RE: DITCH PROBLEMS

Requesting help re recurring problems, East Fork Ditch.  
Previous recent contacts w/ DRT + CJH.....

Mentioned possible control by Watermaster, how to implement etc.

Discussed with DRT. recall 42-907 etc. ... possible to  
impose controls by assisting watermaster .... but for 1997  
season, too late to implement physical controls for 1996.

Discussed again with Gerry: said ditch co. has associated with  
board of directors, no controls or costs, no ditch manage.  
Per 42-1302, could elect (board would) manager to take  
control of ditch. May pursue with board, may approach  
Richard Kestten (Wm of #67A) to monitor diversions on  
ditch for 1-2 weeks to get through worst crisis. Gerry  
would recommend payment for ditch man. if go this route.  
Route.

I told him that appeared OK if ditch co. meets  
other tests of Chpt 13 lat. assoc. - dept. cannot assist  
with site visit etc. unless physical controls installed. possible  
to address problem this winter for longer-term solution?  
No dept. follow-up needed now.
