed the snacks and a good neighborly visit.

1) Enter water right holder name, corresponding IDWR water right number or numbers, and corresponding diversion name and/or remarks on page 2;

2) If you wish to estimate next season's assessments based on the average delivery of past seasons, then enter the actual water deliveries to each user for the past two to five seasons on page 3. You have the option of using at least the past two seasons or up to five seasons for averaging. You also have the option of using last year's delivery or one year's delivery as a basis of determining assessments for the next season. Enter deliveries as total 24-hour second feet. Total 24-hour second feet is a flow rate expressed in terms of one day or 24 hours. For example, a continuous diversion of 2 cfs over 20 days would equal 40 24-hour second feet.

3) If using the averaging method, enter the average delivery for past seasons in column 6 of page 3. If you are not averaging, then enter each user's delivery from last year in column 5 and skip column 6.

4) In the work space provided at the top of this page, enter next year's proposed watermaster salary, secretary and/or staff salaries, and expenses. You may use the past season costs and expenses, or average past seasons' costs and expenses as an aid in determining next year's budget. A more detailed listing or itemization of expenses and salaries can be attached to this form.

5) Divide the total proposed budget amount for next year by the total past season delivery (total of column 5, page 3) or average past seasons deliveries (total of column 6, page 3) to obtain a unit cost factor.

6) Under column 7, page 3, multiply the unit cost factor by each user's past season or average past seasons deliveries to obtain the estimated billing for the next year.

7) Use column 8, page 3, to enter the adjusted billing amount if the district wishes to carryover debits and credits from the previous season. (Refer to the last watermaster report. If a user had a credit, subtract that credit from his or her estimated billing in column 7 of this report, and enter the difference or adjusted amount in column 8. If a user had a debit, then add that debit to his or her billing amount shown in column 7 and show as adjusted billing in column 8.

8) Sign the report and retain to present to the water users at the next annual meeting for the water district.
