The annual meeting of Water District 67-A was called to order by Lawson Howland at 1:30 P.M. on Monday, Jan. 22, 1996.

The minutes were taken by Scotti Yantis in the absence of Sec. Whitney Voermans.

A motion was made and passed to retain both the chairman and sec.-tres. respectively.

The minutes for last years meeting were read and approved. Also minutes from a special meeting June 21, 95 were also read.

Appointed to the Credentials Committee for 96 were Russell Wilkerson Bob Voermans and Tom Grossen.

David Birchard gave watermaster's report for the 95 irrigation season.

Steve Lester gave an update on the readjudication process. Reporting that the judge working on it is doing a better job and progress is being made. It will still be quite sometime before any work is done in our area of the state. Steve also reminded everyone that when buying property to get your name on the water rights as soon as possible.

David Birchard brought up for discussion the problems that had been found this last summer with our billing of certain water rights. We have been charging for some statutory water rights. According to Idaho law only water that can be delivered can be assessed. This category includes judicated, license and permits. A suggestion was made that the water master make changes as needed and possibly review these with members of the water district.

A motion was made to keep the water master salary at last years rate of \$3000. The motion was seconded and passed.

Bob Voermans gave a financial report and pointed out that the water district has come up short of funds the last two years. Non payment of taxes and the time lapse between voting in a new assessment and actually receiving the money has caused the district problems. Also this year we will lose some of the tax base when the statutory rights are removed from the tax rolls. It was recommended that as assessment of 27¢ per CFS for 96 should provide approximately \$5000. which will cover salaries for 96, replace 96 funds that had to be used to pay 95 bills and to allow for the possibility of delinquent taxes.

Following much discussion as to what water should or should not be included in the district a motion was made, seconded and passed to include any legal water rights on North Grays Creek since it is a tributary to the Little Weiser river. A motion was made to assess 27¢ per CFS for 96. The motion was seconded and passed.

Election of water master was next with two candidates running. Votes were cast by water shares using an updated list from IDWR.

Richard Kretten was voted in as 96 water master.

A motion was made and passed to destroy the ballots.

Advisory committee nominated and approved for 96 was Tom Grossen,

Other business included problems with beavers. Richard Kretten knows someone that might be interested in trapping them so he will look into it.

Steve Lester reminded everyone that the water master will be required to measure the river and the water delivered and report to IDWR. This is a new policy for 96.

Next years meeting will be in late January.

Chairman Lawson adjourned the meeting at 3:50 P.M.


