Dear Mr. Tuthill:

Your June 16 letter with the Order requiring measuring devices and controlling works on Hornet Creek was sent to USDA Forest Service as our agency was listed on attachment A, with other users that divert water.

The Forest Service claim is for instream stockwater. There are no diversion works associated with the claim. On the claim, the point of diversion and the place of use identify the stream segment where de minimus consumptive use occurs.

Based on these facts, would the Department please remove State claim number A67-11929, in the name of the United States of America, USDA Forest Service, from the list of diverters in Hornet Creek.
