**CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL**

- 1 Right 35-07942 is also diverted through the point of diversion described above.
- 2 Rights 35-07942 and 35-08884 when combined shall not exceed a total annual maximum diversion volume of 1056.0 af at the field headgate, and the irrigation of 264 acres.
- 3 This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the lands above.
- 4 Use of water under this water right will be regulated by the watermaster of State Water District No. 120.
- 5 This right is for the use of trust water and is subject to review 20 years after the issuance of the permit to determine availability of water and to re-evaluate the public interest.

This license is issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 42-219, Idaho Code. The water right confirmed by this license is subject to all prior water rights and shall be used in accordance with Idaho law and applicable rules of the Department of Water Resources.
