**CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL**

1. Use of water under this water right will be regulated by the watermaster of State Water District No 120.
2. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the lands above.
3. Diversion and use of water under this right is subject to rules that may subsequently be promulgated for existing rights used for supplemental purposes.
4. The use of water under this right shall not give rise to any claim against the holder of a senior water right based upon the theories of forfeiture, abandonment, adverse possession, waiver, equitable estoppel, estoppel by laches or customary preference.

This license is issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 42-219, Idaho Code. The water right confirmed by this license is subject to all prior water rights and shall be used in accordance with Idaho law and applicable rules of the Department of Water Resources.
