Name called to tell me - started delivery per request of #2 6/21/94. (or 6/22/94).

As of 6/22 p.m.:

#1 @ 45" Dial's control left locked, will be getting #1 field valve closed/locked today/early tomorrow. All else ok.

#2 @ 80" very little or no flow past #2 checkdam. Weir pool cleaned so ok. Field valve locked.

#4 @ 303" But flowmeter no working. Told him to contact Dean L. (new Dbl. Division manager) & give him 24 hrs. to get it fixed or shut #4 off.

If happens, water will probably go to #1 if wants it (indicated that #1 will want the water).

I will re-activate #1 monitoring weir

#5 very little if any water getting there

He had a question @ Dowl domestic water &/or keeping Dowl pipelines full: Answer is, domestic right for Dowl = #11. No water to anyone unless it's being delivered in priority order per specific water right. If Dowl getting any of #6/7, can use some for #11 use (domestic) since no intervening calls b/w #7 & #11 water rights.

Talked to Watermaster this afternoon after having a message from him this a.m.

He told me that had not closed #4 as I instructed him on 6/24. Said had figured way to reasonably estimate delivery to #4 by manipulating flows to #1 (water only called for limited amount) & then reducing #1 to called for amount & placing same into #4.

This is not acceptable. I instructed him to do this today:

- Close ~~#4~~ #4 100%

- Deliver to #1 the amount called for. Then need to check end #1 out at center pipe to see if water is reaching the field.

- #2 will be adjusted accordingly if needed.

- If #1 & #2 are getting water they called for & excess flows past #2 p/d, then is water available for next rights in priority order.
