The minutes of last years meeting were read and approved. The watermaster from the previous year did not do all of his job and part in no records in the state. Some Berline were put in as board members. The history of Shuman took was given by president James E. Salkin. Efforts have been made to contact Salkin and get a reservoir. The reservoir was never completed but work on the creek banks is progressing. Time to express the views of the "dove deer lake" organization.
