Attached is the excel file you gave me that I updated with the revised 2000 diversion data for the Bear River Central Division. As you know, I entered data directly from the field notes supplied to me by Pete. As we discussed, I assume you will want to review this before updating your accounting program files and forwarding the data on to Jack Barnett. I don't believe I have all the 2000 call-in data that Jack received from Pete but I do have some call-in data for miscellaneous dates. I checked these miscellaneous call-in data against Pete's field note data and they match pretty close except for a couple of dates in late July and early August. I can explain the difference on one of the dates due to the confusion about the Black Otter return flow to Rainbow Inlet. I'm not sure of the difference in early August (about 30 cfs difference) but I suspect it is due to the same reason. I note too that call-in data to Jack and field note data are off 15 to 20 cfs for two dates in late June.

I think it might be a good idea to use the revised data and repeat the Central division reach gain calculations and graphs that Jack did last year that highlighted the differences between the call-in and final diversion data. This should probably be done before sending to Jack. What do you think? Is this something you have time to do? Tim
