Secretary Bill Gattung talked to Bob Foster of the Salmon office and Tim Luke of the Boise office IDWR concerning Williams Creek and the High Line Lateral Ditch. They both stated that the individual water rights would not be affected by the forming of the High Line Ditch Association and that the Shoup water rights would continue with each individual user. Other things were discussed which will be brought up in future meetings.


Measurements:


It was decided that Kevin Rice and Edward Tolman would construct the water measuring devices on the main Williams Creek diversion at the head of the High Line Ditch and also at the headgate that is now referred to as Headgate C where Bill Gattung, Jason Beyeler and David Logan divert water to their lands. The cost to the Association would be for materials only.

The measurements of these headgates will be taken by Watermaster Kevin Rice.

Cleaning of the High Line Lateral Ditch will be by Kevin Rice for a cost of \$500.00
