
Enclosed is the watermaster's proposed Budget for 1995 for water district 74-M, Agency Creek, near Tendoy, Idaho. It is late as it is because the watermaster never was called on last year due to the lack of water on the creek. Most users were out of water very early in the season, and realizing that very little snowpack existed, self-regulated their use so that those with senior rights would get what water they could.

As noted on the budget, no assessment is proposed because the watermaster feels that assessments collected in 1994 should cover his services and other costs for 1995.

In addition, I write this letter to inform the department of an upcoming water users budget meeting. I have scheduled it for April 3, at 7:00 PM, at the Tendoy School in Tendoy, Idaho. It is likely that 3-5 of the water users will be present, as some of the others are absentee landowners.

PROPOSED BUDGET FOR SUCCEEDING YEAR – Said Watermaster shall on or before November fifteenth in each year, also prepare and file with the secretary of said water meeting a proposed budget for the succeeding year, together with a distribution of the amount of said budget to the respective water users, using the actual deliveries for the past irrigation season or seasons, as the basis for said distribution as hereinabove provided, which said proposed budget and distribution shall be submitted to the water users for consideration and approval at the next annual water meeting.
