Dear Mr. Stoddard:

Enclosed is an order requiring water users that divert water from Mill Creek to install measuring devices and controlling works. This order also provides for watermaster control over all headgates and controlling works.

Please note that this order requires permanent measuring devices and lockable controlling works prior to the 1996 irrigation season.

Failure to install adequate measuring devices and controlling works for the 1996 irrigation season provides authority for the watermaster to shut off and refuse delivery of water to the diversion in question. In addition, water users having diversions not in compliance with this order may be subject to civil penalties of up to \$100 per day.

Measuring devices and/or controlling works should be installed at an adequate location that is accessible and as close as possible to the diversion from the natural channel.


