Dusty Simpson called the meeting to order and asked for nominations for a meeting chairman. Dave nominated Dusty, Greg seconded. Voting was unanimous.

Dusty then asked for nominations for a meeting secretary. Dave nominated Kathi, Greg seconded and voting was unanimous. Kathi was nominated as treasurer by Greg, seconded by Dave and voting was unanimous.

Bryan Wood presented the watermaster budget for 2021. He noted that there was no increase in the total budget over last year, but did reflect a 3% raise for the watermaster. Dave moved that it be accepted, Greg seconded it and the voting was unanimous.

Dusty then opened the floor to nominations for watermaster. Greg nominated Bryan Wood. Dave seconded the motion, voting was unanimous. Everyone is extremely happy with the job Bryan is doing.

In the absence of Bob Simpson, Bryan reported 12,900 a/f water currently in the dam. Last year at this time, there was 22,000. This last storm jumped up the percentages and the outlook for summer is a little better.

Bryan talked to the waterusers about the shrink that he has to deal with every year. It averages right at 30% but sometimes is as high as 50%. New landowners moving in do not understand this concept.

Dusty informed the waterusers that there is a non-election for the directors of the irrigation board since no one filed a petition to run against Milo and Dennis who will represent districts 1 & 2 for three year terms.

No resolutions were passed and the next year's meeting will be on the first Tuesday in February.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:35.m. By a motion from Milo, and seconded by Dave.
