Dear Norm:

Jesse Creek has three abstracts of water rights and they are all decreed rights. We do not show any licenses or permits. They were decreed as first, second and third decrees and the abstracts were made accordingly. I do not know what abstracts were sent to Mr. Schofield, as they were sent from upstairs. At any rate, these water rights are the same ones that have been on record since they were decreed.

We will probably encounter problems as these old permits are licensed, but I do not know what we can do about them. Some of the water users might take legal action to have them declared abandoned.

I have been assured by the Appropriation Section that you are receiving copies of permits and licenses to use in keeping your records up to date. If you have not been receiving these copies, please let me know.
