IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES HEARING PROCEDURE REGARDING CREATION OF WATER DISTRICTS PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 6, TITLE 42, IDAHO CODE

February 4, 2002

Preliminary Matters

- 1. Director introduction and description of the nature of the proceeding.
- 2. Recognize department staff and any other officials in attendance
- 3. Circulate an attendance roster showing persons who desire to make a statement and whom they represent (for those who did not sign at the door).
- 4 Generally discuss the hearing procedure and answer any preliminary questions
- 5 Determine order of presentations:
 - either as they appear on the attendance roster, or
 - divided between speakers in favor of district creation and those opposed
- 6. Identify persons who will testify and on whose behalf.
- 7. Determine spokesperson for entities with multiple representation, as time constraints require.

Procedure

- 1 Prior to going on the record, the Director will make a presentation and take questions on the reasons for the proposed water district and how the district would operate
- 2. Accept and record oral statements and comments regarding the proposed district. Speakers will not be under oath and will not be subject to cross-examination. The Director may ask clarifying questions of the speakers, but will not respond to questions from the speakers or the audience while statements are being taken.
- 3. Accept written statements and comments at the hearing or until the close of the comment period on February 14, 2002. Exhibits may accompany an oral or written statement. All written statements and comments should identify the presenter and the proposed district to which the statement or comments relate.
- 4. The Director will issue a Final Order following the close of the ten-day comment period. A copy of the Final Order will be sent by regular mail to all holders of water rights affected by the order. Any party may file a petition for reconsideration with the Director within fourteen days of the service of the order.
