My husband, Alvin Y. Legg, passed away November 1994. The Legg ranch has always had an abundance of water, but during the last two summers, since my husband's death, a neighbor Tom Hubbard has diverted my water so it's unavailable to my ranch. Virtually leaving my ranch with no water reaching my barn yard, both feed lots and pasture, as well as the crop land. He has locked the gate and will not allow anyone to enter his property, let alone retrieve this water. There have been numerous times in years past when Mr. Hubbard diverted this water, both with my husband and earlier with his father.

Mr. Hubbard is using water that does not belong to him and I would appreciate a full investigation of the Legg water. Alvin knew the location of Jensen Spring and other springs that make up Jensen Spring Creek so he was always able to control his water. I need to know the exact location of this spring so I know where my water should be coming from. I have enclosed several documents that might be of help in this investigation. In order for me to have a productive ranch I need all the water that is rightfully mine.
