President, Blake Matthews called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m. The meeting was held at the Oakley Canal Company Office at 100 West Elm Street, Oakley, Idaho.

I. Elections:

- 1. Meeting Secretary: Ryan Hawker made a motion to appoint Heidi Lloyd the meeting secretary, Ryan Cranney seconded the motion. All agreed, motion carried.
- 2. Election of Officers: Ryan Cranney made a motion to elect Ryan Hawker as Sec/Treas. Ryan Hawker seconded the motion. All agreed, motion carried. The officers will be as follows:

Blake Matthews - President

Ryan Hawker - Sec/ Treas.

3. Water master appointment: Ryan Hawker made a motion to continue the contract with Oakley Canal Co. for Water master responsibilities, with Chantry Whittle acting as the water master. Ryan Cranney seconded the motion, all approved, motion carried.

II. Minutes:

The minutes of the 2019 Annual Birch Creek Annual meeting were read by Blake Matthews. Ryan Cranney made a motion to approve the minutes, Ryan Hawker seconded the motion, all approved, motion carried.

III. Financial Report:

Heidi Lloyd was asked to present the financial report. The current bank balance is \$26,063.52. Five fees were presented for payment: \$5000.00 to Oakley Canal Company for the 2021 water master fees, \$300.00 to Heidi Lloyd for Secretarial Fees, \$1000 for the measuring devices, \$1440 for the water storage fee for the 2021 water season. Ryan Hawker made a motion to pay the bills, Ryan Cranney seconded the motion all agreed, motion carried. There was discussion about the B.C./OCC water use agreement and fees agreed upon. It is based upon 73.94 shares times \$19 per share. The assessment may be raised from \$19 to \$22 per share.

IV. Water master Report: The water master report was given by Chantry Whittle. Manning's used 10,761", Cranny's used 17,382.5", Matthews used 2,057.5" and Town Users used 3,024".

V. Old Business:

- 1. Delinquent accounts were discussed. It was understood that delinquent shares can be dissolved or purchased. Chantry Whittle will talk to the delinquent owners to see if they are willing to sell instead of letting them be dissolved. James Mullen asked if once the shares are dissolved if they can be recovered. Jana Reeder replied with, yes they can be recovered but it is a process. It was discussed that B.C. can purchase the shares and auction them off.
- 2. The diversion concrete will be done this Spring by Lloyd Brothers. The cost will be covered by the flood district.
- 3. Cranney's B.C. meter needs to be replaced. The cost of replacement will be Cranney's responsibility.
- 4. Ryan Hawker made a motion to accept the B.C./ OCC water use agreement for another year. Blake Matthews seconded the motion. All agreed, motion carried.

VI. New Business:

- 1. Agreement Nathan Erickson recommended that town users subordinate their rights to OCC. All users must sign agreement. Once this is done, OCC will be responsible for collecting assessments each year. Nathan Erickson agreed that the verbiage needs revised on the agreement.
- 2. Pipeline The pipeline will be void if Town Users sign agreement.
- 3. Manning Meter Chantry Whittle said he can pull the meter and replace the bearings. Blake Matthews replied, replace it or no water.
- 4. Concrete at Diversion Chantry Whittle reported that they were not able to add a weir in 2020, would like to add a weir in 2021, which will help the measuring device to operate properly.

The next Annual board meeting was scheduled for Monday, January 3th, 2022 at10:00 am at the Oakley Canal Company office. Ryan Cranney made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Ryan Hawker seconded the motion and meeting was adjourned at 10:54 a.m.
