RESOLUTIONS PERTAINING TO THE TIME AND MANNER OF COLLECTING THE BUDGET AS
ADOPTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE USERS OF

WATER DISTRICT No. 11-F

Feb. 7, 2006

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. The annual meeting for 11-F was set for the second Tuesday of February for each year. The watermaster, Joel Teuscher, proposed the budget and explained the use of the funds for the coming year. The CFS's were used to figure out the \$3000.00 budget. Each CFS is being charged \$18. after discussion on the proposed budget it was accepted. June 1 was set as the due date for the assessments to be in. A motion was made that those not paying their fee will not have water delivered to them. After five years of not paying their assessment their water rights will be taken away.

Joel Teuscher was elected watermaster. Bill Parslow and David Petersen were reinstated as part of the advisory board. Rodney Boehme was also put back in as secretary and treasurer. All were made aware of the importance of securing their water rights.
