RESOLUTIONS PERTAINING TO THE TIME AND MANNER OF COLLECTING THE BUDGET AS
ADOPTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE WATER USERS OF

WATER DISTRICT No. 11-F

June 1, 2005 Emergency meeting

A form to dismiss Sherwin Mangum as water master was signed by the board members present. Also, a petition for a new water master was signed.

July 15, 2005 Reorganization meeting

Lon Tueller was reappointed as committee chairman. Garth Boehme nominated Rodney Boehme as secretary and Kert Price seconded it. Garth moved nominations cease. Rodney was put in by acclamation. Mike Sarton moved Rodney Boehme by treasurer, also, and Darren Peterson seconded it. Rodney was put in as both secretary and treasurer by acclamation. Mike Sarton nominated Joel Teascher to be watermaster. Garth Boehme moved nominations cease. Joel was put in as watermaster by acclamation.

Roger Warner from the Idaho Falls IDWR came to the meeting to answer any questions and to give direction. Frawseth Irrigation Company is really Water District 11-F and the other name has to be dropped. The watermaster really runs the district not the advisory chairman nor the board members. Idaho code 42605 section 4 says a minimum charge per point of diversion can be up to \$50.00, but the water delivered to a point of diversion should determine how much is charged.

Dane Raymond moved an additional \$20.00 be assessed to pay for additional expenses. Garth Boehme seconded it. This passed.

Roger Warner then explained how to make a change of ownership on water rights. To split a water right a deed needs to be sent to IDWR to show.

the proper title. Spouses usually have signature authority or a partner in your business. Also, send a map from FSA showing your property. A title company can look up these water rights for the owner.

North Boehme moved all committee members be reinstated. Mike Barton seconded it. This passed.

Those who haven't paid their assessment can be charged a 10% late fee and not have their water delivered until payment is received. One can pump from his point of diversion rather than flood irrigate, but it has to be the same point of diversion. The committee can be authorized in the annual meeting to enforce the payment of all assessments and the payment of late fees and the loss of use of water until the fees are paid.

North Boehme moved the meeting be adjourned. Kirt Price seconded it. This passed.
